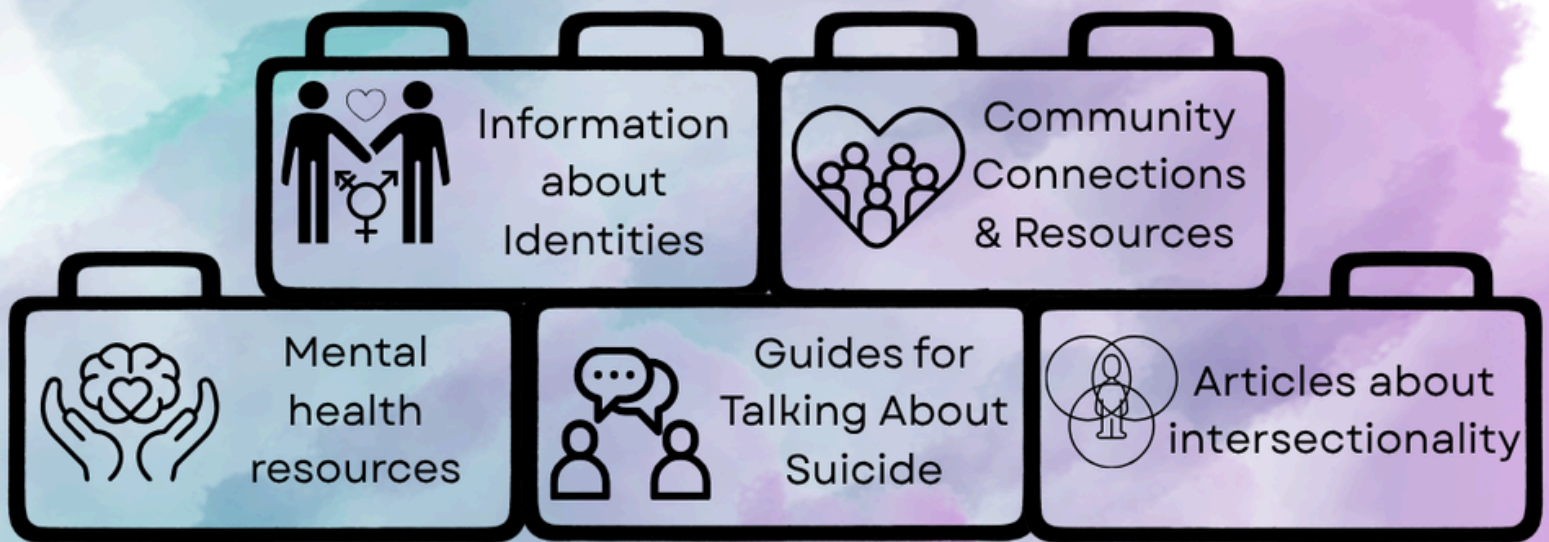


What is **THE TREVOR PROJECT** **?**

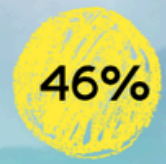
All statistics are from **16,000+** LGBTQ+ Youth

Attempted **suicide** last year



Expressed their **need** for mental health care,
but were unable to access it



Reported experiencing **discrimination**
-Majority due to gender identity



Feel **unsafe** going to a doctor or hospital



Of **13-17 year olds** were bullied
while **25%** of **18-24 years old** were bullied



Reported physical threats or **harm**
-Majority being **13-17 year olds**
