The type of projects done includes school grounds, public spaces, health centres, parks & urban spaces.

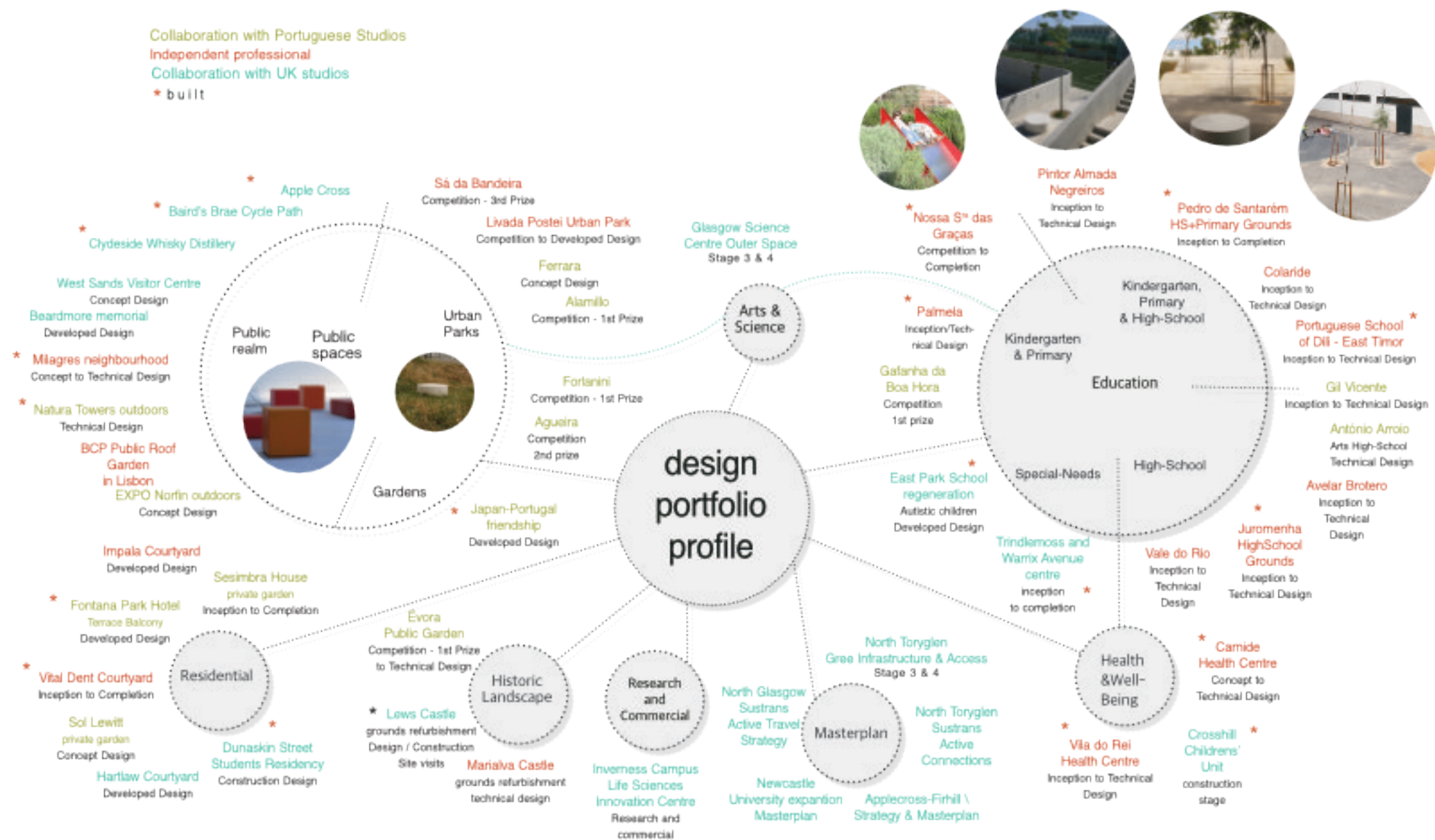
