




IMAC & *canadian leaders* LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE







What is the meaning of ordination in the church?

It's the ceremony of bestowing a person with a position of religious authority — as when someone becomes a priest or minister. The noun ordination comes from the Latin word ordinare, meaning “put in order.” Becoming a religious leader usually requires training in a seminary followed by an ordination.

What can I do as an ordained minister?

Each denomination sets its own policy for distinguishing between the two, but in many cases, religious organizations consider ordained ministers to be permanent clergy. Ordination permits the minister to perform church rites and sacraments, such as baptisms, legal marriages and funerals.





WHY IS LEADERSHIP *important*

We have all heard the adage that no man is an island. No one ever gets to the top alone. If you are at the top of your organization, then you did not get there all by yourself. A tragic mistake leaders make is that when they get to the top, they get protective and start pushing others down. If you are lonely at the top, one behaviour you may need to evaluate is you maybe clinging to your position rather than connecting with your team and inviting them to join you at the top.

What is Leadership

Everybody defines leadership differently, but I love the definition my mentor, John C Maxwell defines leadership, "A leader is one who knows the way, goes the way, and shows the way." Irrespective of how you define a leader, he or she can prove to be a difference maker between success and failure of any venture. A good leader has a futuristic vision and knows how to turn his ideas into real-world success stories.

Characteristics of Leadership

Everyone has the potential to become a leader, it is assumed that leaders are born with the ability to lead, you might remember at school, the kid that the teacher always said would be the leader, they were given opportunities to lead, to succeed. If you then reflect

on this behavior you see that those children that were not chosen were in fact being inadvertently told that they cannot lead and are therefore followers. Research has shown that leadership can be learnt. This shows that the toughest person to lead is indeed, ourselves! When you accept that you are a leader, you need to recognize the following;

Leadership ability determines a person's level of effectiveness - the higher you want to escalate or climb, the more you need leadership. It is also true that the greater the impact you want to make – the greater your influence needs to be. Successful leaders will always look for development experiences to grow in their leadership capacity. This can be done by seeking opportunities to grow your leadership; searching for opportunities to improve organizational structures and procedures and seizing opportunities to create greater efficiencies and to assist others in lifting their development.

Every leader faces obstacles, challenges, tests, and trials, it's a part of the life cycle. Ineffective leaders will wait to see what happens during these difficult times, but effective leaders will act by seizing the moment and rise to the challenge. During these challenging instances, success will be determined by the leader's choice to change and grow. True Leaders will admit mistakes or shortcomings while ineffective Leaders also known as positional leaders, do not acknowledge shortcomings or mistakes for fear people will perceive them as ineffective and/or weak.

"Everything rises and falls on leadership," says Dr. Maxwell, **"but knowing how to lead is only half the battle. Understanding leadership and actually leading are two different activities."**

We are all leaders, in whatever capacity we are called to lead, to lead is to serve! Leadership or servitude does not allow one to misuse their title or position, instead as leaders, we lead from the front, we get involved, we recognize our weaknesses and build teams that succeed. A leader grows other leaders, where a true leader is the law of multiplication follows. Leaders always demonstrate three qualities that enable them to help potential leaders go to the next level – their words: their actions and their sacrifice. It's been said that a wise person learns from his mistakes. A wiser person learns from other's mistakes. But the wisest person of all learns from other's successes. People will summarize your life in one sentence – pick it now. As a leader, what it is that you want to leave behind when you pass from this earth? In the next issue we will look at how you lead **yourself** well?

Growing leaders have growing ministries we are therefore committed to providing avenue of continued ministerial education, exposure and resources for both spiritual and physical growth and achievements. (1 Tim 4:13; 2 Tim 2:15)

PROPHETIC RELEVANCY

We trust God to use us as His mouthpiece to speak in intelligible way in order to genuinely change lives. (John 4:5-42; Acts 17:22-34, 5:27)

IMAC *working map*

There are 32 London boroughs and the City of London – the ancient core and financial centre all of these are located in these cardinal points.

North Cardinal;

The geographical mapping of London for growth and effective work shall consist of all Churches in North London been coordinated under an appointed leader. It's important that the leader be a Bishop or appointed a Bishop of imac trained to coordinate the spiritual, social wellbeing and working with community leaders of the area of responsibility.

South Cardinal;

The geographical mapping of London for growth and effective work shall consist of all Churches in South London been coordinated under an appointed leader. It's important that the leader be a Bishop or appointed a Bishop of imac trained to coordinate the spiritual, social wellbeing and working with community leaders of the area of responsibility.

East Cardinal;

The geographical mapping of London for growth and effective work shall consist of all Churches in East London been coordinated under an appointed leader. It's important that the leader be a Bishop or appointed a Bishop of imac trained to coordinate the spiritual, social wellbeing and working with community leaders of the area of responsibility.

West Cardinal;

The geographical mapping of London for growth and effective work shall consist of all Churches in West London been coordinated under an appointed leader. It's important that the leader be a Bishop or appointed a Bishop of imac trained to coordinate the spiritual, social wellbeing and working with community leaders of the area of responsibility.



WHAT WE *stand for*

The rule of faith and practice for IMAC is obtained in the Holy Bible. The Theological interpretation of our doctrinal position is guided by the belief that the Holy Spirit is the Interpreter.

IMAC asserts that God reveals doctrine and that He continually gives spiritual insight for God's historical plan before the foundation of the world, manifested in these last days through His Son Jesus Christ.

It is the prayer of IMAC that the unity and alliance of God's people should be based on the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

In recognition of the diversity of doctrines and customs, which are represented by the participating churches and organizations, IMAC does not set up a statement of Faith beyond the following Biblical Affirmations:

The Godhead

We believe in the one true God, who has revealed Himself as the eternally self-existent the "I AM" existing in three persons: The Father, The Son-Jesus Christ and The Holy Spirit. These three are distinguished but indivisible in essence: co-eternal, co-existing, co-equal in nature, attributes, power and glory (2 Cor.13: 14, Matt. 28:19).

The Holy Bible is the inspired Word of God

It is the infallible rule of faith and conduct and as such is above conscience and reason, but not contrary to reason (2Tim. 3:15-17; 1 Thess. 2:13)

Original sin and fallen Humanity

Man and woman were created good and upright, for God said, "let us make man in our image, after our likeness." The first man, Adam through disobedience fell from the position God intended for mankind and thus sin and death entered into the world. Adam's transgressions incurred spiritual death, which is separation from God. The resultant depravity of sinful human nature necessitates salvation and redemption from the power of sin, which can only be obtained through the Lord Jesus Christ (Gen. 1:26-31; 2: 17; 3: 6-24; Romans 5:12-21).

The Salvation of Man

Humankind's only hope for redemption and salvation from the power of sin is through the shed blood of the Lord Jesus Christ (Acts 4: 8-12; Rom. 5:8-21; 10:9-10). Salvation is by the grace of God through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ; it is the gift of God and not the works of any man. Salvation is an inward witness of the Holy Spirit, that we are the children of

God. (Rom. 8:16)

The Lord Jesus Christ

We believe that Jesus Christ was born of a virgin (Matt. 1:18). In His love for lost humanity He voluntarily gave His life on the cross, one sacrifice for sins forever and thereby He became the Saviour of the World (John 2: 1-2). We believe that He rose from the dead, appeared to many in the flesh (John 20: 16-31) and that when He departed the earth, He ascended into Heaven where He remains at the right hand of God the Father interceding for us (Rom.8: 34).

The Holy Spirit

(a) The fruit of the Holy Spirit: The work of Holy Spirit in our lives is evidenced by: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

(b) The gifts of the Holy Spirit: The power of the Holy Spirit is available to all believers and is manifested through spiritual gifts. To one is given the word of wisdom, to another the word of knowledge, to another faith, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another the ability to speak in different kinds of tongues and still to another the interpretation of tongues. The Holy Spirit is also our teacher and the source of power for life and our service in the ministry.(Gal 5:7-9; 1 Cor. 12:1-12; Luke 12: 12; Acts 1: 8; 2: 1-47; Is. 53: 4; Matt 18: 16-17).

Ordinances of the Church

We believe that the Lord gave the following ordinances to the church and therefore must be observed accordingly.

(a) Baptism in water: The Ordinance of Baptism is the symbolic identification of the believer with Christ in His death, burial and resurrection (Matt. 28: 19, Acts 10: 47-48; Rom. 6:4).

(b) The Lord's Supper or Holy Communion: The Holy Communion is the expression of our partaking of the divine nature of the Lord Jesus Christ (2 Peter 1:4) and a memorial of His suffering and death. (1 Cor. 11: 26) enjoined on all believers.

The Second Coming of Christ

"Jesus Christ will return to the earth in the clouds in the same manner as He departed" (Acts 1:11)

The Final Judgment

There will be a final judgment in which the dead will be raised and will be judged. Whosoever is not found written in the Book of Life, together with the devil and his angels, the beast and the false prophets, will be consigned to everlasting punishment in the lake of fire and brimstone, which is the second death. (Matt. 25: 46; Heb. 9: 20; Rev. 20:10-15; 21:1-27).

The New Heaven and the New Earth

The Lord shall create a new earth and new heaven void of suffering and woes but peace, love and joy, Christ being the ruler. (Rev. 21:1)

TOGETHER *we stand*

IMAC is a movement of churches working together to change the Nation through a network of church leaders, national gatherings, training events and resources. Giving God all the glory He deserves.

To enable this to happen there are people and teams all across the nation pushing this common vision. All this requires time, investment and application of the gifts God has given to each of us.

BELIEVE IN *each other*

Those who truly love each other, believe in each other, because in order to love someone, you must believe in them. Only a pessimist says “seeing is believing”, but an optimist believes in advance and says “believing is seeing”. Love always believes for the best and through love a couple believes in each other. Love believes in you, it’s been supporting and encouraging you since the day you were born. Believe that?

Think about all the supporting people you have had in your life.

In all of your relationships you have the ability to see the best in people and to believe the best in those people. When you meet someone for the first time and find that you like them, it’s due to something positive that you seen in them. Now since people are imperfect, you most likely had chosen to have an open mindset in that initial meeting. The question here though is, what is it that you liked about them? You must have initially given them the benefit of the doubt to find some positive aspects about them. Now it is possible that you could have gone into the meeting with pessimism or optimism and came out with two completely different viewpoints based upon your own thought mannerisms.

GIVE US *a support*

Everyone needs a supporting cast of love around them, we all desire to have someone who encourages us and someone who believes in us. I would not be writing this article if I had not been encouraged by love to do so. Often times we become discouraged by some less than favourable occurrence and we need others to give us some forward momentum. We need someone else to believe in us, in our capabilities and in our realm of possibilities.
