Kandy

Kandy is a major city located in the Central Province of Sri Lanka. The city is situated in the midst of hills, which crosses a large area of tea plantations. Kandy is both an administrative and religious city and the capital of the Central Province and home of the Temple of the Tooth Relic, one of the most sacred places of worship in the Buddhist world. It was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1988.



Dinner

Arrival at Bhandaranayike International airport at Colombo and proceed to Kandy. Check into hotel. After freshen up, visit Temple of Tooth Relic (Dalada Maligawa), and museum. This is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

This temple has been considered as one of the sacred places of the followers of Lord Buddha all over the world.

Back to hotel. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.





## Temple of Tooth Relic

The Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, is a Buddhist temple in Kandy, Sri Lanka. It is located in the Royal Palace Complex of the former Kingdom of Kandy, which houses the relic of the tooth of the Buddha. Since ancient times, the relic has played an important role in local politics because it is believed that whoever holds the relic holds the governance of the country. The relic was historically held by Sinhalese kings. The Temple of the Tooth is a World Heritage Site mainly due to the temple and the relic.

## Kandy



B/F / Dinner

After breakfast at the hotel, visit Peradeniya Royal Botanical Gardens, which is a 147-acre tropical paradise. You have time for some Souvenir shopping followed by the Garden visit.

Afterwards, explore Kandy Lake and pay technical visit to renowned Gem Museum. The day ends with a traditional Kandyan cultural show in the evening.

Evening back to hotel at Kandy Dinner and overnight stay.





## Gem Museum, Kandy

Historically Sri Lanka has been dubbed 'Ratna-Dweepa' or the 'Island of Gems' in ancient Sanskrit texts. Over the centuries, the country's exceptional variety of gems has attracted traders from across the sea. The Natural Gems and Gemological Museum is situated in Kandy. The museum exhibits rare minerals in the world which are found in Sri Lanka and the oldest fossils of living beings from the Cambrian era about 541 – 485 million years ago.

## Nuwara Eliya



B/F / Dinner

After breakfast at the hotel, check out and get ready for a drive to Nuwara Eliya. The journey takes 2.5 hours approximately. Enjoy the scenic drive via Ramboda Falls, have a quick photo stop. The exhilarating trip through the tea plantations along with tea factories can be added with a tea factory visit (Optional). Gregory lake, Seethamman Kovil, an iconic Ramayana site, are the other attractions here.

Evening stay at the hotel at Nuwara Eliya. Dinner and overnight stay.

Nuwara Eliya is a city in the hill country of the Central Province. The name means "city of light". The city is the administrative capital of Nuwara Eliya District, with a picturesque landscape and temperate climate. Nuwara Eliya is considered to be the most important location for tea production in Sri Lanka. Nuwara Eliya is known for its cool climate – its the coolest place in Sri Lanka during the season.

## Bentota



B/F / Dinner

After breakfast at the hotel, check out and hop on your vehicle for a 5 hours journey to Bentota. At Bentota, visit Dutch fort. Have stroll at the prestine beach. You can enjoy water sports like surfing, paddleboarding, or snorkeling (optional on own expnses) here.

Back to hotel at Bentota in the evening follwed by dinner and overnight stay.



Bentota is a resort town on Sri Lanka's southwest coast. Its long Bentota Beach stretches north, where it becomes a sandy strip known as Paradise Island, parallel to Bentota Lagoon. Coral-rich dive sites include Canoe Rock. On Bentota river, centuries-old Galapota Temple has a large Buddha statue. Bentota has been identified as the ancient Bhimatirtha and the area is also described in ancient messenger poems (sandeśa kāvya).

**5** Colombo



B/F / Dinner

After breakfast Visit the Kosgoda Turtle Hatchery – learn a little about turtle conservation. Then have a boat ride through Madhu river (optional at own cost). Then proceed to Colomba. The capital city is 2 hours drive away from Bentota.

Post lunch move out for a city tour to visit Parliament building, Independence Square, Galle Face, Port city, old Parliament / Lotus Tower from outside and enjoy shopping at House of Fashions- Laksala. Then visit Gangarmaya temple and lake. Evening is the perfect time for some shopping at Petta Market.

Back to the hotel at Colombo and have dinner and overnight stay.



Colombo was made the capital of the island country when Sri Lanka was ceded to the British Empire in 1815. The city retained its capital status when Sri Lanka gained independence from the British. The name 'Colombo', first introduced by the Portuguese explorers in 1505. Another belief is that the name is derived from the Sinhala name Kola-ambathota which means 'Harbour with green mango trees'.

**6** **Departure**

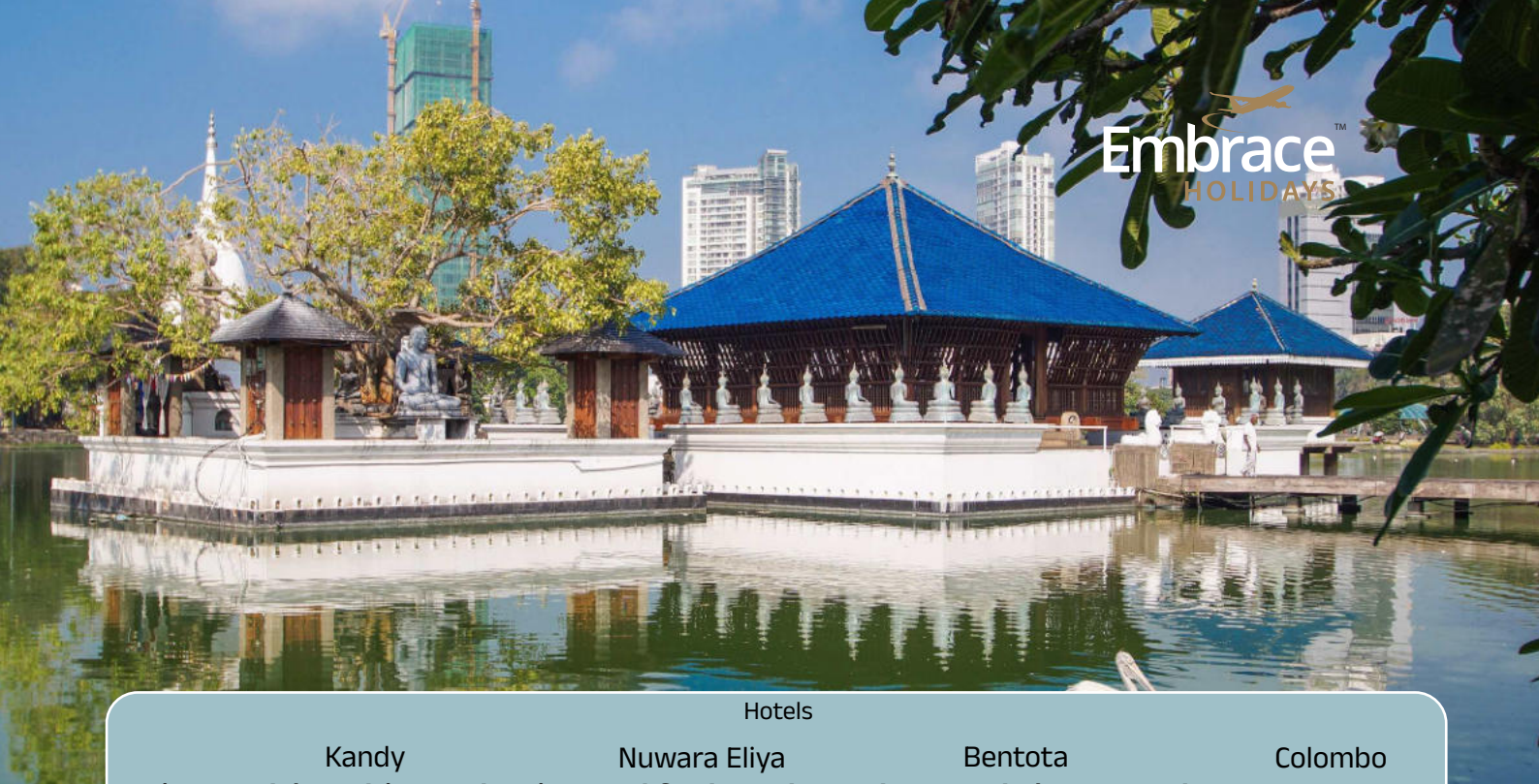


After breakfast find some time to stroll in the city as time permits.
