A Step-by-Step Overview for Launching a Student-Led NeuroHelp Chapter

OUR MISSION: BRINGING BRAIN SCIENCE INTO EVERY SCHOOL

The NeuroHelp Education Initiative is a structured public health program that establishes student-led neuroscience chapters in Arizona middle and high schools. Through organized chapters, students learn to recognize neurological emergencies, spread brain health literacy, and become community health leaders — all supported by free NeuroHelp resources.

Core Educational Pillars

- **Seizure Safety:** Critical response and safety education for students and bystanders.

- **Emergency Preparedness:** Equipping student networks to improve localized medical response at the school level.

THE CHAPTER SYSTEM: THREE-TIER PROGRESSION

1. Starter Chapter

LEVEL 1

REQUIREMENTS

1+ interested student or dedicated teacher sponsor; formal awareness from school administration.

KEY BENEFITS

Full access to the NeuroHelp core digital resource library; official Starter Chapter certificate.

EXAMPLE ACTIVITIES

Campus poster campaigns; managing a dedicated neuro-health awareness table during school lunch blocks.

2. Active Chapter

LEVEL 2

REQUIREMENTS

5+ active core student members; minimum of 2 campus or community educational events coordinated per academic semester.

KEY BENEFITS

EXAMPLE ACTIVITIES

Interactive classroom neuroscience presentations; organizing informative parent and community education nights.

3. Leadership Chapter

LEVEL 3
