



## **Quick Start Guide**

This quick start guide will help you to quickly set up your PoolWatcher (PW) and control its most important functions. Please read this guide carefully before putting the PW into operation to avoid operational errors.

### **Preparation**

- **Battery:** Fully charge the battery before using the PW for the first time (see page 4, §7 of the booklet).
- **Initial Setup:** Remove the PW from the box and ensure it has no transport damage.

Important: If the alarm is triggered unintentionally, you can cancel it at any time by pressing the silver button for approximately 4 seconds. The PW will then return to swimming mode.

### **Installation and Placement**

1. **Secure the Cord:** Attach the included cord to the eyelet on the acrylic plate.
2. **Positioning:** Place the PW in the pool or pond. It should be positioned approximately halfway along the longest side of the pool/pond.
3. **Securing:** Use the cord to secure the PW to the edge of the pool or pond. Ensure there is approximately 20 cm of movement from the edge.



### **Operation and Monitoring**

- **Activation:** Press the silver button for 1 second to wake the PW from transport/deep sleep mode.
- **Confirmation:** To confirm activation, the yellow LEDs ● will blink twice and the alarm will sound twice (the PW starts in "swimming mode" with medium sensitivity).
- **Monitoring Mode:** When the water is calm, the PW will automatically switch to monitoring mode after approximately 2 minutes (indicated by a single alarm tone). It will then begin monitoring the danger zone.

### **Function Test**

While in monitoring mode, perform a function test as follows:

- Fill a 10L household bucket with water.
- Drop it into the water from a height of approximately 1 meter at the point furthest from the PW.
- The PW should trigger the alarm within a maximum of 25 seconds.
- The alarm will sound for approximately 30 seconds before turning off.
- Note: Further alarms may occur due to continued water movement.
