# **Coaching Guide**

Target Skill: Short a CVC Words

Genre: Realistic Fiction

#### **Before Reading**

1. "Today we are looking for short a words like 'cat' and 'jam' as we read."

- 2. What do you think might happen if you left food on the ground?
- 3. Have you ever had a pet do something funny or messy?

### **During Reading**

- 1. Sounding Out Support: If the student struggles, remind them to tap each sound, then blend it slowly without guessing.
- 2. Remind the reader to watch for short a words to help decode new words.
- 3. Pause and ask: What did Kat set on the mat?
- 4. Encourage the child to read with a playful voice when the cat runs in!

### **After Reading**

- 1. Ask the child to retell what happened in the story in order.
- 2. Ask: Why do you think the cat ran to the mat?
- 3. Ask: What would you have done if you were Kat?
- 4. Have the child highlight or underline five short a words from the story.
- 5. Fluency Tip: Read the story to them and then have the child read to you.

#### **Activity Idea**

Draw a picture of Kat cleaning up the jam mess. Label your picture with words like "jam," "mat," and "rag."
