- What themes about bravery, loyalty, or secrecy can you find in the story?
- 3. How would the story have changed if Kael had acted alone?

Activity Idea

Have students create a visual "secret powers" chart: one column for strengths people show openly and one for secret strengths. Then, write or draw how those secret strengths might be used for good—just like Kael and Rhea's.
