- 3. What does Mila do when the rain starts?
- Read the last line with excitement and pride!

After Reading

- 1. Retell the problem and how Mila responded
- 2. Why do you think Mila kept playing even in the rain?
- 3. What lesson does this story teach about trying your best?
- 4. Skill Check: Highlight six ai words in the story
- 5. **Fluency Tip:** Read it again like you're telling a play-by-play at the game!
