During Reading

- 1. **Sounding Out Support: Sounding Out Support:** Stretch and blend the /oi/ sound in "oi" words like *point*, *avoid*, and *spoil*.
- 2. Watch for target skill words that show how players stay calm and plan their moves.
- 3. Where do players point to help their teammates?
- 4. Read the final line using a strong, focused voice like an athlete ready for the next play.

After Reading

- 1. Retell how players score points and stay calm during loud games.
