Before Reading

- 1. Remind your reader that *cl* is a beginning blend that says /cl/ like in *clock*.
- 2. Have you ever found something hidden in a strange place?
- 3. What sounds might an old clock make?

During Reading

- 1. Sounding Out Support: Emphasize blending /c/ and /l/ smoothly in c/ words
- 2. Encourage kids to listen for clues and changes in the wall
- 3. What does the wall do when Cam taps it?
- 4. Read the last line with curiosity and suspense

After Reading

- 1. What did Cam notice that was strange?
- 2. Why was the clock important to the story?
- 3. What do you think is behind the flap?
- 4. Circle all the *cl* words in the story
- 5. Fluency Tip: Read it again like you're solving a real mystery!

Activity Idea

Draw your own mystery wall with a hidden object. Label it with at least two *cl* blend words from the story. Then write a short mystery sentence using one of those words.

Coaching Tip

Blends like *cl* become easier to spot when tied to sound and suspense—make the reading feel like a little adventure!
