Before Reading

- 3. What do you think makes old books feel special or mysterious?

During Reading

- 1. **Sounding Out Support:** Remind kids that 'oo' makes the /u/ sound in words like "book." Try that sound first when sounding out tricky words.
- 2. Watch for 'oo' words and read them clearly.
- 3. What did Mia find inside the hut?
- 4. Try reading Mia's last line with a wondering, curious voice!

After Reading

- 1. Can you retell how Mia found the secret hut?
- 2. Why did Mia think about hidden stories waiting inside the books?
