#### Purpose & Scope

The BCCK Transport Committee evaluates transport and logistics policies, regulations, and infrastructure projects—assessing their impact on trade, mobility, and operations in Kosovo. It serves as the BCCK central information source and represents members' collective interests to government bodies, regulators, and public agencies.

#### **Our Aim**

To enhance the effectiveness, safety, and sustainability of Kosovo's transport ecosystem—empowering BCCK members with insights, advocacy support, and opportunities to shape transport-related decisions and projects.

Key Services & Activities

#### 1. Policy & Infrastructure Monitoring

- o Track proposals, regulations, and infrastructure initiatives across road, rail, air, and cross-border transport.
- o Provide members with concise impact analyses and summaries.

#### 2. Consultation Feedback & Advocacy

- o Draft and submit formal responses to public consultations on transport matters.
- Engage with ministries, municipalities, customs authorities, and transport agencies on behalf of BCCK members.

### 3. Forums, Roundtables & Speaker Events

- o Host events featuring transport planners, logistics experts, regulators, and infrastructure developers.
- o Include Q&A panels to deepen member engagement and understanding.
- Establish temporary sub-committees formed around specific themes—cross-border transit, urban logistics,
  rail freight modernization, or infrastructure project feedback.

# 4. Workshops & Site Visits

- o Organize field visits locally and internationally to ports, logistics centers, and transport terminals and infrastructure works.
- o Conduct training on customs procedures, urban transport planning, and efficiency best practices.

#### 5. Member Alerts & Publications

- o Issue transport alerts on route changes, permit/licensing updates, border processes, and infrastructure opportunities.
- o Publish regular newsletters capturing sector trends, upcoming projects (e.g., SEETO/Transport Community efforts in the Western Balkans), and government updates.

# 6. Networking & Stakeholder Collaboration

- o Facilitate introductions between members and key stakeholders: transport agencies, infrastructure developers, logistics firms, and PPP project managers.
- Encourage partnerships for addressing transport, warehousing, and customs bottlenecks.
