### *Speaker's Corner*

Topic: "Introduction to Asian Cymbidiums" Speaker: Richard Ho

Richard Ho is a former project manager with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, managing the cleanup of hazardous waste sites. He has served as the President of the North Jersey Orchid Society twice, chaired a dozen orchid shows, and is active in several orchid societies. He has been growing orchids of all kinds for close to 30 years. His collection consists primarily of species, with a special interest in Asian species including *Neofinetia falcata*, *Sedirea japonica*, and Asian cymbidium—all grown indoors under lights for the majority of the year. You are most likely to find him at local orchid shows, either shopping or working or both.
