The Workshop

A hands-on learning programme where participants actively practice skills under expert supervision.



DURATION	FOCUS	MODE
1 to 3 Days	Skill Acquisition	Offline or Online

Objectives:

- Develop practical and technical skills
- Apply concepts through activities and exercises
- Encourage learning by doing

Example: A 2-day workshop on Data Analysis using SPSS with real datasets and practice sessions.



DISCOURSE. INTERACTION. IDEAS.

The Seminar

An academic talk or presentation on a specific topic followed by followed by discussion.

DURATION	FOCUS	MODE
1 to 3 Hours	Knowledge & Critical Thinking	Mostly Offline

Objectives:

- Share knowledge and research ideas
- Promote critical thinking
- Encourage academic interaction

Example: A seminar on Artificial Intelligence in Education delivered by a university expert.



RESEARCH. NETWORKING. RECOGNITION.

The Conference

A large formal academic event where researchers present papers, posters, and studies.

DURATION

2 to 5 Days

FOCUS

Research Dissemination

MODE

Offline or Hybrid

Objectives:

- Disseminate original research
- Facilitate academic networking
- Promote interdisciplinary collaboration

Example: An international conference on Climate Change and Sustainability with paper presentations.



Faculty Development Programme

A structured professional training programme designed exclusively for teachers and academic staff.

DURATION	5 to 14 Days
FOCUS	Teaching Improvement
MODE	Offline or Online

Objectives:

- Improve teaching effectiveness
- Update pedagogical knowledge
- Promote research and innovation

Example: A 5-day FDP on Outcome Based Education and NEP 2020 for college faculty.

EXPERTISE. DEPTH. CONVERGENCE.

The Symposium



A focused academic meeting where multiple experts discuss different aspects of one central theme.

DURATION	1 to 2 Days
FOCUS	Single Theme Exploration
MODE	Mostly Offline

Objectives:

- Deep exploration of a specific topic
- Expert-level discussion
- Exchange of scholarly viewpoints

Example: A symposium on Indigenous Knowledge Systems with invited scholars only.

DIGITAL. FLEXIBLE. ACCESS.

The Webinar

An online academic event conducted using digital platforms.



DURATION	1 to 3 Hours
FOCUS	Online Learning
MODE	Online Only

Objectives:

- Provide flexible and remote learning
- Reach wider audiences
- Share knowledge cost-effectively

Example: A webinar on Research Ethics and Plagiarism Awareness conducted via Zoom.
