FINAL REPORT—CHECK ON DRAFT ANALYSIS

An **Accurate Assessment** when the assessment was spot on, **Meh** for when the analysis was ok, and **Huge Miss** for when the editor completely s* the bed.

- **Ryan O'Reilly (162)** and **Gabriel Vilardi (140)** are first-line, first-PP players who fell to the 13th. Outstanding value.
- **Bouchard (31)** in the 1st. He could be a Norris candidate this season.
- **Garnet Hathaway (325)** for the hits in the 13th is not a great pick. Foils is sacrificing every other category for this player. **Dylan Cozens (101)**, **Trevor Zegras (516)**, **Gabriel Vilardi (140)**, and **Andrej Kuzmenko (484)** all went after and have 60+ point potential.
- **Filip Gustavsson (58)** in the 10th a high reward and low risk pick
- I'm not super high on **Joseph Woll (94)**, **Pekka-Luukonen (169)**, **Adin Hill (75)**, and **Tristen Jarry (217)** went way later and I think are comparable goaltenders
- **Hill (75)** and **DAccord (93)** in the 7th and 13th respectively are great goalie options and even better based on where they were selected.
- I think **Wyatt Johnston (55)** is a good player with a lot of upside, but he is a player that could have been drafted in the following rounds
- Has to be **Dylan Cozens (101)** but sneakily I am going to give an honourable mention for **Kochetkov (121)**
- **Jake Sanderson (29)** in the 6th stands out as a very solid pick
- I'll beat the dead horse on **Nick Suzuki (24)**. Too early for a centreman of his calibre.
- **Nik Ehlers (115)** in the 9th and **Nyqvist (544)** in the 13th stand out as sneaky picks of un-sexy wingers who produce at a 60+ point clip.
- Not a big **Seth Jarvis (59)** fan, especially in round 3. A safer play at that spot would have been **Kevin Fiala (60)** or **John Tavares (49)** who went shortly thereafter.
- **Zegras (516)** in the 14th has the most upside based on where he was drafted
- I don't like the **Celebrini (65)** pick in the second round
- **Jake Guentzel (30)** in the first round could be a 100pt threat playing on the top line and top PP in Tampa Bay
- Probably **Nico Hischier (51)** in the 4th. That type of centre was available way later in the draft.
- **Nugent-Hopkins (170)** in the 5th seems like good value for a dual-eligible player and exposure to the Edmonton PP
