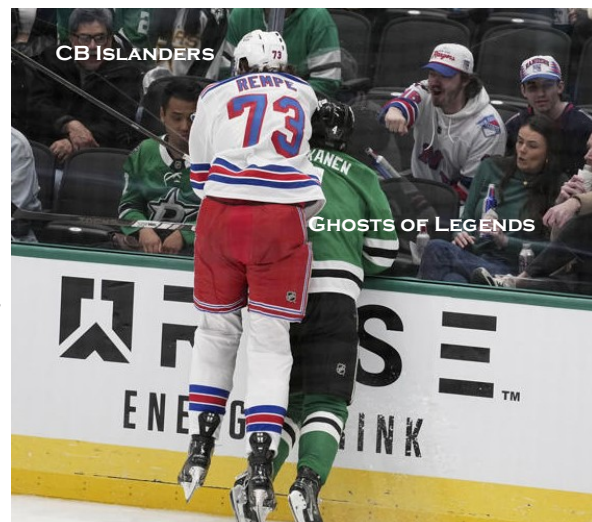


Week Eleven: Nearly a tie-free week; thanks Foil. Tocchet, Dynasty, CB, Kings, and Retired Commish each put two points on the board.

Ottawa Senators – the existence of Don Sweeney. Greatest gift we could have got this year. And a quick recovery from Linus Ullmark

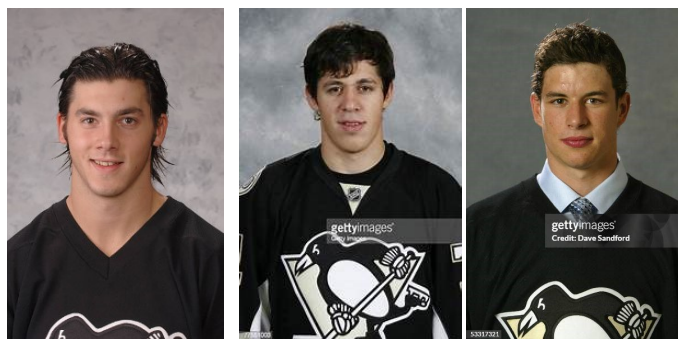
Philadelphia Flyers – another high draft pick and for it to be 1973 again
