

What is Giri Pradakshina?

What is Giri Pradakshina?

- Giri = Hill, Pradakshina = Circumambulation (walking around in reverence).
- Pilgrims walk 14 km around Arunachala Hill in Tiruvannamalai, Tamil Nadu.
- It is believed that walking around the hill itself is equivalent to doing darshan of Lord Shiva in all the temples of the world.
- The practice was strongly recommended by Sri Ramana Maharshi.

Best Time for Giri Pradakshina

- Pournami (Full Moon days): Most auspicious; lakhs of devotees gather.
- Karthika Deepam festival (Nov-Dec): The most special time when a huge lamp is lit on top of Arunachala hill.
- Early Morning or Late Night: Cool weather, less crowd, peaceful experience.

Now to Perform

- Start from Arunachaleswara Temple main gate.
- Walk clockwise around the hill barefoot.
- Chant "Om Arunachaleshwaraya Namah" or "Om Namah Shivaya" while walking.
- The path is well-paved, lit at night, with many shrines along the way.

Spiritual Significance

- Belief: Each step around Arunachala is equal to great punya (merit).
- Removes karmic debts, grants peace, prosperity, and ultimately liberation (moksha).
- Called "Walking Yajna" offering oneself in humility to Lord Arunachaleswara.
- Things to Keep in Mind
- Carry a small water bottle, dry fruits, or light snacks.
- Avoid plastic; carry eco-friendly bags.
- **☑** Don't rush it's a spiritual walk, not a race.
- Elderly can do partial pradakshina by auto.
- Beware of monkeys near some temples.


Temples & Shrines on the Giri Pradakshina Path There are 8 Lingams + many holy spots you must visit:

- 1. Indra Lingam connected to East direction, represents strength & prosperity.
- 2. Agni Lingam South-East, worshipped for health.
- 3. Yama Lingam South, helps overcome fear of death.
- 4. Niruthi Lingam South-West, removes negativity & sins.
- 5. Varuna Lingam West, grants peace of mind.
- 6. Vayu Lingam North-West, for good health & vitality.
- 7. Kubera Lingam North, for wealth & abundance.
- 8. Isanya Lingam North-East, grants moksha & spiritual upliftment.
- **♦ Other Must-visit Spots on the Path:**
 - Sri Ramana Maharshi Ashram
 - Adiannamalai Temple
 - Pachaiamman Temple
 - Several Theerthams (sacred water tanks)



Arunachalam - The Path to Moksha

- According to the Skanda Purana, performing Giri Pradakshina (circumambulation of Arunachala Hill) destroys sins and frees a person from the cycle of birth and death.
- Sri Ramana Maharshi also said:
- "One complete pradakshina around Arunachala itself is the path to Moksha."
 - That is why this sacred place is also called Moksha Puri.
