Duties & Responsibilities

The Darter Editor is responsible for designing, creating, and distributing the Darter, MASI's magazine/club newsletter. It is the editor's duty to communicate with chairs and other club members to obtain information and material for the newsletter portion of the Darter and to find content to fill the rest of the magazine.

The design and style of the Darter has changed much over the course of the years and each editor approaches the job differently. Under the Darter Development Team (2022-Present) the Darter has become an aquarium magazine, while the MASI newsletter content has been sequestered to the rear of the publication, so that it can be removed later. This was done to enable the team to sell the Darter, as a magazine, to subscribers who were not club members, and likewise to remove club information before archiving the magazine.

Because the design of the Darter is so variable, there are few set tasks. Darter editing must be passed down from one editor to the next, like a plague or deadly virus. But, after contracting this duty, make the Darter your own.
