Katie's safety investigation reports are used as evidence in national-level inquiries, including the National Maternity and Neonatal Inquiry chaired by Valerie Amos and the independent review led by Wes Streeting and Donna Ockenden.

Katie is a registered midwife who has been qualified for 19 years and has an extensive clinical background including 17 years at an NHS Trust as a Patient Safety Manager and senior Delivery Suite Coordinator. Katie has been providing expert witness services to legal cases for two years.

Katie is a Maternity Investigator (MI) and forensically investigates and authors detailed MNSI maternity safety reports in maternity cases with poor neonatal outcomes, intrapartum stillbirths, therapeutic cooling cases with evidence of hypoxic ischaemic encephalopathy (HIE) and maternal deaths up to and including 42 days postpartum (excluding deaths by suicide).

Katie's safety investigation reports are used as evidence in national-level inquiries, including the National Maternity and Neonatal Inquiry chaired by Valerie Amos and the independent review led by Wes Streeting and Donna Ockenden.

Katie also has experience of preparing reports for coroner's inquests and providing evidence at these proceedings.
