All animals are observed daily for visible signs of health prior to sale. Preventative and veterinary care is always provided when appropriate. However, due to the nature of live animals, no formal guarantees are offered. Health issues can arise naturally and may not reflect the condition of the animal at the time of purchase. Due to this & past consumer misrepresentation, all sales are final.

At Purchase: Inspect your animal carefully. You may take photos/videos for your records.

If concerns arise: Have your new animal examined by a licensed veterinarian within 3 days.

Contact us promptly with documentation.

We care deeply about our animals and our reputation and will always review concerns case-by-case when given the opportunity to make things right.

Basic Bird Care Guidelines

Diet - Quality seed/pellet mix as a base diet (Vitamin blends) -Fresh greens 3–4x weekly (collard, mustard, turnip greens — e.g., HEB Great Green Trio)- Fresh vegetables regularly Fruit as an occasional treat (e.g., apple, berries, melon) -Provide cuttlebone or calcium source at all times & Fresh, clean water daily -Natural sunlight (when safe) is critical. Improper diet (excluding fresh produce) can significantly harm your bird and reduce the lifespan. We ensure all birds readily accept these options prior to sale.

Toxic / Avoid - Avocado, chocolate, caffeine, alcohol, Onion, garlic (in excess), salty or processed foods

Environment - No smoking/vaping, candles, air fresheners, perfumes, or aerosols - Avoid cooking fumes (especially non-stick/Teflon) - Clean cage regularly (no harsh cleaning agents). -Provide perches and toys/swings for enrichment. Many birds learn to open their cages; lock the doors with stainless steel clips (zinc is toxic). If using a DIY cage, be advised that treated wood is also highly toxic. Use only stainless-steel wires or use store bought cages.

Sleep & Stress - 10–12 hours of quiet, dark sleep nightly - Keep in a low-stress environment

Health - Annual vet check recommended - Routine fecal exams detect parasites early

Monitor for: - Lethargy - Changes in droppings - Loss of appetite - Excessive daytime sleeping - Prolonged fluffed out feathers, General weakness or poor balance, etc.
