

Privacy Policy

Information Obligations According to Art. 13 and 14 GDPR

Protecting your personal data is of utmost importance to us. We process your data solely based on legal regulations (especially the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Telecommunications Act (TKG)). In this Privacy Policy, we inform you about the key aspects of data processing on our website.

2. **Data Collected and Purposes of Processing** We process personal data that you voluntarily provide to us, for example, through our contact form or by e-mail. The processed data includes, in particular:
 - **Contact form:** Name, e-mail address, and message.
 - **Website usage:** IP address, information about the browser and operating system, and access time.

These data are used solely for the purpose of contacting you, such as inquiries about sponsorship or general questions.

3. **Data Retention Period** Your personal data will be stored only as long as necessary for the respective purpose. In the case of inquiries via the contact form or by e-mail, your data will be stored for a maximum of 6 months and then deleted, unless there are statutory retention obligations.
4. **Cookies and Web Analytics** Our website uses cookies to improve user experience. However, no cookies are used for analytics or tracking purposes. For web analytics, we use the web hosting service Hostinger, which provides us with information on how many people visit our website and at which times. This data is anonymized and not used for marketing purposes. No detailed tracking of individual users takes place.
5. **Data Sharing with Third Parties** We do not share your personal data with third parties unless required by law or you have expressly given your consent.
6. **Your Rights as a Data Subject** You have the right to:
 - Obtain information about the processing of your data (Art. 15 GDPR)
 - Request correction of inaccurate or incomplete data (Art. 16 GDPR)
 - Request deletion of your data (Art. 17 GDPR), if they are no longer necessary or if you withdraw your consent
 - Request restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR)
 - Object to the processing of your data (Art. 21 GDPR)
 - Request data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)
