Match Your Story to the Criteria

Don't just answer the question
— address what the judges are
really asking. Look at the
judging criteria and reflect
their language in your
answers.

Be Clear, Not Clever

Big words don't win awards — authenticity and clarity do. Focus on what you've done, what the result was, and why it matters.

3

Get a Second Set of Eyes (or a Writer!)

Even the best business owners struggle to write about themselves. Ask someone else to read it — or get help writing it professionally (yes, that's a thing!).

Pro tip:

Judges are reading hundreds of submissions. Make yours stand out with clean structure, confidence, and clarity.
