Emergency Aid of Boulder City has been a pillar of support for the community since 1931, providing critical assistance to residents facing financial hardship. On-Site Pantry

Stocked with non-perishable staples, fresh produce, and frozen meats, our pantry provides essential groceries to BC residents facing food insecurity.

Financial Aid

Financial aid may be provided to residents in temporary crisis and can be used to help pay for rent, utilities, and other urgent needs.

Community Events

We support and participate in special programs throughout the year to address specific needs such as Angel Tree gifts and back-to-school supply drives.

Stranded Traveler Assistance

Services such as limited emergency fuel funds, travel food bags, and one-way bus tickets may be offered to qualified persons who are truly stranded.
