




















Gold Leaf Paintings

The paintings in the gold leaf collection are created using a gilding process that involves applying very thin sheets of gold (or similar metal alloys) to a surface or shape, giving it a shiny and elegant appearance. This ancient technique is used to decorate objects, furniture, walls, canvases, and even leather, and is applied to surfaces previously prepared with a "mission," a type of special glue.











Baroque Paintings

Italian Baroque art is an artistic and architectural style born in Rome in the early 17th century. It aimed to amaze and astonish the viewer through grandeur, the use of contrasting colors, chiaroscuro, curved lines, and complex, dynamic forms. This style, in contrast to the harmony and balance of the Renaissance, sought a strong emotional impact, often linked to the Catholic Counter-Reformation, using theatricality and excess to celebrate the power of the Church and the nobility.












