**2742 Ash Trees on Riverside with Ash Dieback**

The two trees that had been in question following Mr Stewart-Brown's survey have been confirmed. The one to the right of the butterfly garden is just within ownership of the council.

The one to the left of the wall, opposite Glandwr, does not belong to the council.

It was suggested that the latter is subject to the National Resources Wales and therefore not within the council's purview to deal with. It was unanimously agreed that the Clerk should inform NRW of the state of the trees and that Mr Stewart- Brown's report included a deadline of 90 days for removal (as of today 7 days of the deadline remains).

It was unanimously agreed that Cllr Hather and the Clerk are to confirm that the tree to the right of the butterfly garden, is indeed an ash. (This was done early morning of the 11<sup>th</sup>).

It was also unanimously agreed that Cllr Coldrick speak to the resident who lives opposite the tree to inform him of the situation.

It was unanimously agreed that when this has been done, that the Clerk should action the removal of the tree, as discussed and obtain the necessary waiver.

It was agreed that the remaining wood to be placed with the other ash logs in Riverside Gardens. This would then be advertised by the Clerk for people to collect what they wanted for a small donation. Any monies to then be put towards plants for the garden. The Clerk to confirm how these donations need to be recorded.
