CALL FOR SERVICE PROVIDERS

Plastic-Free Nile: Youth-Led Cleanup & Advocacy Juba, South Sudan

1. Background

Save the Nile is implementing a 6-month project titled **Plastic-Free Nile: Youth-Led Cleanup & Advocacy** aimed at reducing plastic pollution along the Nile River in Juba.

The project will mobilize over 100 youth volunteers, conduct 6 monthly cleanup campaigns, deliver 10+ school workshops, and engage communities through media and policy advocacy.

To support implementation, Save the Nile seeks qualified service providers to deliver logistics and technical services across multiple project activities.

2. Objective of the Assignment

The objective is to engage reliable service providers to support the planning and delivery of cleanup campaigns, workshops, and community engagement activities over a period of six months.

3. Scope of Work

Service providers may apply for one or more of the following service areas:

a) Transport Services

- Provide transport for approximately 100 volunteers during monthly cleanup activities (6 events)
- Support movement of materials and equipment to and from activity sites

b) Waste Collection and Disposal

- Collect and safely dispose of plastic waste generated during 6 cleanup events
- Coordinate with local authorities or disposal sites

c) Event Logistics

- Provide tents, chairs, and PA systems for:
 - 1 project launch event
 - 6 cleanup events
 - 2 policy dialogues



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d) Cleanup Materials Supply

- Supply gloves, waste bags, and protective gear for 100+ participants across 6 cleanup events.

e) Photography and Videography

- Document key activities including:
 - Project launch
 - Monthly cleanups (6 events)
 - Selected workshops and advocacy events
- Provide edited photos and short video highlights

f) Printing and Branding

- Design and print banners, posters, and visibility materials for project activities
- Support branding for campaigns and outreach

4. Deliverables

Service providers will be expected to:

- Deliver services according to agreed schedules
- Provide quality and timely execution during all assigned activities
- Submit invoices and any required supporting documentation
- Coordinate with Save the Nile team before and during activities

5. Duration

The assignment will run from April to September 2026, aligned with project activities, including:

- Monthly cleanups (Months 2–6)
- Workshops and awareness campaigns (ongoing)
- Key events such as launch and 2 policy dialogues

6. Payment Terms

- Payments will be made via Mobile Money or bank transfer only
- No cash payments will be made
- Payments are processed weekly and may take approximately two weeks to reach accounts
- Providers must submit invoices in advance of scheduled activities and ensure all documentation is complete



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7. Qualifications

Applicants should:

- Be based in or able to operate in Juba
- Demonstrate relevant experience in similar assignments
- Show capacity to deliver services reliably over multiple engagements
- Be responsive and able to meet scheduled timelines
