


Revelation of God

Understanding the Revelation of God

God has revealed himself to his people by many names in the times past. God revealed himself to Abraham as ' El-Shaddai ' – Almighty God, Nothing is Impossible with him (Genesis 17:1) and Most High God Above all gods (Genesis 14:22). At Creation God revealed himself as ' Elohim ' Lord God (Genesis 1:1) Lord God Created Man (Genesis 2:7). God revealed himself to Moses as ' I am that I am ' (Exodus 3:14) and as the God of Abraham , the God of Isaac , and the God of Jacob (Exodus 3:6) God who keeps his covenant for generations. God revealed himself to David as the Lord of Host (Lord with powerful army)-(1 Samuel 17:45 , 2 Samuel 5:10). King David was protected and fought his enemies by the Lord of Host. King Nebuchadnezzar knew God as God of Shadrach , Meshach , Abednego, who saved them from the hands of the king and of fire (Daniel 3:28). King Darius knew God as God of Daniel who saved Daniel from lion's mouth (Daniel 6:26). People knew God according to the revelation of him and how he wished to manifest himself to them according to his purpose.

Revelation of God to the Church in this present times.
You must understand how God desires his church to have the knowledge and revelation of him. That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory,

may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him (Ephesians 1:17). Through the knowledge of our Lord we have received divine power pertain to our life and godliness (2 Peter 1:3).

We worship the Triune God , Our God is revealed and manifested as the Father and the Son and the Holyspirit.

Let me explain this to you, In the Beginning God (Genesis 1:1) God is the beginning and the end, the alpha and omega (Rev 21:6). This One God came in the flesh (1Timothy 3:16), Son of God means God in flesh. when He came in the flesh as Son, still the father was in the heaven, He came from the bosom of the Father (Jn 1:18). The Son looked up to heaven and prayed saying, my Father (John 11:41). Holyspirit proceeds (come forth) from inside the Father (John 15:26). When Holyspirit proceeds from inside the father, the father is still in heaven seated on his throne. Holyspirit is presence of the father and reveals deeps things of God to us (1Corin 2:10-12).

Let's see the revelation of the Triune God.

We are Baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holyspirit (Mathew 28:19).

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holyspirit, be with you all (2 Corinthians 13:14). When Jesus was baptized at Jordan river we see heavens opened and the Holyspirit descending as dove and voice came from the father this is my beloved son in whom

I'm well pleased (Mathew 3:16&17, Luke 3:21&22). There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. There are different kinds of ministry, but the same Lord Jesus Christ. There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God the Father at work (1 Corinthians 12:4-6).

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over everything on all earth (Genesis 1:26).

Nature of the Triune God (God the Father , God the Son , God the Holy Spirit).

1. God is Spirit (John 4:24, 2 Corin 3:17, 1 Corin 2:11)
2. God is Life (Jn 14:6 , 1 Jn 5:11&12 , Jn 1:4 ,
Psalms 36:9 , Deut 30:20)
3. God is Love (1 Jn 4:17 , Jn 3:16, 1 Jn 3:1)
4. God is Truth (Jn 3:16 , Rom 3:4 , Jn 17:7)
5. God is Light (Jn 1:5 , 1Tim 6:16 , Jn 8:12 ,
James 1:17)
6. God is Word (Jn 1:1 , Jn 1:14 , Rev 19:13 , 1 Jn 5:7).

Attributes of Triune God

1. God is Almighty(Nothing is Impossible with Him)
(Genesis 17:1 , Jeremiah 32:17 , Job 42:2)
2. God is Omni-Present (He is Present everywhere)
(Psalms 139:7&8 , Jeremiah 23:23&24 , 1Kings 8:27)

3. God is Elohim (The Creator of the Universe)
(Gen 1:1 , Isaiah 45:12 , Ge 2:7 , Colossians 1:16).
4. God is Omni-scient (All Knowing) (Psalms 147:5 ,
1 Jn 3:20 , Proverbs 15:3 , Heb 4:13).
5. God is Master Communicator (He can talk to
everything eg: man , wind , water , animals , fish ,
tree etc)
6. God is First and the Last (Alpha and Omega)
no one is before him and no one after him. (Rev 1:8,
Isaiah 44:6 , Rev 22:13).
7. God is Immortal – Eternal ,Unchanging and forever
alive (God lives forever and cannot die, He is the
Source of Life and everything exists because
of him.) (1Tim 6:16 , Ps 90:2 , Daniel 6:26).

Character of Triune God

1. God is Good (Ps 34:8 , Nahum 1:7 , Ps 100:5)
2. God is Faithful (1 Corin 1:9 , 2 Tim 2:13 , Ps 36:5)
3. God is Righteous and Just (Ps 145:17 , Deut 32:4 ,

4. God is Merciful (Ps 103:8 , Eph 2:4 , Titus 3:5)
5. God is Unchanging (Malachi 3:6 , Heb 13:8 ,

6. God is our Provider (Gen 22:14 , Philippians 4:19,

7. God is our Healer (Exodus 15:26 , Ps 103:2&3 ,

8. God is our Saviour (1 Jn 4:14 , Titus 2:13 , Luke 2:11,

Let's understand the each Person of Triune God separately :

Lord Jesus introduced God to his disciples as Father, Call your God as your Father. And call no man your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven (Mathew 23:9). Pray like this: Our Father in heaven (Mathew 6:9). When you pray; shut the door and pray to your father. Then your Father, who sees everything, will reward you.(Mathew 6:6). For your Father knows what you need before you ask him (Mathew 6:8). Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven (Mathew 5:16). Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God (1 Jn 3:1). And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, “Abba, Father!” (Galatians 4:6).

The Revelation of God to the new testament church is the God is our Father, Church is the pillar and ground of truth (1Tim 3:15).

1. Father of Spirits – Father of Born Again Spirits
As we have father of our flesh so our God is the father of our spirit (Heb 12:9). God is Spirit (Jn 4:24). He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth(born again) and new life through the Holy Spirit (Titus 3:5). As we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall

also bear the image of the heavenly (1 Corinthians 15:49). The Holyspirit himself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God (Romans 8:16).

2. Perfect Father - Be perfect, as your Father in heaven is perfect (Mathew 5:48). Our Father is perfect in love, He loves the good and bad , the righteous and unrighteous without any partiality (Mathew 5:45). God is Holy means God is love, and in love abides holiness, without loving no one can live holy. Some say holy holy and filled with anger, envy, hatred, cant love their own family, this is not holy. When a person is living in love he is living holy, practice love. Without forgiving you cannot love, God forgave us and loved us and God loved us and forgave us. Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you (Colossians 3:13). Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God (1 John 3:1). The love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us (Romans 5:5).

3. Good Father - The Lord is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him (Nahum 1:7). Good Father who gives good gifts to his children (Mathew 7:11). Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, who does not change, neither shadow of turning (James 1:17).

4. Father of Mercies and all Comfort - Blessed be God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort. He comforts us every time we have trouble (2 Corinthians 1:3&4). It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness (Lamentations 3:22 &23). But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us (Ephesians 2:4). By his mercy he saved us (Titus 3:5). As a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you (Isaiah 66:13).

5. Helping Father – Father who helps us in difficult times (Mathew 10:17-20). The Father who helps us in our weakness (Romans 8:26).

Son Of God – Lord Jesus Christ

Son of God means God in flesh (1 Timothy 3:16), Word became flesh (John 1:14). For thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name (Psalms 138:2).

Who is the Son Of God ?

1. Son of God is the Saviour of the world - The Father sent the Son to be the Saviour of the world (1 John 4:14), For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life (John 3:16).

2.Son of God is the atonement for the whole world -
He is the atonement for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world (1 John 2:2). Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world (John 1:29).

3.Son of God is the Lord of Heaven and the Earth -
Jesus said, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth (Mathew 28:18). He is far above all the rule and authority, power and dominion (Ephesians 1:20-22).

4.Son of God is the Judge of the Living and dead - The Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom (2 Timothy 4:1). God hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by Jesus whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead (Acts 17:31).

5.Son of God is the Head of the Church and Saviour of the Body - Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body (Ephesians 5:23). when God raised Jesus from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: And God hath put all things under his(Jesus) feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all (Ephesians 1:22 &23)

What do we receive from Jesus?

1. Forgiveness of Sin through Jesus - In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins (Colossians 1:14). Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins (Acts 13:38).

2. New Birth - Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit (John 3:5&6). Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever (1 Peter 1:23). Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures (James 1:18).

3. Eternal Life - I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly (John 10:10). He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God. (1 John 5:13&14).

4. Adoption as Sonship - But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name (John 1:12). The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God (Romans 8:16).

5. Reconciliation to God through Jesus - That God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not counting their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation (2 Corinthians 5:19). And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven (Colossians 1:20).

6. Gift of Righteousness - Every religion say you need to attain righteousness by own works to receive blessings and to see God. But Lord has given us the gift of righteousness as free gift to live righteously and receive blessings and see God. For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ (Romans 5:17). For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believeth (Romans 10:4). But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe (Romans 3:21 &22).

How Relevant is Jesus today? Faith in the Lord is practical to today's life, in his name you can cast out demons, and lay hands on the sick and they shall be healed, and anything deadly and infectious things cannot harmful you through any means.

And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover (Mark 16:15)

HolySpirit

Holyspirit is God, God is a Spirit (John 4:24), Lord is that Spirit (2 Corinthians 3:17). Holyspirit is given as gift to those who believe in the Lord(Acts 2:38). Holyspirit proceeds from the Father (Jn 15:26) and fills us and dwells in us and Holyspirit has made his home in our body, which is the temple of the Holyspirit (1 Corinthians 3:16). And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him (Mathew 3:16). And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance (Acts 2:4).

Who is the Holyspirit to us?

Holyspirit is our Comforter, called to one's side, especially. called to one's aid. And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him;

for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you (John 14:16&17). But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you (Jn 14:26). He shall testify of Jesus (Jn 15:26). Jesus said, I will send comforter unto you. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they believe not on me; Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged. I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you (Jn 16:7-14).

Holyspirit is the Spirit of Adoption – You have received the Spirit of adoption, and by him we cry, Abba, Father (Romans 8:15) And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father (Galatians 4:5&6).

Holyspirit helps us to pray - Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit himself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered (Romans 8:26).

Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit (Ephesians 6:18).

Holyspirit is the Spirit of Grace - And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son (Zechariah 12:10).

Holyspirit is the Spirit of Faith - We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak (2 Corinthians 4:13).

Role of the Holyspirit in the Life of Believers.

1. Holyspirit makes you to Worship the Father in the Spirit and Truth - when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth (John 4: 23 & 24). For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh (Philippians 3:3).

2. Holyspirit has baptized you into the body of Christ - For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, and have been all made to drink into one Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:13).

3.Holyspirit will make you the witness of Christ – By the power of the Holyspirit we are the witness of Christ. But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and you shall be witnesses unto me (Acts 1:8). And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great grace was upon them all (Acts 4:33). And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people (Acts 6:8).

4.Holyspirit Empowers you and gives the special gifts and manifestations for the work of the ministry. But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues (1 Corinthians 12:7-10).

Believer's Life in the Spirit

After receiving the Holyspirit you are free from the sinful nature of the flesh and you are not carnal minded. But you are Spirit minded and received new nature of God. Those who are having the old sinful nature set their mind on the things of the flesh and desires of the flesh and they cannot please God nor obey the commandments of God and by nature they are enemies of God.

But you are born again of the Spirit and the Holy Spirit dwells in you and you don't have carnal mind but spirit mind and you have set your mind on the things of the spirit which is life and peace (Rom 8:2-8). We have the mind of Christ (1 Corin 2:16). But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His (Romans 8:9). Because you are born again and you live in the Spirit and have set your mind on the things of the spirit, so you walk in the Spirit (Galatians 5:25). Because you walk in the Spirit you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh and the Spirit desires against the flesh (Galatians 5:16). Walking in the fellowship of the Holy Spirit (2 Corin 13:14). Noah walked with God (Genesis 6:9). Enoch walked with God (Genesis 3:24). Today we all can walk with God as Noah and Enoch walked in the fellowship of the Spirit. And Abraham was called the friend of God (James 2:23) He experienced friendship and fellowship with God. And the Lord God walking in the Eden garden in the cool of the day to fellowship with Adam (Genesis 3:8). And you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law (Galatians 5:18). Do not live on the rules and regulations of the commandments but live by the Spirit, Jesus was led by the spirit (Mathew 4:1) Apostles were led by the spirit (Acts 2:4). We must be led by the Spirit, As the ship is moved by the wind in the big sea, without the wind ship cannot be moved from one place to another.

So we must be moved by the Spirit in all areas of the life. As an Eagle flies and moves in the wind so we are moved by the spirit, learn to be moved by the spirit. And the Spirit of the Lord began to move samson (Judges 13:25). Go in the leading of the Spirit, Do as Spirit of God guides you, Don't force yourself to take any decision but wait for the spirit guidance and instructions, for He will tell you whether to do or not and what to do and how to do it. Moses asked the Lord, who shall you send with me to lead the children of Israel into the promised land of Canaan? And the Lord answered Moses, For mine Angel shall go before thee, and bring thee in unto the land of Canan, Holyspirit is that Angel who led them. And be filled with the Spirit (Ephesians 5:18) by Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God (Ephesians 5:19-21). Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit (Eph 6:18)
