

1.] Why Rodent Prevention Matters

RODENTS CAN:

- SPREAD DISEASES LIKE HANTAVIRUS AND SALMONELLA.
- DAMAGE ELECTRICAL WIRING, LEADING TO FIRE HAZARDS.
- CONTAMINATE FOOD AND SURFACES.
- HARM YOUR HOME'S COMFORT AND VALUE.

PROACTIVE PREVENTION IS KEY TO AVOIDING THESE RISKS.

2.] Prevention Strategies

- SEAL ENTRY POINTS
- MAINTAIN CLEANLINESS
- PROPER WASTE MANAGEMENT
- ELIMINATE NESTING AREAS
- REGULAR INSPECTIONS
- USE TRAPS AND DETERRENTS

Seal Entry Points

RODENTS CAN ENTER THROUGH SMALL GAPS. TAKE THESE STEPS:

- INSPECT THE BUILDING EXTERIOR FOR CRACKS, HOLES, OR GAPS.
- SEAL OPENINGS WITH STEEL WOOL, CAULK, OR METAL FLASHING.
- INSTALL DOOR SWEEPS AND REPAIR DAMAGED SCREENS.



Maintain Cleanliness

A CLEAN HOME REDUCES RODENT ATTRACTANTS:


- STORE FOOD IN AIRTIGHT CONTAINERS.
- CLEAN SPILLS AND CRUMBS IMMEDIATELY.
- EMPTY TRASH BINS DAILY AND USE RODENT-PROOF CONTAINERS.



Proper Waste Management

MANAGE WASTE TO DETER RODENTS:


- USE SEALED, RODENT-RESISTANT BINS.
- SCHEDULE REGULAR WASTE COLLECTION.
- KEEP OUTDOOR DUMPSTER AREAS CLEAN AND SECURE.



Eliminate Nesting

REMOVE POTENTIAL RODENT HABITATS:

- CLEAR CLUTTER, SUCH AS UNUSED BOXES OR EQUIPMENT.
- KEEP STORAGE AREAS ORGANIZED AND OFF THE FLOOR.
- TRIM VEGETATION AND REMOVE DEBRIS AROUND THE BUILDING.



3.] Resident

Responsibilities

ENCOURAGE RESIDENTS TO CONTRIBUTE TO PREVENTION:

- REPORT SIGNS OF RODENTS IMMEDIATELY.
- FOLLOW FOOD STORAGE AND WASTE DISPOSAL GUIDELINES.
- KEEP SOURCED AREAS CLEAN AND CLUTTER-FREE.
