

Types of Background Checks

1. Employment Background Check

- Verifies work history, education, certifications, and references.
- May include criminal history and credit reports, depending on the job.

2. Criminal Background Check

- Searches for criminal records at local, state, and federal levels.
- Common for jobs in childcare, healthcare, and finance.

3. Credit Check

- Reviews financial history, including debt, bankruptcies, and payment records.
- Often used by landlords or for roles involving financial responsibility.

4. Tenant Background Check

 Combines criminal, credit, and eviction history to assess a potential tenant's reliability.

5. Driving Records Check

- Examines driving history, including accidents, DUIs, and license status.
- Essential for roles involving driving.

6. Identity Verification

 Confirms a person's identity using official documents like Social Security numbers, passports, or ID cards.

7. Professional License Verification

 Checks if a person has valid and active licenses required for their field (e.g., healthcare, law).

8. Education Verification

• Confirms degrees, certifications, and academic achievements.
