How many cookies are there on the plate now?
7. Anna places 3 books on a shelf. Her brother adds 4 more.
How many books are on the shelf now?
8. There are 2 frogs on a lily pad. Then 3 more frogs hop on.
How many frogs are there now?
9. Tom has 5 crayons in a box. He finds 3 more under the table and adds them.
How many crayons does he have now?
10. Sophia buys 1 chocolate cone and 2 strawberry cones.
How many ice cream cones does she have in total?
