5. A farmer picks 76 apples from one tree and 48 from another.

How many apples does he pick in total?

6. There are 59 books on one shelf and 64 on another shelf.

How many books are there in total?

7. Lily counted 36 butterflies in the garden in the morning and 57 in the afternoon.

How many butterflies did she see in total?

8. A truck carries 88 watermelons. Another truck brings 49 more.

How many watermelons are there now?

9. Noah read 67 pages of a book on Monday and 58 pages on Tuesday.

How many pages did he read in total?

10. A toy store sold 76 teddy bears in the morning and 39 in the afternoon.

How many teddy bears were sold that day?
