emotional pause.

**Place near light
or air current.
Don't overthink it.**

Gentle movement becomes
a silent signal.

*Let them approach
on their own terms.*

*What changes
in you when
it moves?*

Observe together. Or alone.

The mobile becomes
a habit of attention.

That's what they sense most.
