


Born Again

🌸 What Does It Mean to Be Born Again?

Jesus used the phrase born again to describe a new life that comes from God Himself—a spiritual birth that begins when we place our faith in Him.

The phrase “born again” also means “born from above,” reminding us that this new life begins with God—not human effort.

Being born again is not about becoming religious. It is about becoming alive.

Scripture tells us what Jesus said:


“I tell you the truth, unless you are born again, you cannot see the Kingdom of God.”

and that You rose again so that I could have new life.


I confess that I need You.

Being born again is the beginning—not the end.


You may grow slowly.
