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


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Explore Flores



<u>Itinerary</u>

Day I

Pick-up from the hotel in Labuan Bajo will be at 7:00 AM, after which we will head towards Wae Rebo. We will have lunch at Wae Rebo Lodge at 12:00 PM. followed by a ride to the trekking point using local bikes. The trek will begin at 2:00 PM, and upon arrival, we will be welcomed with a traditional ceremony at the main house in Wae Rebo. Enjoy the local coffee. the stunning views, and the warmth of the local people, before concluding the day with dinner.


Day 2

After coffee and breakfast, we will depart from the starting point at 8:00 AM and head towards Ruteng town, arriving by 10:00 AM. We will have lunch at Sky Terrace in Ruteng before continuing the journey to Rana Mese Lake. Following that, we will proceed to Bajawa town.

Day 3

Breakfast will be served at 7:00 AM. after which we will embark on the next leg of our journey to Wolo Bobo Hill. After enjoying the panoramic views at Wolo Bobo, we will continue to the Bena Traditional Village. We will immerse ourselves in the charm of Bena Village until 10:00 AM, before proceeding to the Malanage Hot Springs. Lunch will be at 1:00 PM in Bajawa town. Following lunch, we will resume our journey to Ende town, where we will check into the hotel. In the evening, we will have dinner at Mopis Restaurant, after which we will return to the hotel for the night.





Wae Rebo

Wae Rebo or Waerebo is a remote traditional village in Manggarai Regency, East Nusa Tenggara. Wae Rebo is one of the cultural tourism destinations in Manggarai Regency. Located at an altitude of 1,200 meters above sea level.

Lingko Cara Spider Rice Field

Lingko is a traditional farming system applied in Manggarai regency, Flores Indonesia, which is used to manage rice fields in a way similar to a spider's web. In this system, rice fields are divided into plots that lead from a central point, resembling the shape of a spider's web. This technique is not only effective in distributing water for irrigation, but also reflects the philosophy of cooperation between farmers in managing natural resources sustainably. Lingko is a symbol of local wisdom which prioritizes togetherness and balance between humans and nature.

Liang Bua Hobit Cave

An interesting limestone cave where series of excavations for archeological research were conducted, especially after the discovery of Homo Floresiensis was announced in 2003. The decorative stalagmites and stalactites inside the large 1,300m2 cave creates a lasting impression of the natural processes of how the cave was formed, preserved, and inhabited by humans, bringing alive a series of historical events.

Rana Mese Lake

Rana Mese Lake is located about 25 kilometers from Ruteng, Flores. This area offers amazing natural charm, especially for visitors who are looking for tranquility.

This lake covering an area of around 5 hectares and a depth of 43 meters is like a hidden paradise in the middle of a forest located at an altitude of 1,200 meters above sea level. This lake was formed from the violent eruption of Mount Ranaka around 400 years ago which caused the crater on the mountain to be covered with water and form a lake with steep edges.

Day 4

Wake up early at 4:00 AM to begin the journey to the next destination. At Kelimutu Volcano, witness the three differently colored lakes (a 20minute trek to the summit). Enjoy the spectacular sunrise, then return to the hotel for breakfast. At 10:00 AM, continue the journey to the Wologai Traditional Village, followed by a visit to a coffee plantation. Finally, enjoy lunch at Blue Stone Beach. Back Bajawa Town get the hotel and stay overnight

Day 5

After breakfast, we will continue our journey to a local distillery, where we will learn about the process of crafting traditional drinks and have the opportunity to sample them. Next, we will proceed to Ruteng town, where we will enjoy lunch at either Parikoro or Agape Restaurant. Following lunch, we will visit the Hobbit Cave and explore the fascinating history of the Floresiensis Homo sapiens. Afterward, we will return to Ruteng town and check into our hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 6

After breakfast at 7:00 AM, we will continue our journey to the Lingko Cara Spider Rice Fields. Following that, we will visit the Cunca Plias Waterfall. Afterward, we will return to Labuan Bajo, concluding the trip.





Bena Traditional Village

The history of the Bena Traditional Village begins with the long journey of their ancestors who are believed to have come from the Ende area, eastern Flores. According to stories passed down from generation to generation, their ancestors moved to the Bajawa area and founded Bena Village at the foot of Mount Inerie.

The name "Bena" itself is taken from the word "Ba'a Na" which means "resting place". This village has existed for more than 1,200 years and still maintains a rich cultural heritage and traditions

Malanage Hot Spring

Malanage Hot Spring is located in Dariwali Village about halfway between Bena and Gurusina Villages and unlike some hot springs in Flores, is entirely natural and unaltered. Here, in a pretty forest grove at the confluence of a hot and cold river, a series of shallow, babbling pools provide the perfect place relax and let the warm water melt away whatever aches your trekking and sightseeing around Bajawa has left you with. If you feel like exploring a little, there's a small cascade a short distance up the cold river.

Wolobobo Hill

Wolobobo Hill has a very beautiful and stunning view. From the top of the hill, visitors can witness the view of green mountains and valleys as well as the vast sea stretching in the distance. In addition, the hill is also surrounded by forests and coffee plants that provide a soothing sensation of nature.

The charming Wolobobo Hill is located in Turekisa Village, West Gelowa District, Ngada Regency, Flores, East Nusa Tenggara. It takes about 20-30 minutes by car from Bajawa City. The road access is quite good, but some parts of the road are potholed and uphill, so care must be taken.

Blue Stone Beach

If you are looking for a different tourist destination in Flores, East Nusa Tenggara (NTT), Penggajawa Beach or known as Batu Biru Beach could be the right choice. Located in Penggajawa Village, Nangapanda District, Ende Regency, this beach offers an unusual charm, namely the green and light blue rocks that decorate the beach. These rocks are smoothly rounded, providing a unique panorama that is not found on other beaches.



Kelimutu Lake is a crater lake at the top of Mount Kelimutu, Flores, East Nusa Tenggara. This lake is famous because it consists of three lakes with different colors, namely red, blue and white

Wologai Village

Wologai is a traditional village located in the Ende Lio area, precisely in Detusoko subdistrict, Ende Regency - East Nusa Tenggara. Wologai traditional village is about 12 kilometers from our Lodge (Kelimutu Crater Lake Ecolodge), reached by renting a car or motorbike. This traditional village is 800 years old with traditional building forms that are full of meaning.

Cunca Plias Waterfall

The valley area of Wae Lolos Village, Sano Ngoang District, is one that has beauty in the form of hidden waterfalls, one of which is the Cunca Plias waterfall. There are at least nine waterfalls located close together in the valley of Wae Lolos Village, Sano Nggoang District. The distance from people's houses to the location of the first waterfall called Cunca Plias is no less than two kilometers.
