

MEGHALAYA TRIP 2025-26



Itinerary as follows:

1st Day : Reach Guwahati and Transfer to Shillong via Umiam Lake

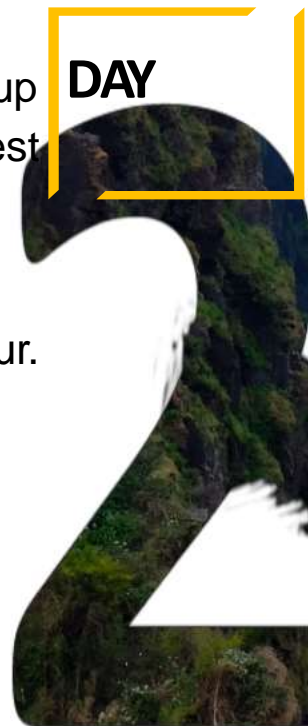
- Meet upon arrival at **Guwahati** Airport / Railway Station.
- After the initial introduction, we travel to **Shillong** which is famously known as the Scotland of the East and is at an altitude of 4908 feet above sea level.
- Visit to Umiam Lake and Later Explore Cafes and Local market of **Shillong** in the evening.
- Overnight stay in **Shillong**.

DAY



2nd Day : Shillong to Cherrapunji via Laitlum

- Breakfast will be served in the morning.
- **We will explore Laitlum Canyon, Cathedral Church, Don Bosco Museum,** After that, the group will head towards Cherrapunji (4,400 ft.), the wettest place in the world.
- En route, the group will visit **Elephanta falls** and **Shillong peak** for a short sightseeing tour.
- The rest of the day will be spent visiting waterfalls between Shillong and Cherrapunjee followed by exploring **Wakaba Falls** in the evening.
- Overnight stay at Cherrapunji.



3rd Day : Trek to Double Decker Bridge

- Post breakfast, we will visit **Mawsmai cave, seven sister falls** and later the group will head for trekking towards one of the UNESCO World Heritage sites - **Double Decker Living Roots Bridge**. If time permits, we shall go exploring and trekking to the **Rainbow Falls** as well. Later will cover **Nongriat village & Nohkallikai water falls**.
- Return to **Cherrapunji** by evening.
- Overnight stay at **Cherrapunji**.



4th Day : Cherrapunji s - Mawlynnong – Dawki and stay at Shnongpdeng

- We'll have an early breakfast, we'll continue on the road-trip further to **Mawlynnong Village**, also known as **Asia's Cleanest Village**.
- Afterward, we'll drive to **Dawki**, from there the **India-Bangladesh Border** is just 2 hours away. In here, you can roam around in between the **India-Bangladesh border** which is an unbarbed area free of any strict army vigilance, unlike most border areas.
- Finally, we'll head down to our riverside camps.
- Post-check-in, we'll have dinner followed by bonfire.
- Overnight at the campsite in **Shnongpdeng**.

5th Day : Dawki to Shillong

- After breakfast, the rest of the day is for adventure activities.
- The group will head off for adventure activities including cliff jumping and boating. Except for these two activities, anything else would be at a personal expense.
- Later, we'll drive back to **Shillong** with an evening at leisure , enroute we will explore Krangsuri falls
- Guests are free to explore the city in the evening as this will be the last day for the **Meghalaya** backpacking trip and by this time, we would have already covered all our itinerary checkpoints.
- Overnight Stay at **Shillong**.

6th Day : Shillong to Guwahati

- Breakfast will be served in the morning.
 - Post breakfast, the group will drive from **Shillong** to **Guwahati**.
 - On reaching **Guwahati**, you can head back home according to your own convenience.
 - The tour ends and we'll conclude our **Meghalaya** backpacking trip.
- *You are advised to book flights for Day 6 as the group will be reaching Guwahati around 5 PM, booking your flight tickets accordingly.

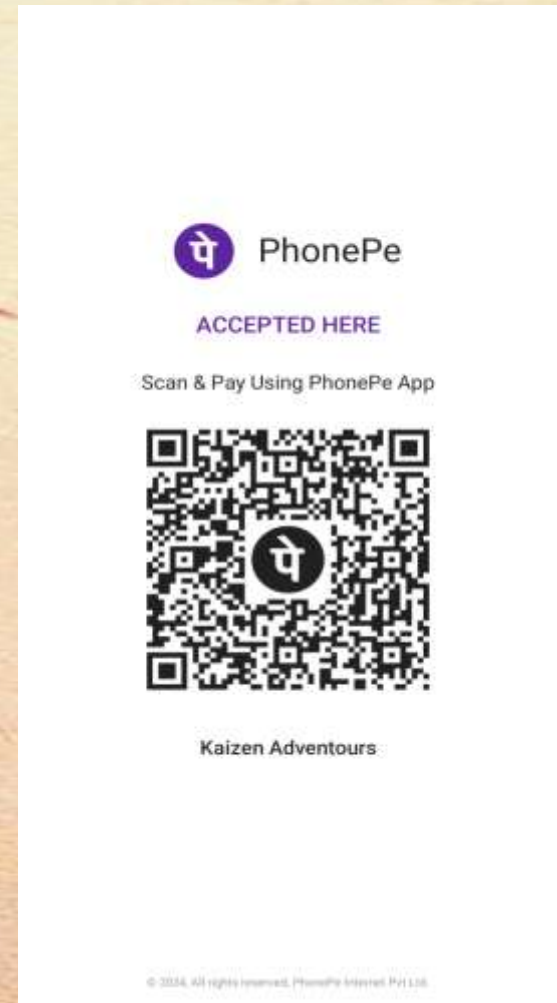

Cancellation Policy

- **No cancellations** will be taken over the **call or WhatsApp message**. Please reply to the email of the payment receipt that you have received at the time of booking regarding the cancellation.
- **Free Cancellation up to 60 days** before the departure date (**Booking amount is non-refundable**)
- **1st installment** will be made 60 days prior departure date
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within **59 days to 45 days** of the Departure Date then only **10% of the total trip cost** (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within **44 Days to 30 Days** of the Departure Date then only **25% of the total trip cost** (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within **29 Days to 15 Days** of the Departure Date then only **50% of the total trip cost** (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within **15 Days to 8 Days** of the Departure Date then only **75% of the total trip cost** (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within **7 Days from the Departure Date then 100% of the total trip cost** (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- You are **not applicable for a refund if you fail to show up** on the day of departure under the given timeline that has been provided to you beforehand.

- If a trek is called off at the last moment due to a natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc.) then the participants would be provided with a travel voucher for the same amount that can be used within 365 days of the issuance date for any package worth the same amount.
- If a trek/trip has to be aborted midway due to a natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc.). In that case, no refund would be provided.
- Kaizen Adventours will not bear any extra expense due to any natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc.).
