- EXAMPLES:** They don't live here, do they? No, they don't.  
 He doesn't play football, does he? No, he doesn't.  
 She likes to swim, doesn't she? Yes, she does.  
 You played basketball yesterday, didn't you? Yes, I did.

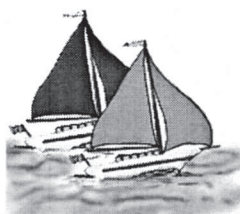

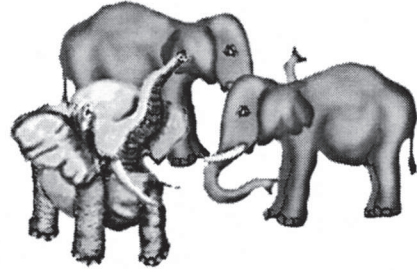
