Melanie lives <u>nearer to</u> the English School <u>than</u> John. Melanie lives <u>closer to</u> the English School <u>than</u> John.

**NOTE:** The meaning is the same.

Pamela and John live <u>the same distance from</u> the English School. Pamela lives <u>the same distance from</u> the English School <u>as</u> John. Pamela lives <u>as far from</u> the English School <u>as</u> John.

**NOTE:** The meaning is the same for the three sentences.

Jim lives the farthest from the English School.
