- **Upon successful completion** you will receive a WSET certificate and lapel pin, and will be able to use the associated WSET certified logo.

- Completion of **WSET Level 2** or equivalent knowledge strongly recommended
- Minimum age: 18
- Must present valid photographic ID on exam day
- Reasonable Adjustments available upon request
