The examination devices for our doctors, such as the ophthalmoscope, otoscope, and the instruments for removing small foreign bodies from the nose and ear, also clearly improve the quality of our care.
- **Improved Patient Experience:** The provision of new toys and comfort items has positively influenced the therapeutic environment, aiding in the emotional wellbeing of our young patients.



• **Comfort Items:** Your donation provided toys and comfort items, making the hospital experience less stressful for children and helping to create a more welcoming environment. Decoration of the walls makes the environment attractive and relaxing to the sick children.

Sandra is coming for weight review and resupply of plumpynuts.


Pillows are essential and caregivers are also using them.

• Improved Facilities: The donation helped us enhance our facilities, ensuring that new mothers and their babies receive the highest standard of care. The CTG machine new vital signs monitor is of great value in monitoring of Post natal mothers.



• **Comfort and Care Items:** The contribution of comfort items has significantly improved the emotional well-being of our patients during their stay. Babies' clothes, cotton wool, underwear have improved the hygiene of our clients. We would need more of the underwear next time.

#### Mattresses

We have received 10 mattresses from kids care which are of great value. The maternity ward which comprises of 35 beds. These 10 mattresses were placed in the surgical ward and part of post-natal.
