Housing

On-Post Housing

Fort Leavenworth's on-post housing is managed by Frontier Heritage Communities, offering a mix of historic and modern homes.

Features include:

- Variety of floor plans and layouts
- Utilities included in Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH)
- Walkable access to schools, commissary, PX, and recreational facilities
- Maintenance and community services provided by the housing office

Availability may vary based on rank, family size, and current occupancy. We recommend contacting Frontier Heritage Communities directly for waitlist details and eligibility.

Off-Post Housing

Many families choose to live in nearby communities, each offering its own blend of amenities, housing styles, and commute times.

Popular nearby areas include:

- Leavenworth & Lansing: Located just minutes from post, these towns offer a mix of rental properties and homes for sale, along with local shops, parks, and schools.

Fort Leavenworth Unified School District 207
