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Hi. I'm Elliot, and I'm glad to know that if you're reading this now, it's because there is at least the slightest or great (hopefully), interest in reading my book #MILLENNIALS IN NEW YORK. I'll tell you briefly how this story was born, how it was developed and how it ends up being published. As a member of generation X, I also had the age and perhaps the experiences of many of the millennials (and centenials who are beginning to live their own history), to live and experience the issues of our youth, passing through the passage of adulthood and ending with the maturity of the present. If I remember

correctly (I hope), this started about ten years ago, as a movie script, which tells the story at that time in the CDMX. Lacking experience and contacts, I had the idea a couple of years later to turn it into a novel, but this time adapted in the Anglo-Saxon world, and in this case in New York City. Since I live on the border, I have grown up influenced by both Mexican and American cultures. Although we must accept that one is always more influenced by the neighboring country, because of the commercial traditions of that country. So, my idea was to enter literary contests, send it to publishers, and during the process I made changes and polished the story and the characters. Unfortunately, I continued with the same answer, the lack of interest by publishers to publish it, and obviously the lack of contacts and guidance from an editor or representative. Certainly, the literary market has declined sharply from some time ago, and added to this, the lack of culture to read, as well as the interest to follow more foreign and commercial currents, which is very valid and respectable. While they also began to see new publishing methods such as private presses or selfpublishing like on Amazon and other sites. I decided to put my story away for a while. Fortunately, I think the

literary market and interest in reading has improved again, at least a little.

Due to destiny and personal reasons, I found myself in the emotional and creative need to resume this project. since in November 2024 I was diagnosed with skin cancer, type Nodular pigmented basocellular carcinoma, which at the beginning I was informed that it was a rare type of cancer, but apparently, there was not much risk of being dangerous; my doctors gave me much hope, since this type of cancer is attacked in the first instance by surgery, the tumor is removed and that's it. So I had high hopes for it. Unfortunately, my naivety and my lack of symptoms (since it is a silent cancer), caused me to carry it for almost eight years before I was diagnosed. My pathology tests after my second surgery, I came back positive, which meant that the cancer had spread. By June 2025, I have been diagnosed with melanoma cancer on my left foot, a much more dangerous and aggressive skin cancer than carcinoma, as it can quickly spread to the lymph nodes or blood system, causing metastasis to other organs such as lungs, liver, etc., including the bones. Now I am waiting for two surgeries that have been postponed for reasons beyond my control. I do not want to continue with this story about my health, since the

priority in talking to you about my book, but I had to make this parenthesis; so for the moment I continue with more scheduled surgeries, and what seems to be an uncertain process in matters of my health, since sometimes the symptoms that since then if they appeared, do not let me lead a "normal" life as any of you. Pain, dizziness, nausea, skin reactions, etc. Faced with the need to find a reason for my present that would stimulate me to continue, it is here where my projects make me enthusiastic again, to at least give them continuity and to carry them out at any cost. It fills me with illusion to achieve it, even if it means using most of my time to work on it. As well as my children (my three beautiful cats, Koko, Candy and Mizzy), who also fill me with strength to get up and take care of them, and receive their affection and love. That's why I decided to self-publish on Amazon, because it is the most viable alternative to my possibilities. Certainly my work is not only limited to writing, but also editing, layout, design, watching tutorials, programs, etc. Thanks to Artificial Intelligence (AI), and here I want to make it very clear, that all the text, the story, the idea, was 100% mine. I used AI mostly to create the cover design and images; as well as the translation and corrections in the English language for the English

market; and probably music, to create songs with my lyrics, for the book itself, because my idea is to add a plus to the traditional publishing world. I respect and value the work of illustrators and musicians, qualities that I lack, just a series of many ideas that wander through my creative head. While I am not in favor of using the AI as author or creator of a work almost total for a few instructions, if I am in favor that the At should be only a complement to add, contribute or polish a work that for reasons of skill or resources, can not be carried out by a single person, in this case, as those who work alone, in the absence of the same. As I mentioned before, this story is a work of years? not the result of an Al work for a couple of hours or days. I admit that thanks to the Al, this may help me to give a more attractive vision to the work, only in illustrative and auditory matters. As for the literary, I repeat it is 100% of my authorship. What I can't do much about is publicity, since as far as I know, paying for a promotion and/or marketing campaign, no matter how small it may be, requires investment, which is far from my possibilities for the moment. I live up to my medical, personal and family expenses So for that reason I thought I would write this little PDF book, pre-book, as a promo to tell you about my book #MILLENWALS IN NEW YORK; and be able to

distribute it for free. Via voluntary download from yourselves. made us think, reflect and understand our own actions towards those women, be it girlfriend, wife, sister, daughter, mother, friend, companion, etc., and get to know that special world of women.




# **#THE PROTAGONISTS**


characters, now set in New York.

In addition, her perception of freedom and selfacceptance of emotions and ideals, was that plus that



### Nicole Smith







and I know that everyone will have their own opinion and taste for a different one, and that is part of the enrichment of creative diversity. I hope you like it.

































This dating is practically about to end, so I thought it appropriate to conclude by putting the cherry on the cake, and what better with what I have called the Soundtrack of the book. I know, it sounds weird, strange, ridiculous maybe, but if movie stories have their own soundtrack. Why not books, which are also stories? Maybe it's not common, or I don't know if there are already books that have their soundtrack (of course, some of them before being movies or series), but I imagine that people like me, when we have the opportunity to write, it's to write books, not songs; although in my defense I must confess that at

one time I used to write my lyrics for songs, which were not even remotely possible to become songs, since I didn't have that gift of writing music, you know, that of reading staves, musical notes, etc. For a while in my youth, I took guitar lessons in cultural centers, and then violin lessons, ending years later with a frustration of playing only maracas. Well, at least I tried. But thanks to technology, and especially Artificial Intelligence, I have been able to fulfill that dream. I know that many will not agree with this tool to create, and I agree that there is nothing like the innate talent with which one is born, or at least to have the qualities to study and learn music; it is admirable. And therefore, to be able to compose organic music. Personally, as I said at the beginning of this book, the lyrics are 100% of my own creation, both in Spanish and English (although in the latter language I had to help a little just to find the rhyme frames), in order to keep the essence of my original lyrics, since it is my native language. In fact, it was a very interesting process to learn, at least the basics, such as tempos, stems, harmonies, musical genres, rhythms, melodies, even to be able to work with the Al itself, since it is not enough to write a prompt and boom, and the song is ready, at least for me it was not like that. Perhaps many who have used

this technology, have realized that when you don't know how to master at least enough to create something acceptable, the music and / or songs are very generic, in other words very similar, or very X. Certainly the lyrics, influence a lot that the AI, can also have something more instructed and defined to be able to square with the sounds and rhythms, working continuously in a series of trial and error, to be able to achieve what in creativity intuited to be able to do in reality. This experience made me learn, experiment and above all, enjoy every moment of musical creation. I am still a neophyte in this art, but believe me I was surprised with my results, even genres that I don't often listen to, I loved them.

To tell you now more about the process of my creation of lyrics, as I mentioned, I have more experience in this area, yet I had to focus on writing in rhyme, since I usually did it in prose; and to be able to tell and/or reflect, depending on the song, the story or the essence of the character, as well as his personal context, so it was also a challenge. Opening the emotional part of them and being able to translate it into a musical lyric is not as easy as it seems. I didn't think it would take me a considerable time in the whole process of the soundtrack, but as I repeat, it was an experience that I would repeat again.

Regardless of the fact that the songs were being created for the book, this experience also helped me a lot in my health process, because creativity is like that strength that makes me get up and be active, something that my body lacks because of my condition, and sometimes it was very frustrating, that my mind was at 100 processing ideas, and my body was not in tune with it. But well, I understand it and rest when it is already very necessary.

About the songs that I decided to officially add to the soundtrack, it is a diversity of genres, as well as lyrics. Ballads, electronic, pop, house, dance, urban, among others (even reggaeton), a genre that I didn't think to use, but I loved how it turned out. As well as very deep lyrics and great message, as fun lyrics and very festive atmosphere. Both the songs and the lyrics can be found and listened to on different music platforms, such as Spotify, Youtube, Apple Music, Deezer, Amazon Music, among others. 












































# AWARENESS & SUPPORT

Skin cancer is a disease in which skin cells begin to multiply uncontrollably; and despite being a common type of cancer, particularly in Mexico it is unknown among us, either due to lack of interest in the subject, ignorance or lack of culture to deal with symptoms to which we play down importance, since at the beginning (sometimes years), it is an abnormal spot that does not cause pain, but simply until we see that it is growing, or in a routine medical checkup, we are recommended to see a

specialist, as happened to me. Basal cell and squamous cell carcinomas are two of the most common types of skin cancer that exist. They begin, respectively, in the basal and squamous layers of the skin. Both can usually be cured, but treatment is expensive and can leave scars. The pigmented nodular basal cell carcinoma was the first one detected in my right flank, and after two surgeries in that area, the cancer persists.

Melanoma, the third most common type of skin cancer, begins in melanocytes. Of all skin cancers, melanoma causes the most deaths because of its tendency to spread to other parts of the body, including vital organs such as the brain and liver. Melanoma was the second skin cancer detected on my left foot, for which I have been awaiting surgery since May 2025.

This small piece of information is to invite you to become aware and informed about this type of cancer. I know that many women are in the habit of taking extra care of their skin and being aware of any anomaly that may occur.

Unfortunately for many others, due to lack of information and/or economic resources, they don't pay as much attention as they should. In most men, beyond the daily cleaning of our skin, it is very common not to have

much care or extra attention to it. Therefore, I invite you again, to get informed, and especially to take care of any anomaly in your skin.

In particular, I can be certain that in addition to having the dreams that have accompanied me throughout my life, a very significant one is to be healthy again, to be able to beat cancer in order to continue dreaming and creating. Unfortunately, as I have shared with you, the circumstances in my recovery process are not in my favor. One of the medical recommendations, in my case, the ideal would be to move to a different city, since where I currently live and have lived most of my life because I was born here (Mexicali, Baja California, Mexico), has been for years one of the geographic places with the highest temperatures during the summer. (which covers parts of spring and autumn), as well as one of the hottest in the world, with temperatures between 86- and 100.4degrees Fahrenheit during spring (mid) and autumn (early); in summer, the most critical temperatures are between 107.6- and 118.4-degrees Fahrenheit on ordinary days, and on critical days, they exceed 122 degrees Fahrenheit. As you can understand, solar radiation is very intense here. For someone in my condition it is NOT advisable to be here. But it is not easy to leave here either, when I have no family outside, or the resources to do so, so the most I can do for the moment, is to take care of myself with what is in my hands. I cover my skin from head to toe (sleeves, neck, hair, glasses, umbrella, etc.), people look at me strangely, I practically look like a mummy because I'm all covered up, and I try to go out as early as possible, or when the sun goes down. Sometimes because of my medical appointments, I have to be more exposed to daylight, but no way, it's part of my battle.

I want to make it clear that despite all this, I don't feel like a victim, nor a hero. I'm just a human being who had to deal with this, and I have no choice but to face it. I try to make something good out of the bad. Maybe you are in good or excellent health, and I'm glad for that. However, I'm also aware that unfortunately there are many people a thousand times worse off than I am; whether due to health, geographic or any other kind of violence or personal issues. Yes, I have not had a very good time these last few months due to recent issues with my body, but fortunately I'm not in bed 24 hours a day, or with a catheter, oxygen or any device on which my life depends. That's why I decided to do this, now that I can still move, I can still do the basic things and even though

I have to sometimes pause, slow down, or even have days when my body can't respond to me, I have decided to live one day at a time.




