ABOUT ITANAGAR

Itanagar, the capital of Arunachal Pradesh, is nestled in the foothills of the Eastern Himalayas, providing a picturesque backdrop of rolling hills, verdant valleys, and serene rivers. Located at an elevation of around 750 meters, it is a scenic and culturally rich city that reflects the diversity and natural beauty of the region. An important tourist destination is the Jawaharlal Nehru State Museum in Itanagar itself which showcases aspects of the multi-faced colourful way of life in Arunachal Pradesh. Around Itanagar, several captivating destinations offer a blend of natural beauty and cultural richness. Just 115 km away lies Ziro Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage tentative site known for its picturesque landscapes, lush paddy fields, and the unique culture of the Apatani tribe. About 300 km away from Itanagar is the Dirang hill station which offers a salubrious climate apart from its varied attractions such as scenic valleys, fruit orchids, migrating birds, pristine rivers and enchanting views of the rolling hills covered in trees. Pasighat, the "Gateway to Arunachal Pradesh," is 260 km away from Itanagar. There, one can explore the Daying Ering Wildlife Sanctuary which is a biodiversity hotspot and adventurous river rafting on the mighty Siang River. These places represent a picture of the natural and cultural beauty of the region surrounding Itanagar.

The institute is powered by a well-balanced mix of: a) 6 Engineering departments (Agriculture, Civil, Mechanical, Computer Science, Electrical, Electronics and Communication), b) 5 Science departments (Forestry, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Humanities), and c) a center for Management Studies.
