

TONGUES OF FIRE

We are starting a new series comprising four books under the title "witnesses". During the earthly life Jesus limited his activities to the territories of Israel. But, the good news of salvation brought by Jesus was not to be limited to a particular people of area. So, after the resurrection Jesus sent out the apostles to the whole world. The present series depicts how they accomplished this task by preaching the Gospel from Jerusalem to Rome, the capital of the then known western

world. These stories are based on the book of the Bible called "The Acts of the Apostles".

The present book depicts the events that took place in Jerusalem from the coming of the Holy Spirit to the election of the deacons (Acts 1-6). The title "tongues of fire" refers to the mission of the apostles to proclaim the gospel with strength and zeal. The outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost marked the solemn inauguration of the Church of Christ. The feast of Pentecost was one of the three major feasts of the Jews, the others being Passover and the feast of tabernacles.

Its name, meaning "fiftieth" derives from the fact that it was celebrated on the fiftieth day after the Passover. The pilgrims who came to Jerusalem for the Passover feast usually stayed on till the Pentecost.

The coming of the Holy Spirit marked a transformation in the lives of the apostles. They were illiterate fishermen from Galilee, who were hiding in Jerusalem for fear of the Jews, but suddenly became courageous and eloquent speakers. Those who fled at the arrest of Jesus and denied him when questioned started proclaiming in public that the one they crucified has risen from death and that he is the only Savior. Miracles of healing confirmed their preaching. Touched by the Holy Spirit, the audience could understand the apostles, speech in their own language. As the confusion of language at the "tower of Babel" marked the scattering of peoples, so the coming of the Holy Spirit initiated the gathering of nations into one people.

The people who repented and believed in Jesus Christ were baptized and became one family. The primitive Christian community had four characteristics. 1. They believed in the teachings of the apostles; 2. shared all material goods; 3. celebrated the memory of Jesus' death and resurrection in the "breaking of the bread" and 4. were united in prayer.

Thousands of people were converted and accepted Jesus as the only Saviour and Lord. But, the Jewish leaders, adamant in their convictions, were determined to destroy the infant Church. Even though they tried to stop the apostles from speaking about Christ through threats and persecution, the Church was growing fast. As the

believers took refuge in ever more ardent prayers, the Holy Spirit gave them strength and courage for bearing witness to Jesus Christ. The episode of Ananias and Sapphira, as well as the election of the deacons show how the apostles dealt with the internal problems of the Church. This ideal picture of the primitive Church is a model and source of inspiration for the Church of Christ at all times. All our actions should be guided by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.












As promised by the Prophet Joel, God has poured out His Spirit. You know the man Jesus. Many of you have witnessed the miracles he performed.




You crucified Him. But God raised him from the dead. We are his witnesses.








What must we do now?



God's promise was made to you and all the people in the world.



The Apostles were released with strict warning. They returned to the upper-room.




Lord God, creator of heaven and earth, listen to our prayers. Take note of the threat against the disciples of your beloved son.


Strengthen us to work miracles and signs in the name of Jesus Christ.

As they prayed, the house where they were assembled rocked. They all were filled with the Holy Spirit.




Strengthened by the spirit, the Apostles preached with greater courage. Many miracles were performed through them.




In this community, there is no difference between the rich and the poor. Everything is common to be taken as needed.







Now, we are going commemorate the Last Supper. Those who have not received the Baptism may leave.


My wife and I would like to join this community.


We celebrate the memory of His death and resurrection until He returns in glory.


We, who partake in the body of Christ, become one body. We must love one another as He has loved us. A few days after receiving the Baptism, Annanias and Sapphira sold their property.

> I shall give this Three Thousand Shekels to Peter. No need to say anything about the Thousand we have set aside.


> > Who knows how long this kind of community will last. It is only wise ... just in case...

Here is the money we got from selling our property. We donate all the Three Thousand Shekels to the community. Ananias, did any of us compel you to sell your land?






Suddenly Ananias fell dead. They burned his body. After a while, his wife arrived.

Sapphira dropped dead.



The next morning the Sanhedrin met.


The followers of that Nazarene have become a threat to our very existence. Their numbers are multiplying day by day.


Even some of the members of Holy Sanhedrin have joined them. Stone to death those so called twelve Apostles. That will be the end of all these.





We all know about that Judas from Galilee who tried to start a revolution against Rome.

Judas was killed and His followers scattered. We have seen many such cases. If this movement is not from God, it will die a natural death.








> Why are we being pushed aside saying that we are Greeks?





Greek widows and orphans are neglected in the daily distributions.



Let us select seven men of good reputation, filled with the Holy Spirit and with wisdom to carry out this job.




They were called the "Deacons" which meant "those who serve". Stephen was the leader of that group. A conversation between two Jews:




That Stephen! Better informed than Gamaliel, more eloquent than Saul!
