DAVID

David was the greatest king of Israel. Though Saul was the first king, the institution of Monarchy became a reality in Israel only with David. Sixty nine chapters of the Bible (I & II Sam; I King; and I Chr.) deal with him. Seventy three Psalms are known as the 'Psalms of David'. David belonged to the tribe of Judah and was born in Bethlehem which later came to be known as the town of David. The glorious rule of David gave

rise to the Messianic expectations in Israel. Thus, David occupies a unique place in the history of Salvation.

The present book, "David", deals with his early life as a shepherd, as a bodyguard of King Saul, and as a fugitive. His ascent to the heights of glory and his fall to the depths of shame and loneliness will be presented in the next story, "King David".


The Israelites were encamped in the valley of Elam. From the Philistine camp a giant came forward challenging them.

Israel, where is your mighty king. Why is he hiding?






David was brought before Saul.




David with his men marched to Keila.





Hearing that David was in Keila, Saul went with his army to seize him. David escaped into the desert.



We are the ones who protected Nabal's sheep and shepherds. For this insult he must die. Take up your swords, we start immediately.



David plundered the Amalekites, enemies of the Israelites and brought the spoils to the king Akish.


