TOBIT

The age of the prophets came to an end in Israel by the end of the Babylonian captivity. Haggai, Zechariah and Malachi were only weak imitators of the earlier prophets. As reported by the Jewish historian, Flavius Josephus, it was the general belief among the Jews that by B.C. 450, the spirit of prophecy was extinguished in Israel. After that time the Priests and the Scribes took over the leadership. Their style was quite different from that of the prophets who had

confronted the whole nation with denunciation of their crimes, announcement of impending judgment, and urgent call for repentance. The later leaders however, concentrated their whole attention on interpreting the truth revealed through the prophets and implementing the law scrupulously and with extreme severity.

Besides interpreting and applying the law to concrete situations, they gave rise to a number of inspiring stories like Tobit, Esther and Judith. The purpose of these stories was to deepen the faith of the people and to enable them to draw strength from their faith in the Lord, in times of difficulties. The book of Tobit, the source of the present story, was written towards the end of the third century B.C. and it is not accepted by all as part of the Bible. The Council of Trent in 1546 officially decided to include it among the inspired books. However, the Protestant Churches consider it as an "apocryphal" book, meaning a book that is to be used only for edification, and not for confirming the dogmas of the Church.


Tobit is a model of unwavering faith, unselfish love, and great respect for the dead. He did not hesitate to risk his life in order to bury the bodies of Jews killed by the soldiers. Even in the midst of the most crucial trials, he turned to the Lord with childlike trust. He firmly believed that God would not abandon those who depend on Him. Poverty, sickness, threat to his life, persuasion by friends, none of these could shake his trust in God. "Tobit" is the Greek form of the Hebrew name "Tobiah", which means "Goodness

of Yahweh." "Tobias" also has the same meaning.


From a merely human point of view, Sarah who had lost seven husbands should have been in the depth of despair. But, hoping against hope, she prayed to the Lord God who listens to the cry of the innocent. God saved Tobit and Sarah and blessed them beyond all expectations. The advice Tobit and Raguel give to their children is a lesson for all the parents who must bring up their children in the fear of God and instill in them the


love for the poor. Tobias' devotion to his parents is a model for all children.







The exiled Israelis settled in the vicinity of Nineveh.




















Tobit went to many cities in Media to buy material. He sold it in Nineveh.





Slowly he became rich. One day in Rages, a small town in Media.







Shalmaneser died and Sennacherib became king. Tobit lost his job. Sennacherib was cruel to the Israelites and killed many of them.













Realizing his life was in danger Tobit fled. His property was confiscated.








Before long Sennacherib was assassinated by his sons. One of his sons, Esarhaddon became king.












































Tobit's life became more miserable once he lost his eyesight. Anna had to work as a hired hand to support the family.













At the same time in Ecbatana, capital of Media, in the house Raguel, a conversation between his daughter Sarah and his maids.
















Tobias and Sarah were blessed with many children. In his old age Tobit called them all and told them.
