

SUSANNA

Daniel is considered as one of the four Major Prophets. The division of the sixteen books of prophets into major and minor is based purely on the amount of material contained in the book attributed to each prophet. In the previous story (No. 25) we have seen that it was during the persecution unleashed by the Syrian king Antiochus IV that the book of Daniel was written. Though Daniel is counted among the prophetic books, it is quite different from the others. It is a

collection of anecdotes and visions. The present story depicts four episodes from Daniel's life. The first episode is related to Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon (B.C. 605-560). Probably taking inspiration from Isaiah's satire on the death of a tyrant (Is. 14, 3-21), the story depicts the pride and arrogance of the king who destroyed Jerusalem, burnt down the temple and carried away thousands of Jews captives to Babylon. He pretends to be God Almighty and the Lord of the universe. Behind this picture of Nebuchadnezzar one can detect the figure of Antiochus IV.

Human pride that denies God by pretending to assume His position is seen by the Bible as the Sin. The sin of Adam and the sin of those who tried to build 'a tower reaching up to heaven' are understood in this sense. Nebuchadnezzar is seen as a type of all those rulers who try to make themselves God.

The Bible understands the human person as the image and representative of God on earth. It is this relationship to God that makes him a person.


When this relation is severed he loses his identity as human person and becomes like a beast. This profound truth is vividly depicted in Nebuchadnezzar's punishment. The "Fall of a Tyrant" is a lesson and a warning to all. Accepting the Lordship of God does not diminish human dignity. On the contrary, it is God who guarantees freedom and dignity to all human persons.


There is only one God and only Him shall we adore. This is a fundamental affirmation of the Bible. Idol worship is denial of God. That God will not abandon His faithful servants who are ready to suffer persecution and death in order to affirm His Lordship is colorfully presented in the second episode.


The story of Susanna exhorts not to succumb to temptation and intimidations. One must not obey any authority, even a religious authority, if one is asked to do evil. God who delivered Susanna from the hands of the wicked judges will always protect the innocent ones who resist evil. The name Susanna means "lily". She is a model of purity and of total trust in God.

The last episode, "Eating Statue", reveals the folly of idolatry. It exposes the treachery of those who enrich themselves by exploiting the simple faith of the people. Idols are made by man and have no power in themselves. Those who worship them are being deceived. However, it is not only statues that can become idols; whatever takes the place of God is an idol. Money, which Jesus called 'mammon' is perhaps the biggest idol that is being worshipped today almost everywhere. It is the duty of true believers in God to denounce and destroy such idols, as Daniel did with Bel.







It was a horrible nightmare. I still feel disturbed by it.

Until you come to know that it is the God Almighty who rules the world. Lie in the sun, rain and snow and be with the wild beasts.

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


Proclaim to the whole world what happened to me. Let no one boast before the Lord.


Daniel in the Lions' pit.

Darius, the emperor of Persia divided the empire into 120 provinces and appointed governors for each province. Daniel was one of the three appointed presidents over them.


In all the matters Daniel has provided to be the wisest man in the empire. Daniel shall be our chief adviser.

In an empire like Persia where there are so many religious groups, we need unity in worship to ensure unity in the empire.


As an experiment, it will be good to issue a royal command that all should worship only the emperor for the next thirty days.








Daniel continued to pray to the Lord three times a day, turning towards Jerusalem as he used to.




Daniel was summoned by the Emperor.




According to the Royal command, they threw Daniel into the Lion's pit. The pit was closed and sealed.


Lord, you never abandon those who put their trust in you. I praise you.


That night Darius was greatly troubled thinking about Daniel. The next morning.







Immediately Daniel was pulled out of the pit and the ones who accused him was thrown into the Lion's pit.









Among the exiles of Israel in Babylon there was a man named Joachim. This rich and generous man was liked by all. The court hearings were held at his house.









The Court hearing.











Never mind. Well, we ordered to return the money with interest and if not auction out his property. Is it good that we encourage interest? See, he promised to give us half of the interest. So,why not?




















No, never! Against God and my husband I will not do this. It is wrong.


We know all that. Nobody is going to know. You just agree.



Consenting to you would be a sin. But, if I refuse you'll kill me. I place myself in the hands of God. God will not come to save you. You better agree with us.




The next day the judges came to Joachim's house. People gathered. Susanna was brought to the court.







With much reluctance and sorrow, the people took her outside the city gate to be stoned. Then God sent Daniel to them.



Oh, Israelites, how foolish you are to condemn an innocent woman to death without a proper trial.








You, wicked sons of the devil, how many maidens were abused by you? When one woman resisted, you decided to kill her. Your own words have condemned you.

God will never abandon those who trust in him. Susanna, you chose to die rather than sin. You are a model for all. May God bless you.




Eating Statue.

How can you say that "Bel" is not a living God when he consumes so much food every day.




The king summoned all seventy priests of "Bel" inside the Temple.


All right.

Unless you find out who is eating all the food offered to Bel, you will be killed. But, if it is proved that Bel is eating, then, Daniel will be killed.


Your Majesty, he who speaks against our great god Bel must die.

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









