

THE MACCABEES

We are presenting the last book in the OT series of the Bible comics. In this book of heroic deeds and tragic deaths of the five Maccabee brothers are depicted. This is the continuation of the previous story, Maccabeus, that presented the heroic resistance of the Jewish people against the advance of Hellenism and Greek imperialism.

Judas Maccabeus defeated several generals of Antiocus IV in various battles. Within three

years he was able to rededicate the temple that was defiled by the pagans. He liberated the Jews who were kept prisoners and persecuted by the neighbouring countries. With this the primary goal of the Maccabean revolt was achieved. The next step was to obtain political independence and stability. For this he entered into a treaty with Rome.

When Maccabeus fell in battle, Jonathan took over the leadership. He was a shrewd politician and an accomplished diplomat. Taking advantage

of the internal rivalries that plagued the Syrian empire, Jonathan was able to secure his power as the ruler of Judea and also to expand his territory. Any means that served this purpose was acceptable to him. He did not have the least hesitation to accept the dignity of High Priesthood and the position of a vassal from a pagan emperor.

Simon who succeeded Jonathan gained complete independence for the Jewish nation. The people considering him as the liberator of

the nation, acclaimed him High Priest and king. Thus simon became the founder of a dynasty, called the Hasmoneans. However, Hasmoneans could not guarantee true and lasting freedom to the people. At the end of the dynasty we see Herod, an Idumean, sitting on the throne of Israel, as a vessel king of the Roman Empire.

A revolutionary movement that started as a heroic struggle for preserving religious freedom gradually gave way to imperialistic ambitions,

undermining the very foundations of Yahwistic religion. During the period of monarchy in Israel, that is to say, from Saul to Zedekiah, there were prophets and priests who, in the name of Yaweh, denounced the kings and called them to conversion. But when the High Priest himself became king, no one dared to challenge him. Supreme authority when concentrated in the hands of sinful people, gets corrupted. Where criticism is not tolerated, self-righteousness prevails and conversion becomes impossible.

The OT history ends here. It depicts with extreme clarity how man's repeated attempts to build a paradise on earth without God miserably fails. The sin of Adam and Eve who tried to become like God, and of Cain who killed his brother, steadily grew with every generation, becoming an enslaving force from which humanity cannot liberate itself. At the end of the OT period, we see a people groaning under foreign domination and crying for liberation. The OT depicts also, with even greater vividness,


