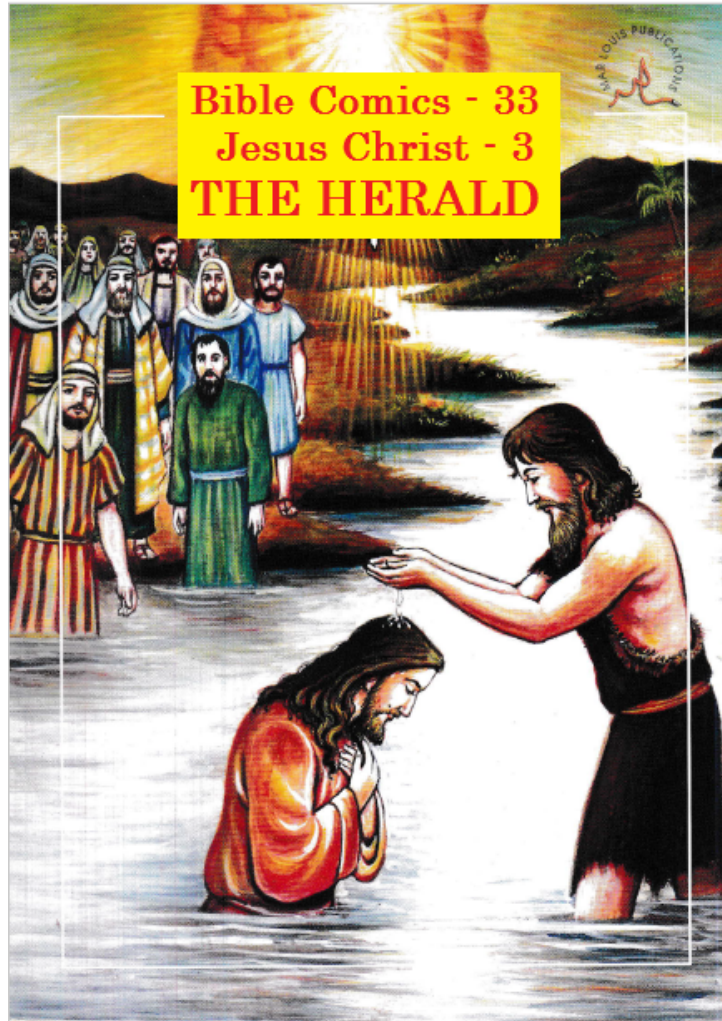

The Herald

In this book we are depicting the period that lies between Jesus' return from Egypt and the beginning of his public ministry. The Gospels give us no information about his life in Nazareth except the fact that he grew up in Nazareth as an obedient boy, he was loved by all and that he worked as a carpenter. He lived as an ordinary man, earning his bread by the sweat of his brow. Such a life

has no place in the world history that records the triumphs of heroes.

The event in the temple at the age of twelve stands out as an exception to this obscurity. The setting in which we present that event is based on the historical context of the period. By staying back in the temple and then responding to his parents as he did, Jesus reveals his unique relationship to God and his firm determination to do the will of his Father. The finding of Jesus in the Temple on the

third day foreshadows the Paschal event that turns Sorrow into joy.

John the Baptist was the Herald sent to announce the coming of Messiah and to prepare the people to receive him. The Gospels tell us that until receiving the prophetic call John was in the desert. His association with the Qumran community depicted in this story is plausible because of the similarity and differences between John and the desert community. His attire reminded one of Elijah and his words

were like those of the authentic prophets of the Old Testament.

John's message was an urgent call to conversion. He proclaimed that God was angry with the world and was about to punish the sinful humanity. Only a true change of heart and life could save the world from impending disaster. The Messiah, he said, was coming after him to purify the world with fire. Everybody without exception was a sinner before God and stood in need of conversion. The

Baptism he administered was a sign of admitting one's sinfulness and need of redemption.

Together with the common people Jesus came and was Baptized by John. Though he was sinless, by submitting to the Baptism, Jesus expressed his solidarity with the sinful humanity. He took upon himself the sins of the world in order to liberate the world from its sins.

With the appearance of the Lord on the scene, the task of the Herald is accomplished. When he challenged the ruler of Galilee, with his call to conversion, John was signing his own death warrant. The first wife whom Herod Antipas divorced in order to marry Herodias, was the daughter of Aretas, king of the neighboring Nabataea. Aretas was preparing for war to avenge this insult when John started his violent accusations. Herod

feared that this would raise popular revolt in that critical moment. Instead of changing his ways, Herod chose to silence the accusing voice. Thus, John became the Herald not only announcing the coming, but also prefiguring the outcome of Jesus' ministry.

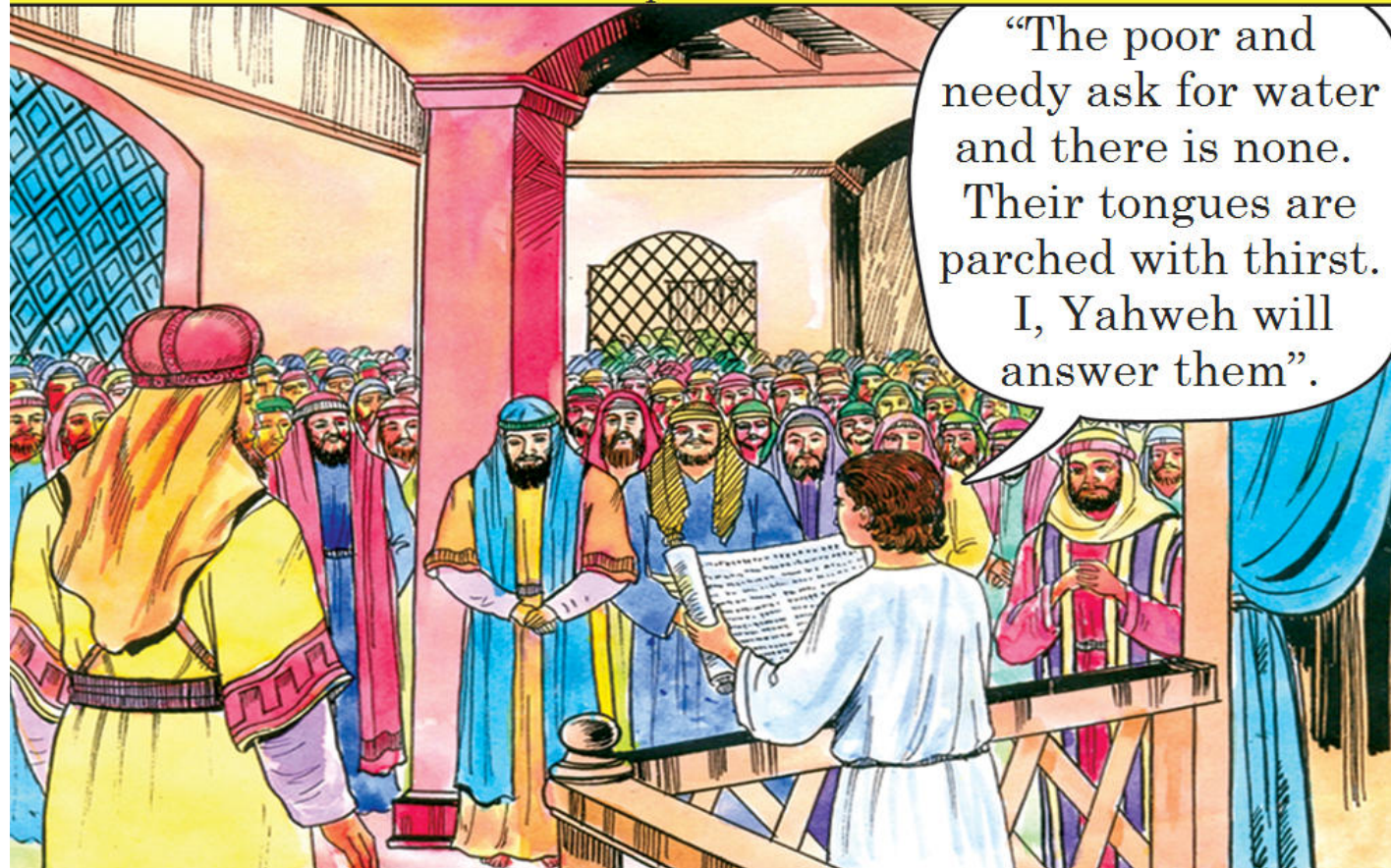

When Jesus was twelve years old they celebrated his Bar-Mitzvah. As a part of the ceremony, he exercised his right of reading the scripture in public.

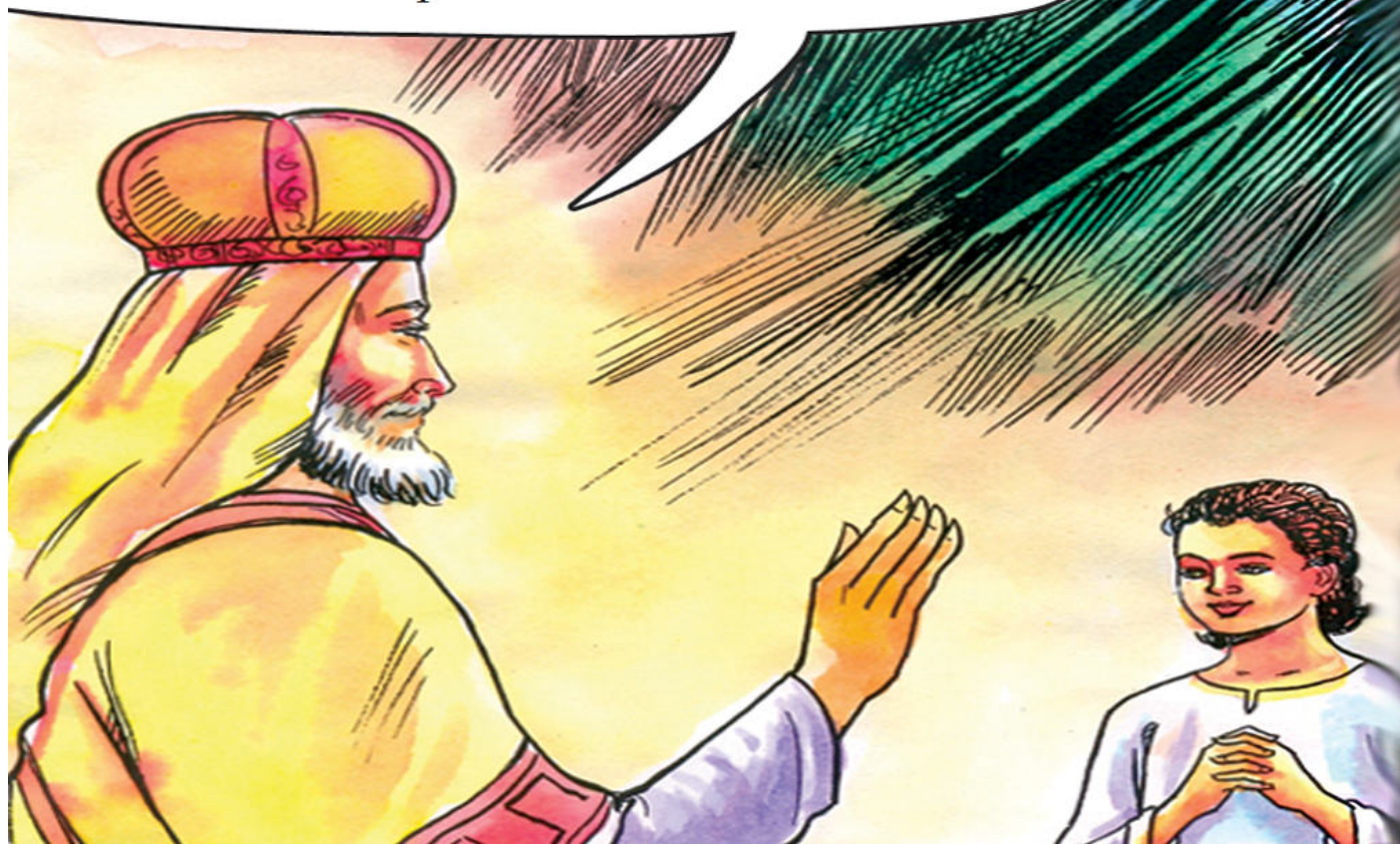


After the reading.

May the word of the Lord be a light on your path, in moments of joy as well as grief and persecution.



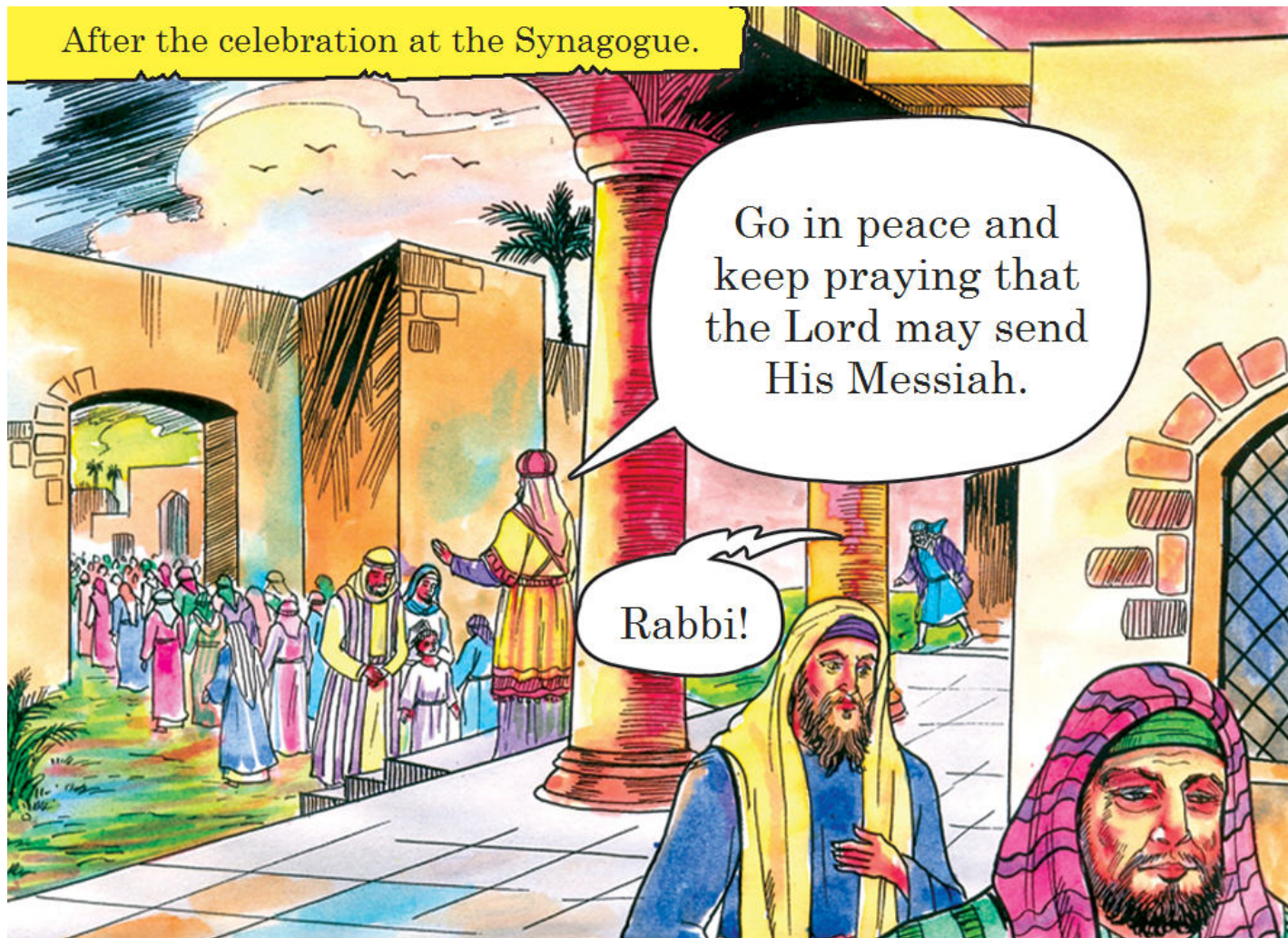
Remain faithful to the

His Messiah.

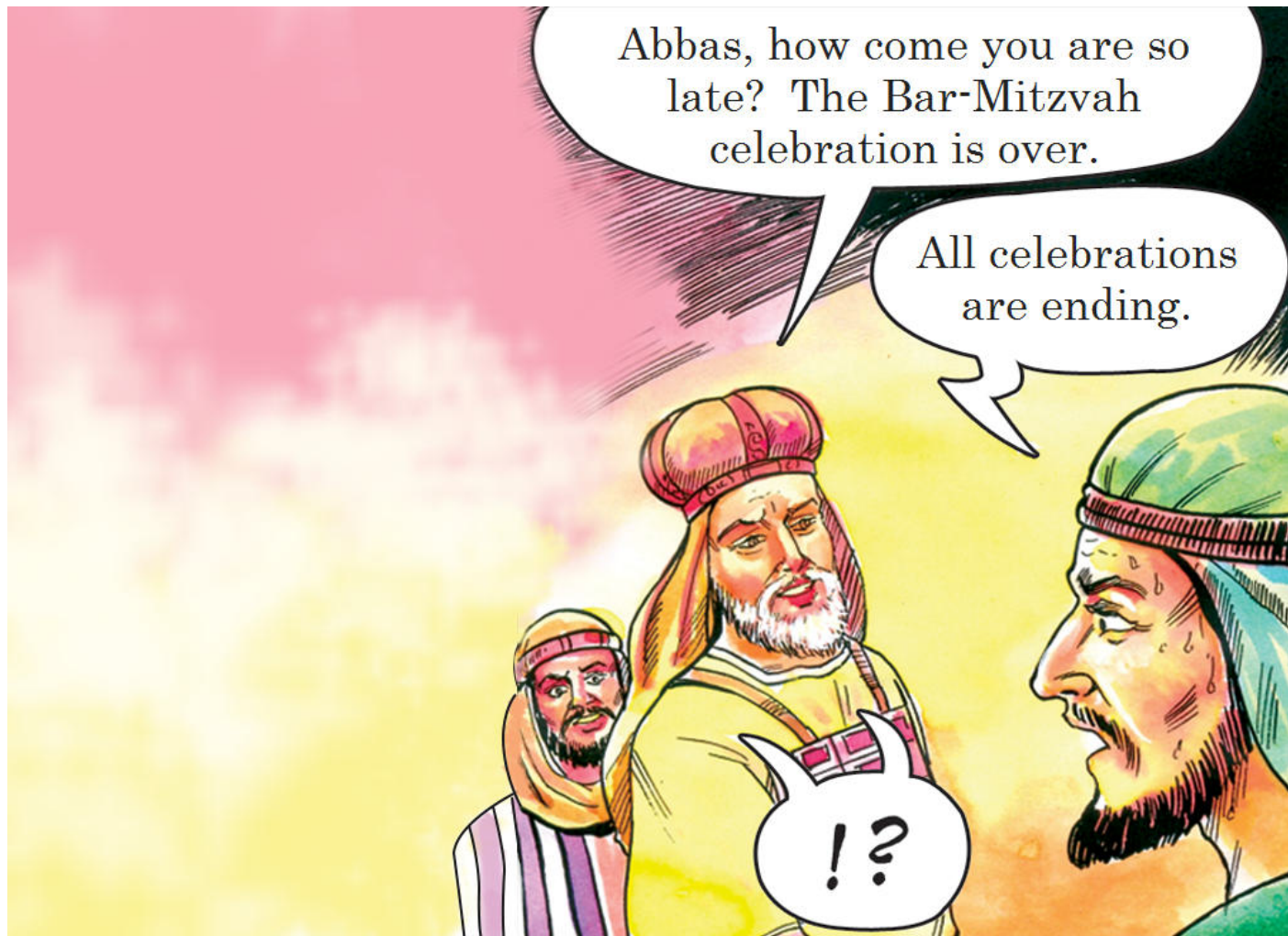
Rabbi!

revolt has started.

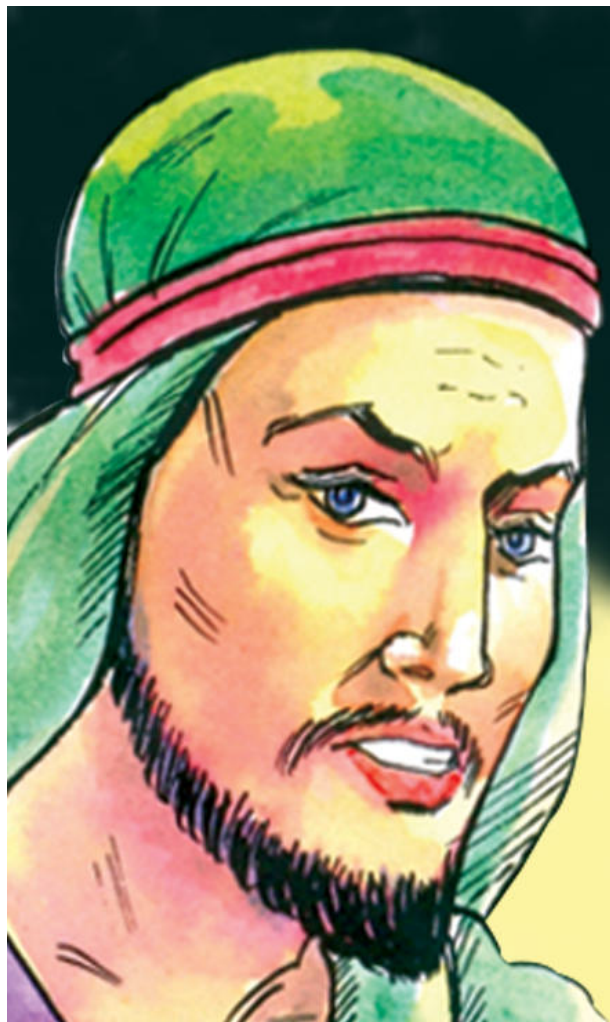


Didn't the army of

count us again.

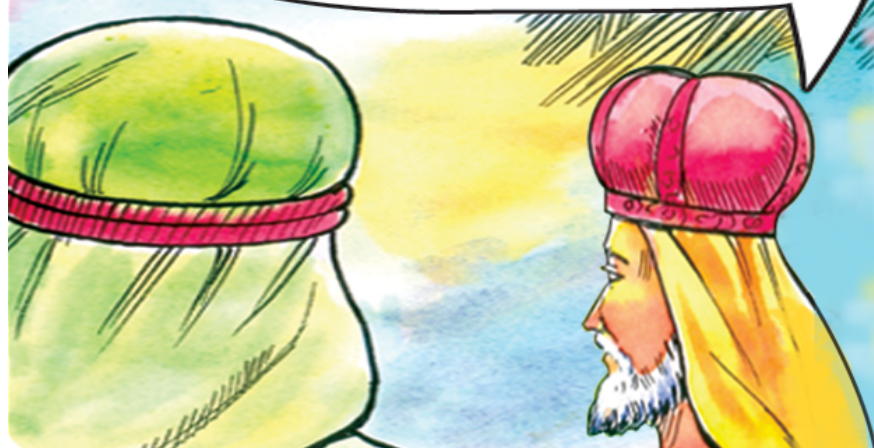
Our law forbids counting the

Hezekiah.



must take up arms.




What can we do against Rome who rules the world?

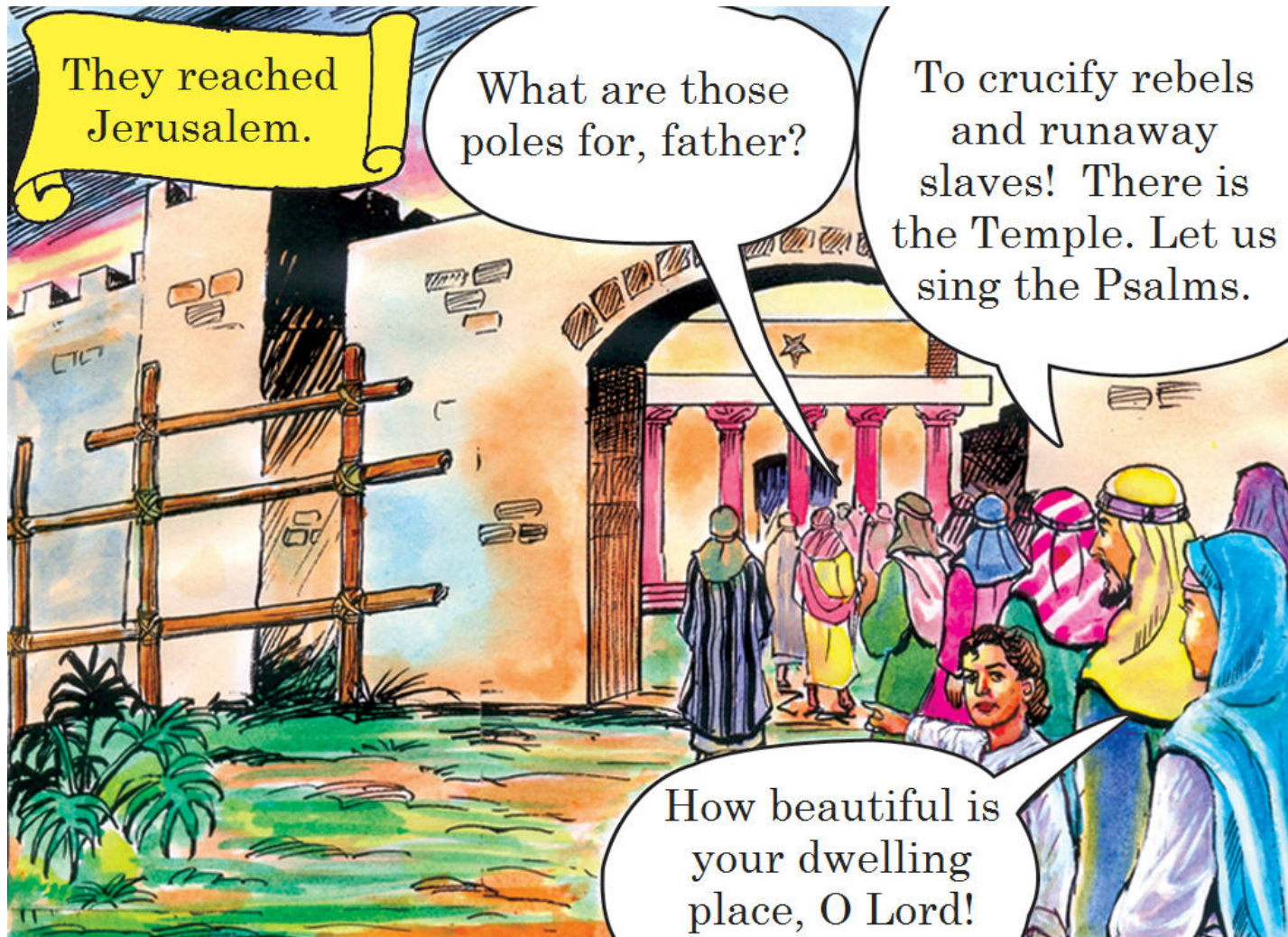


They reached

sing the Psalms.

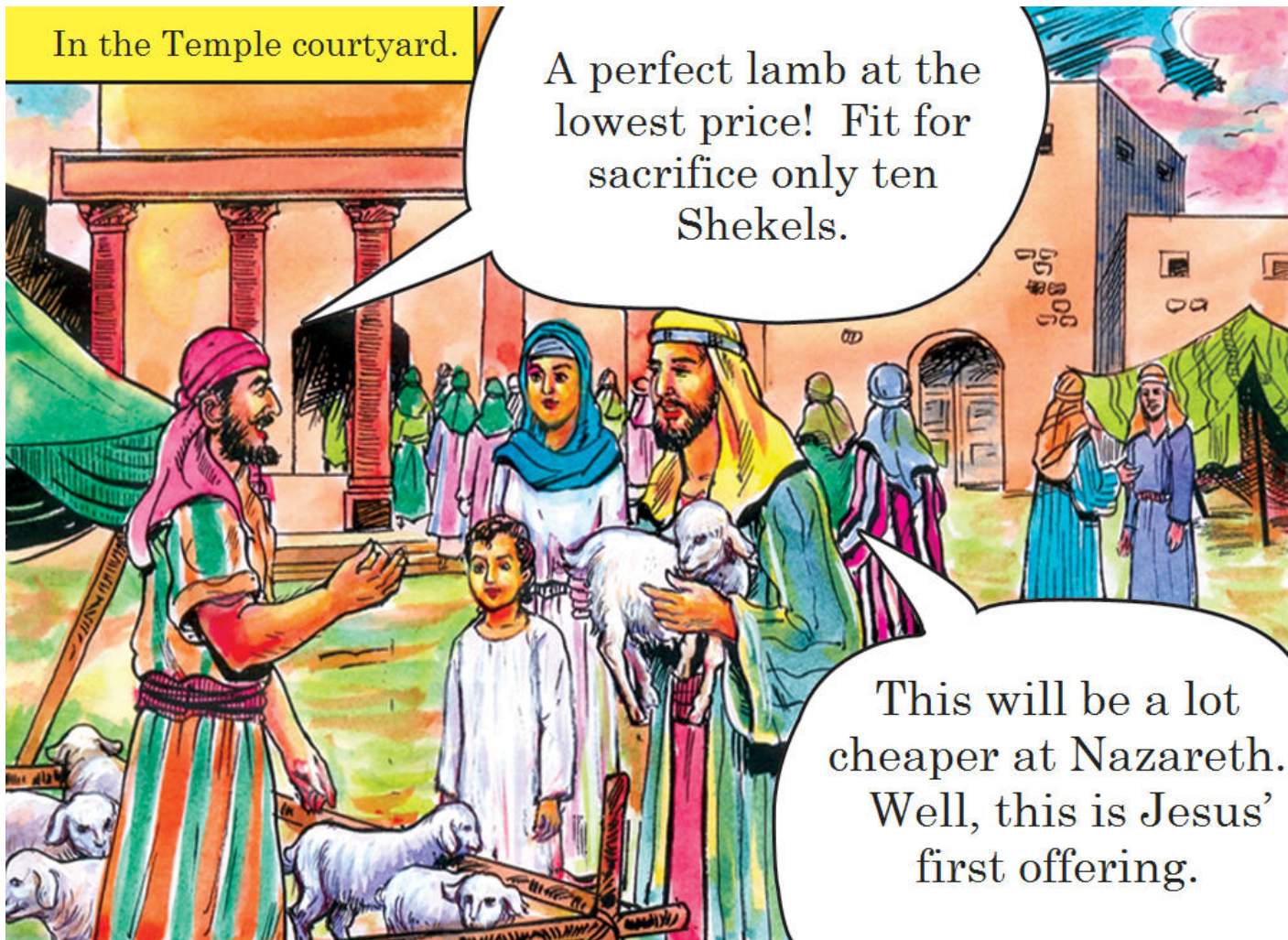
How beautiful is

In the Temple courtyard.

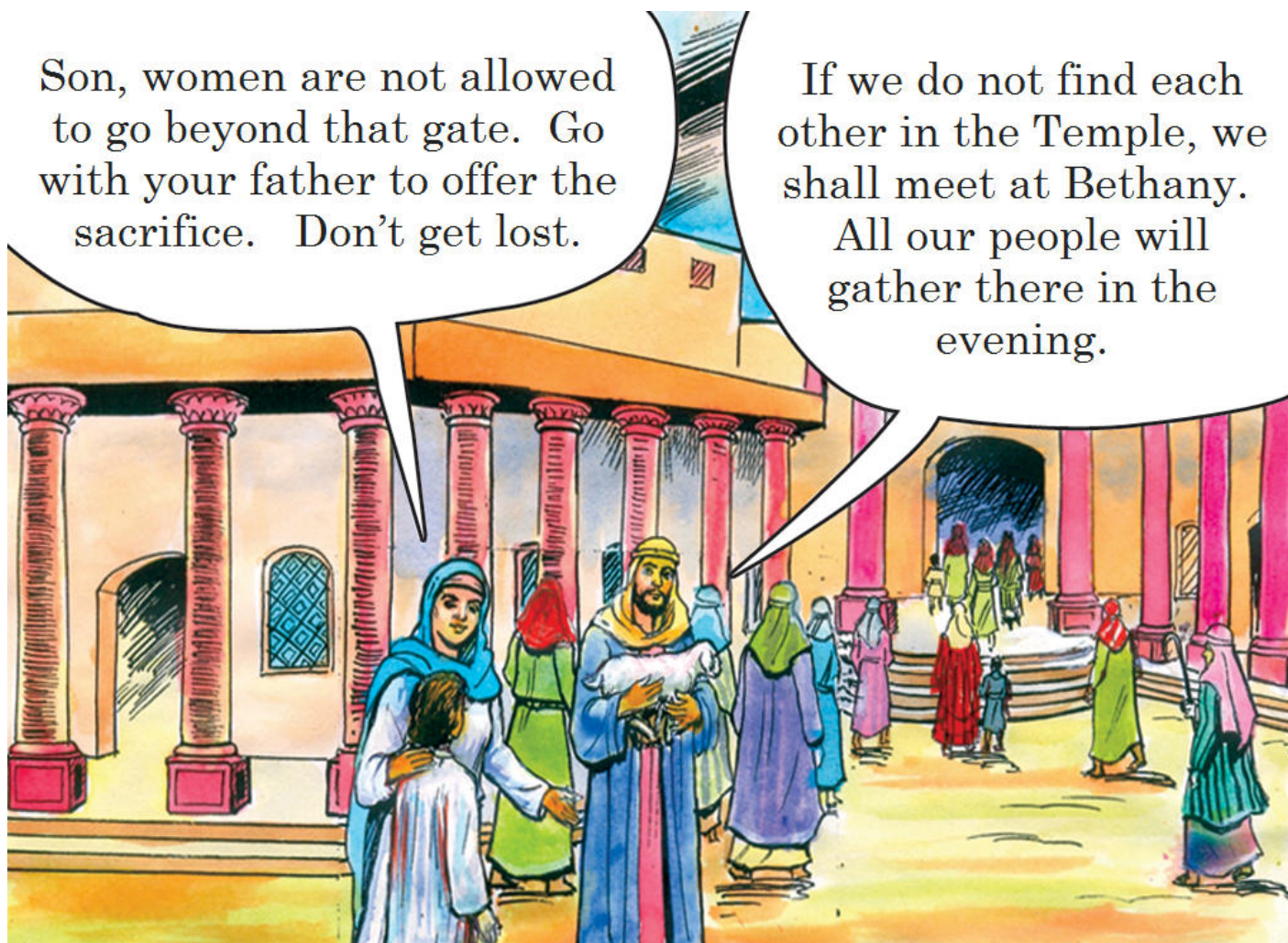
A perfect lamb at the lowest price! Fit for sacrifice only ten Shekels.

This is our offering to the Lord. Kindly accept this gift and bless us.

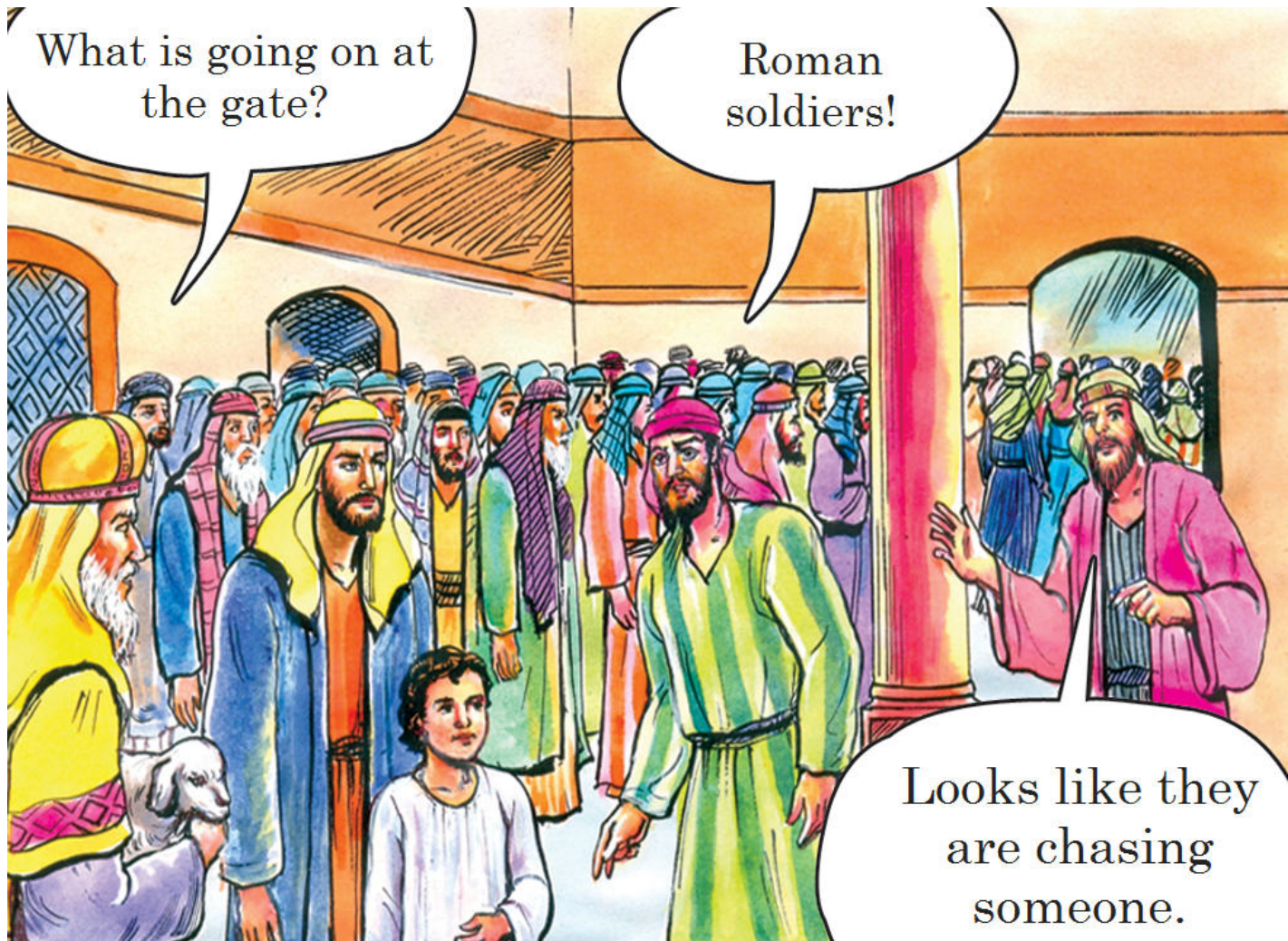
A lamb acceptable to the Lord! May His face shine upon you.

someone.

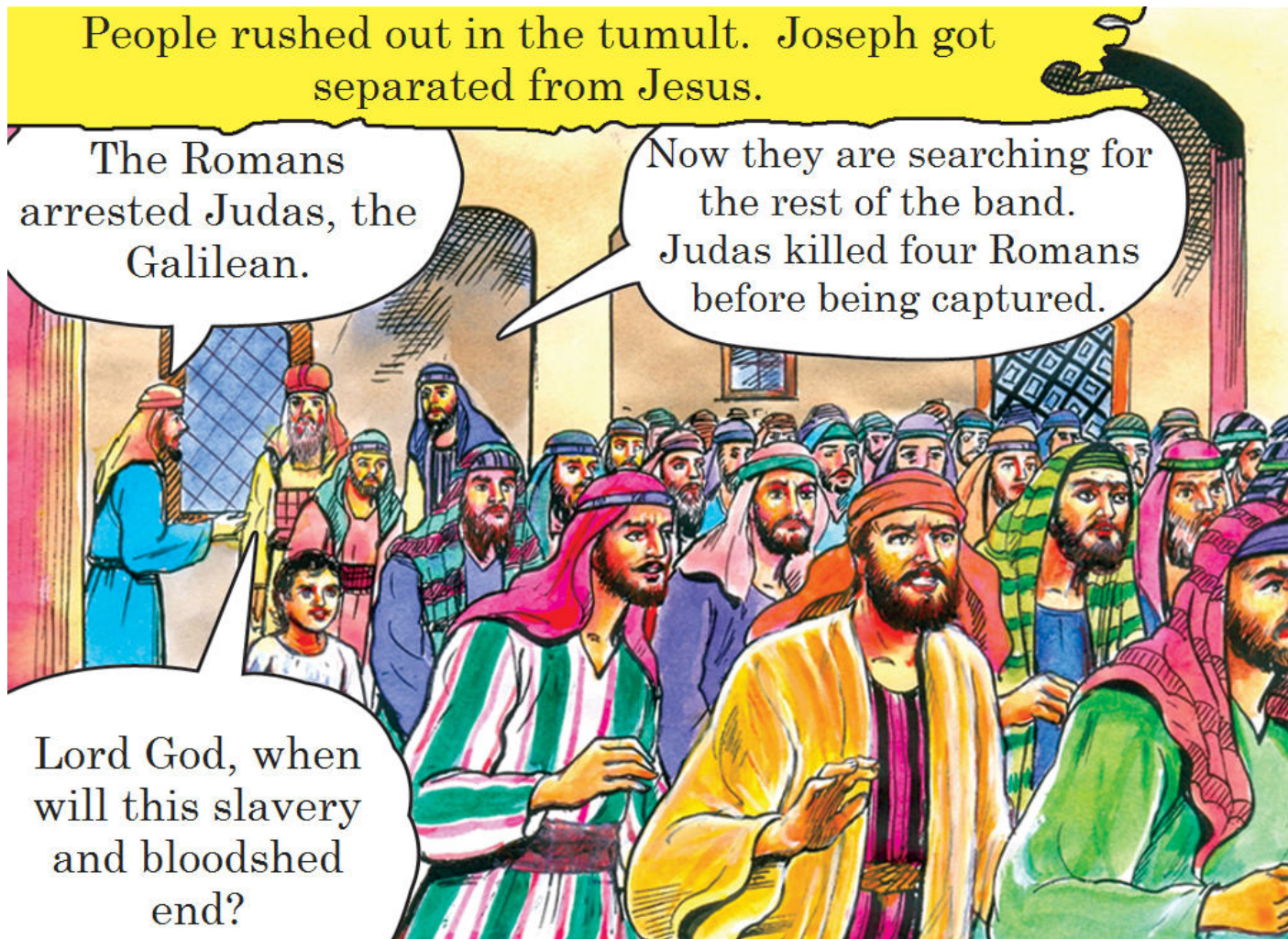


People rushed out in the tumult. Joseph got separated from Jesus.

open to all?

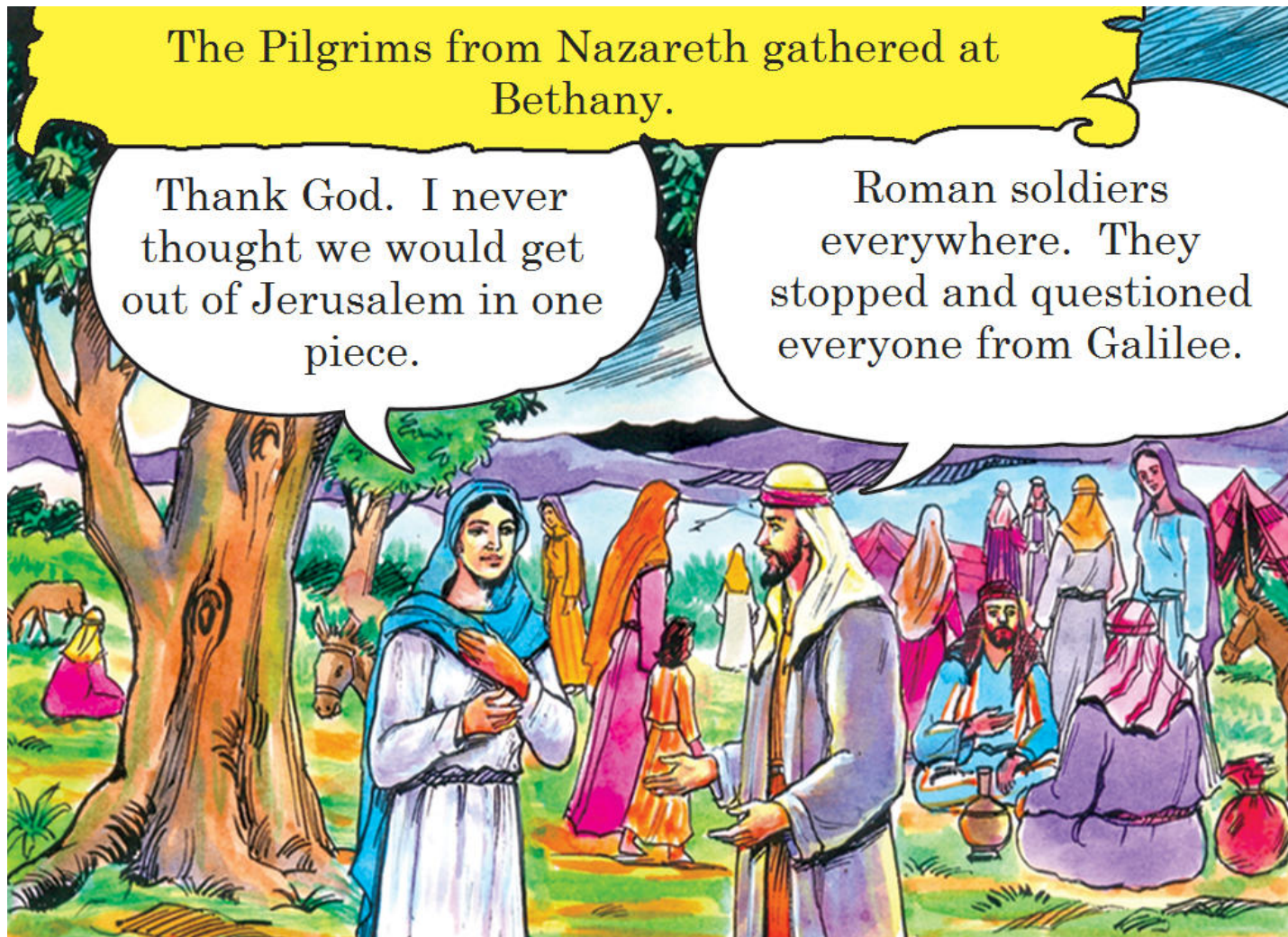
The Lord our God chose

the Temple.

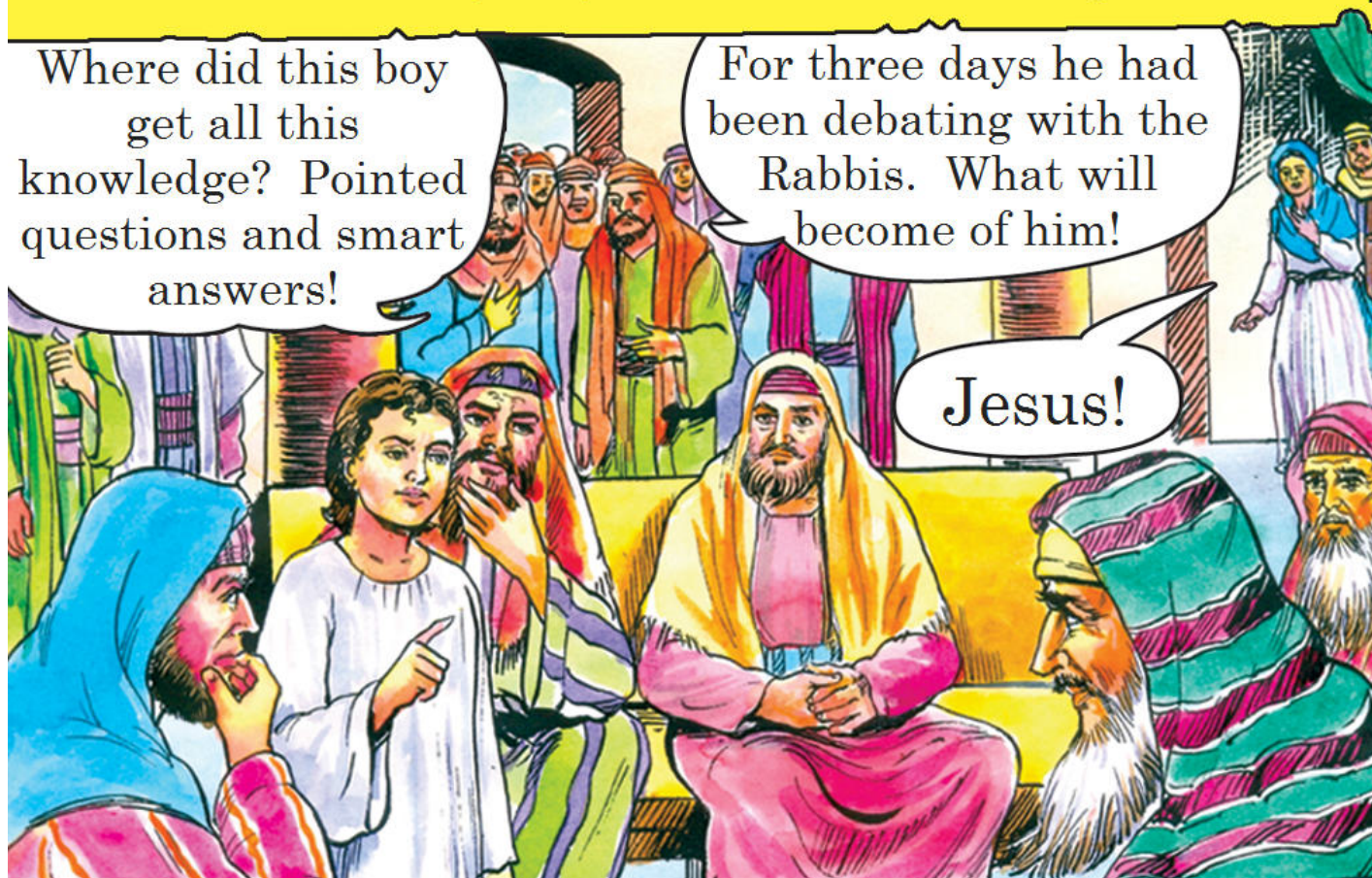


Greatly troubled, they went around searching for Jesus. On the third day they found him in the Temple.

Where did this boy get all this knowledge? Pointed questions and smart answers!

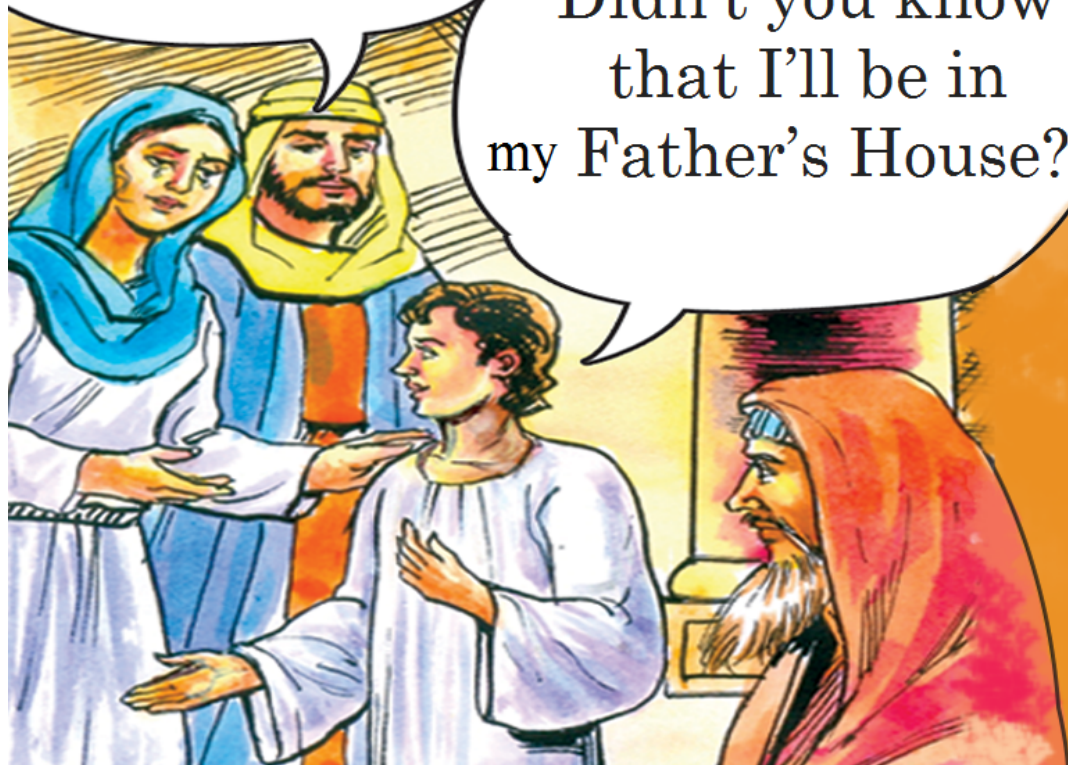
For three days he had been debating with the Rabbis. What will become of him!

my Father's House?

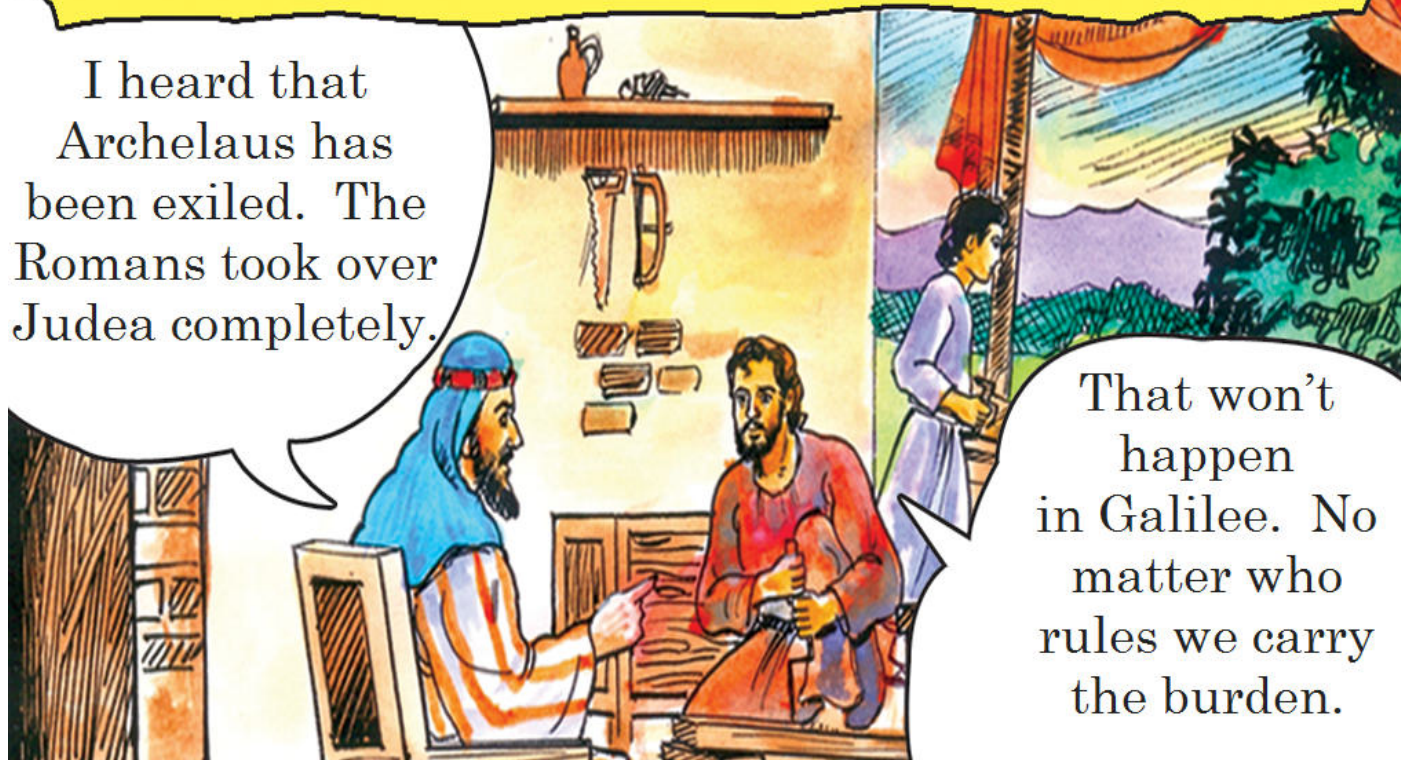


Come, let us go

and harassing our people too.

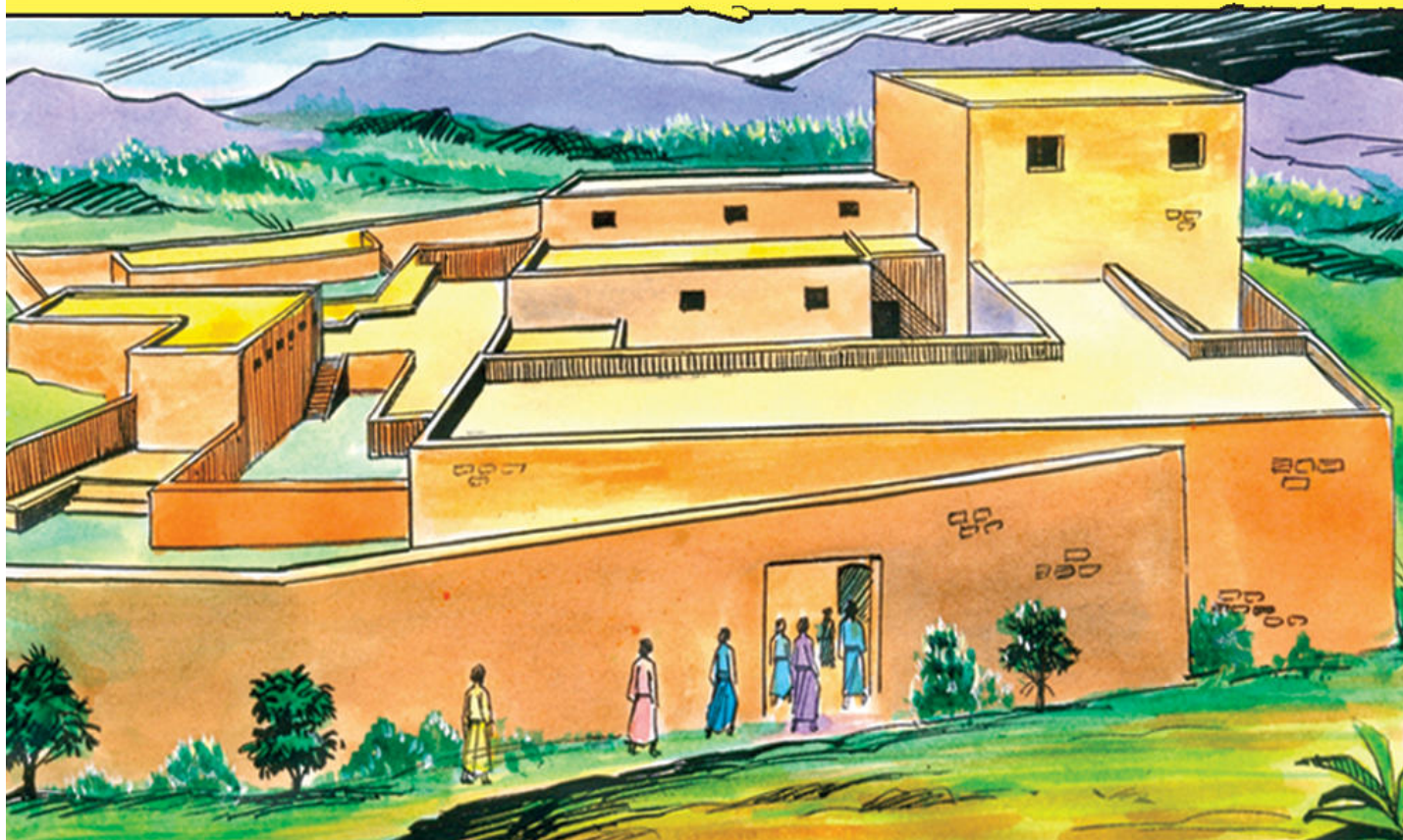


Only those

people.

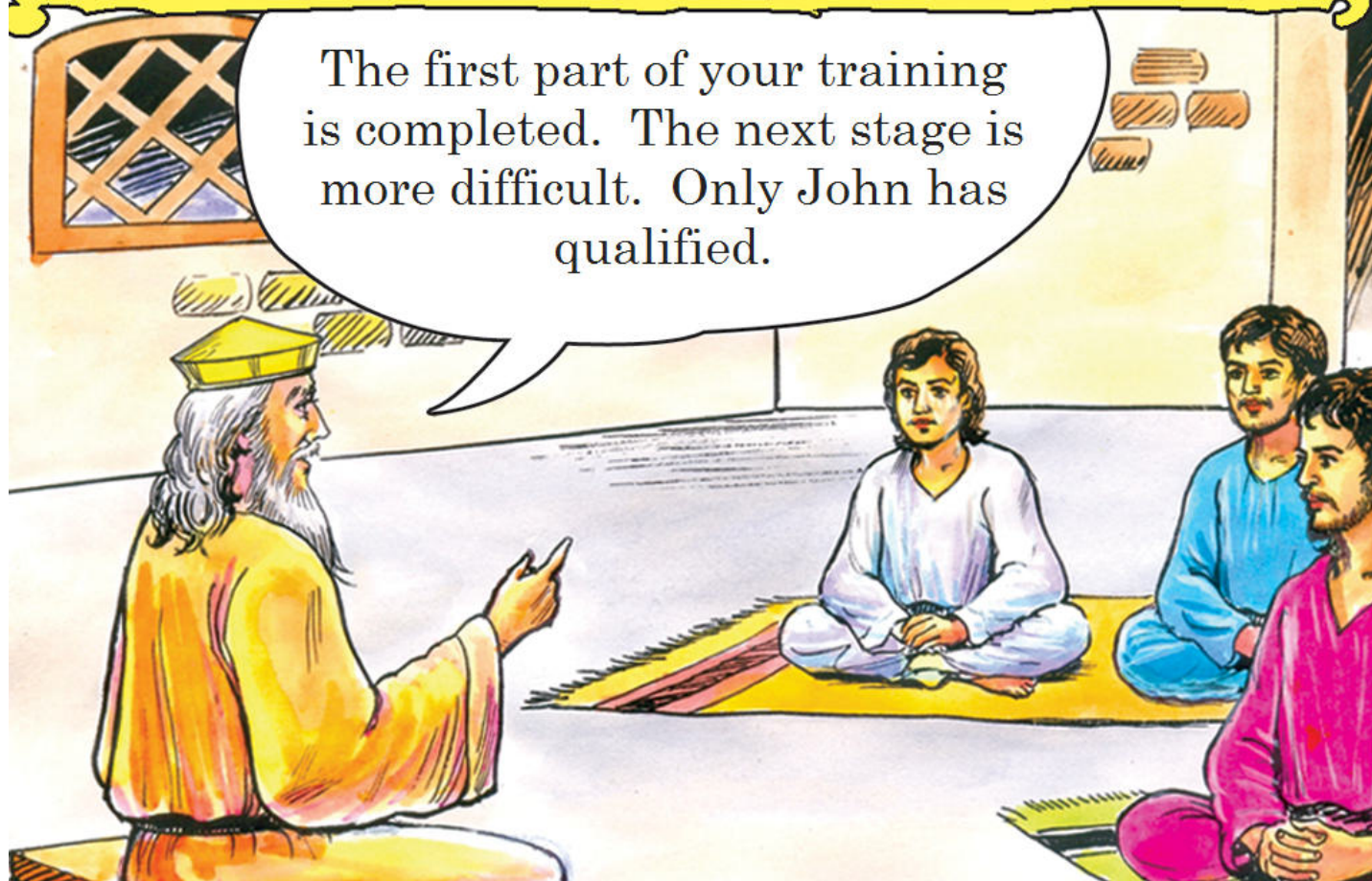

John went through strict training under various masters.

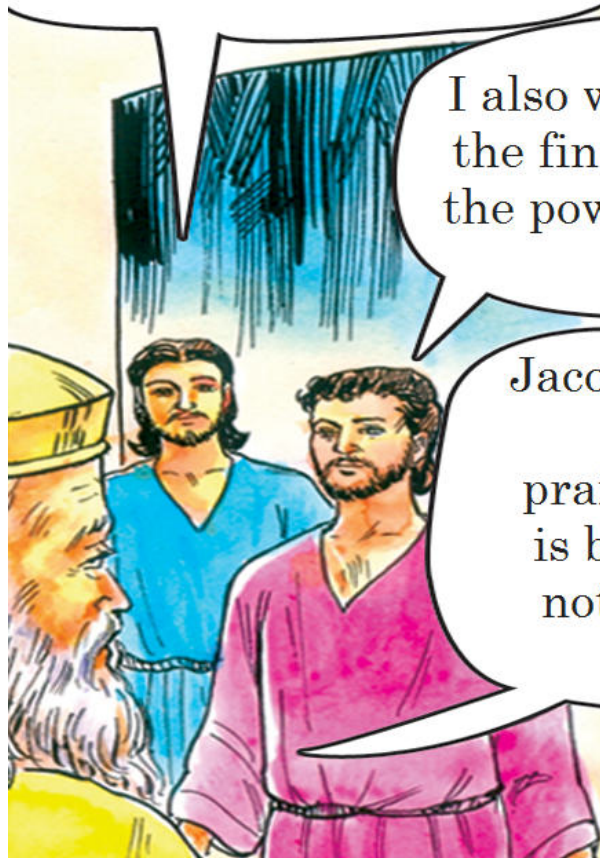
The first part of your training is completed. The next stage is more difficult. Only John has qualified.



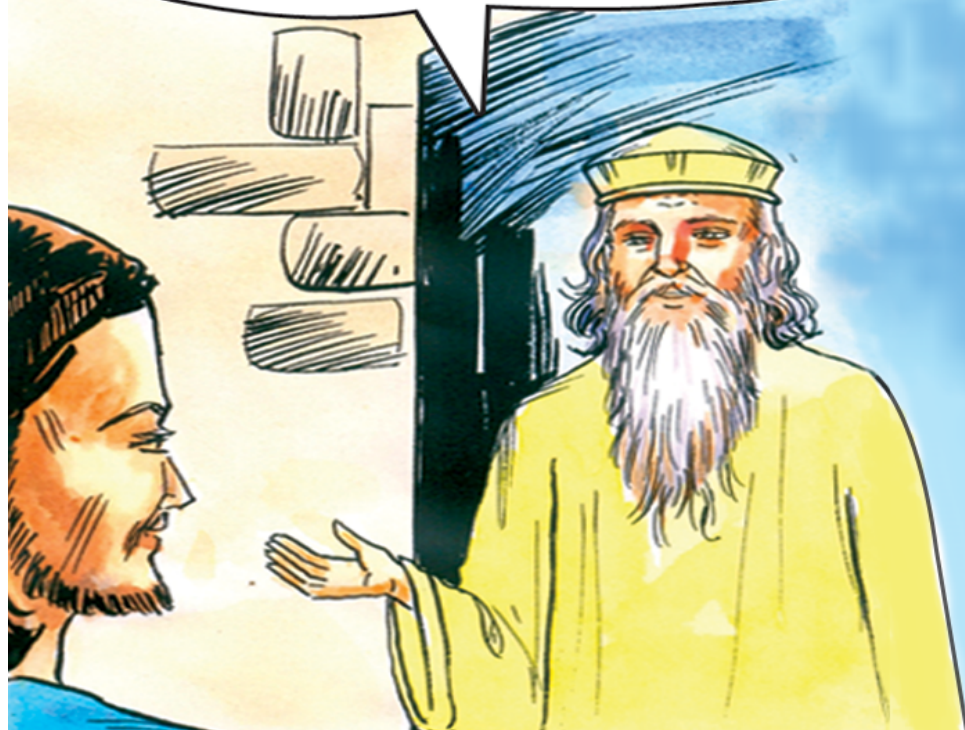
I would like to stay and prepare the way for the Messiah.

I also would like to join the final battle against the powers of darkness.

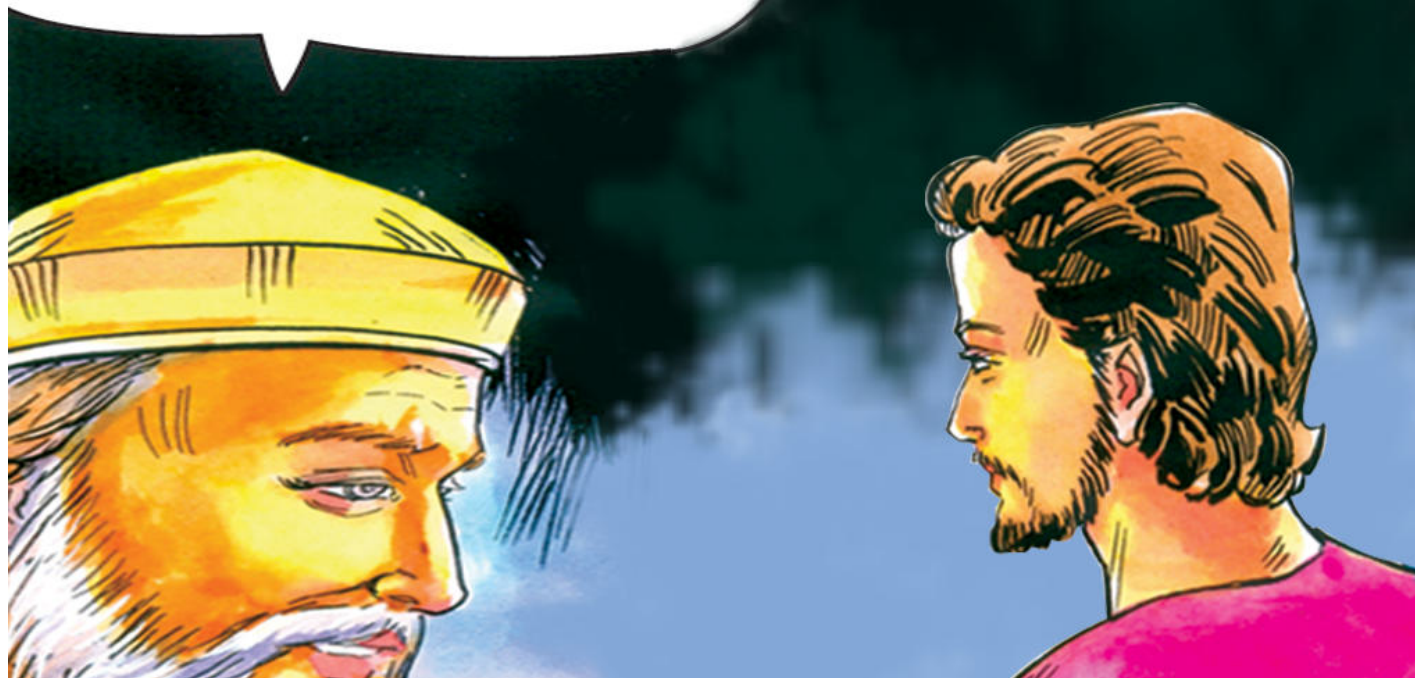
Jacob, Andrew, your desire is praiseworthy but it is best that you do not continue here now.

Palestine.

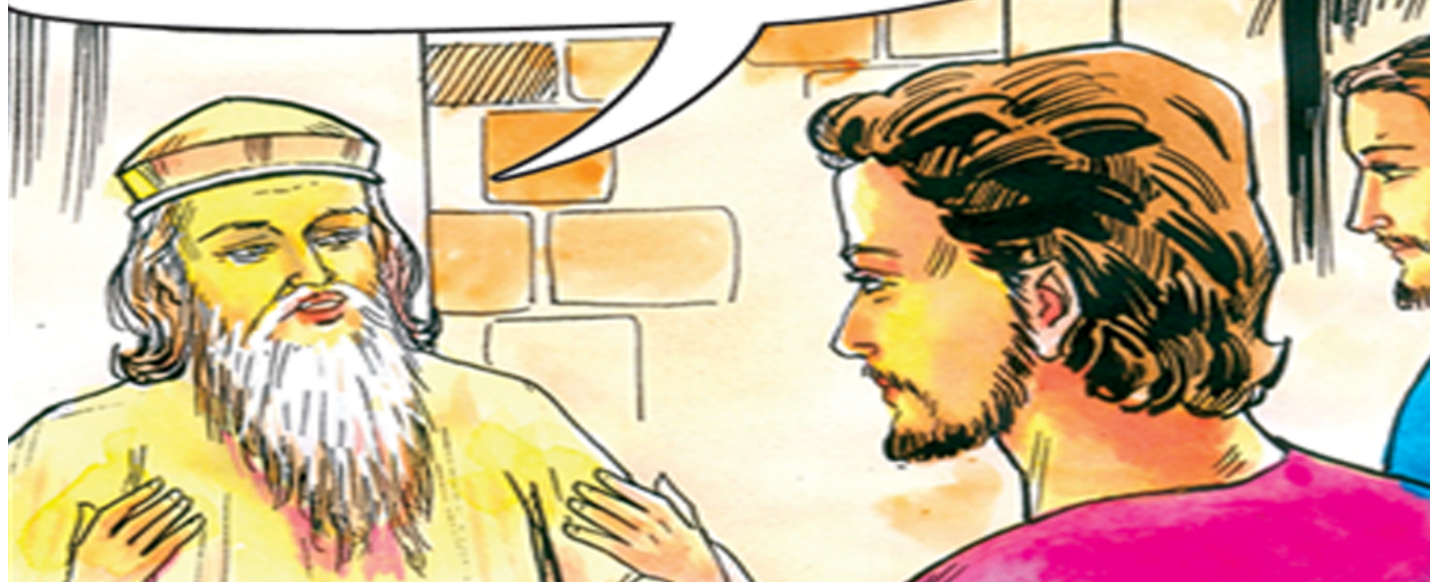


When it is time you also

John's religious training started.



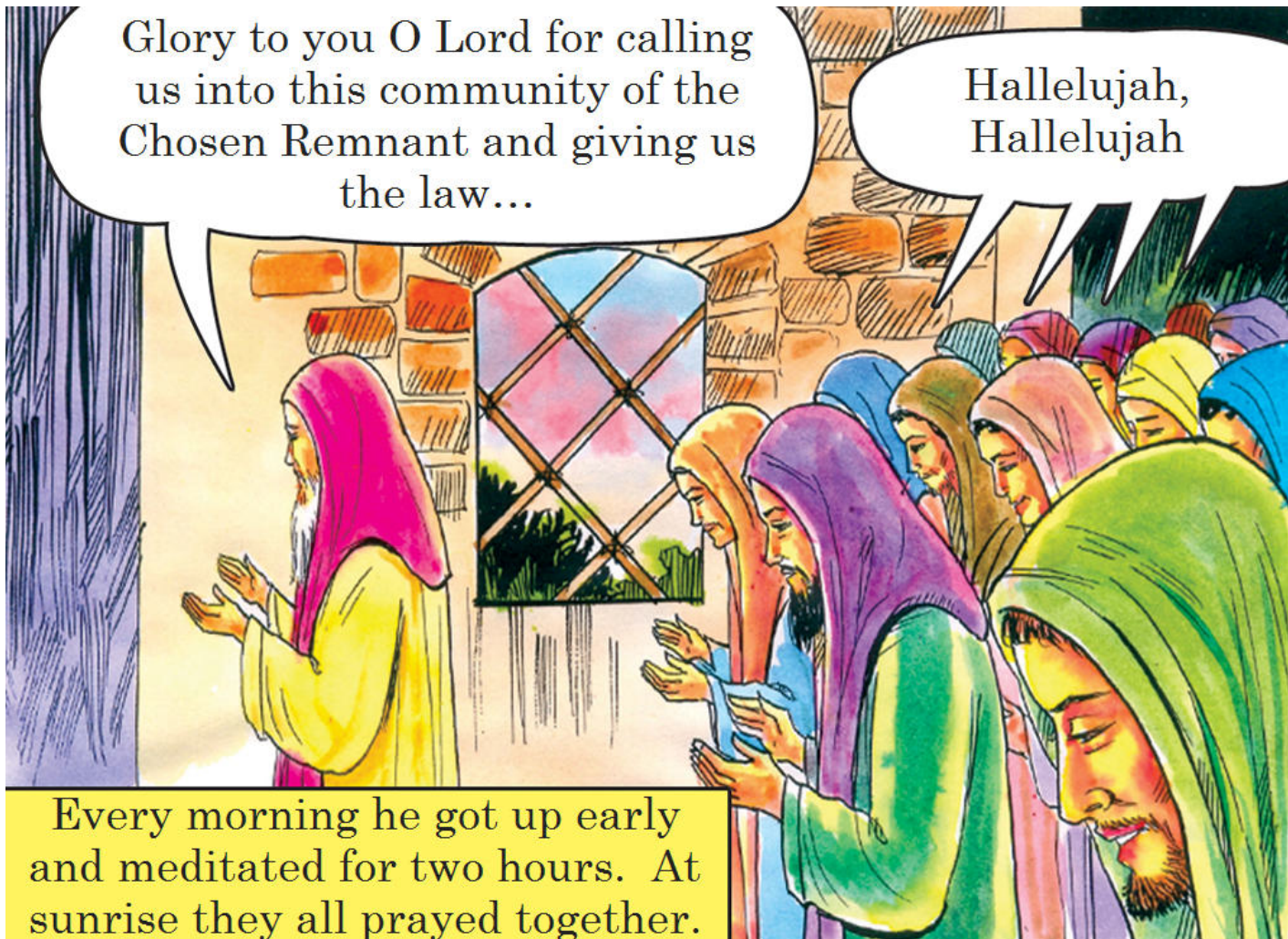
John, son of Zachariah, you

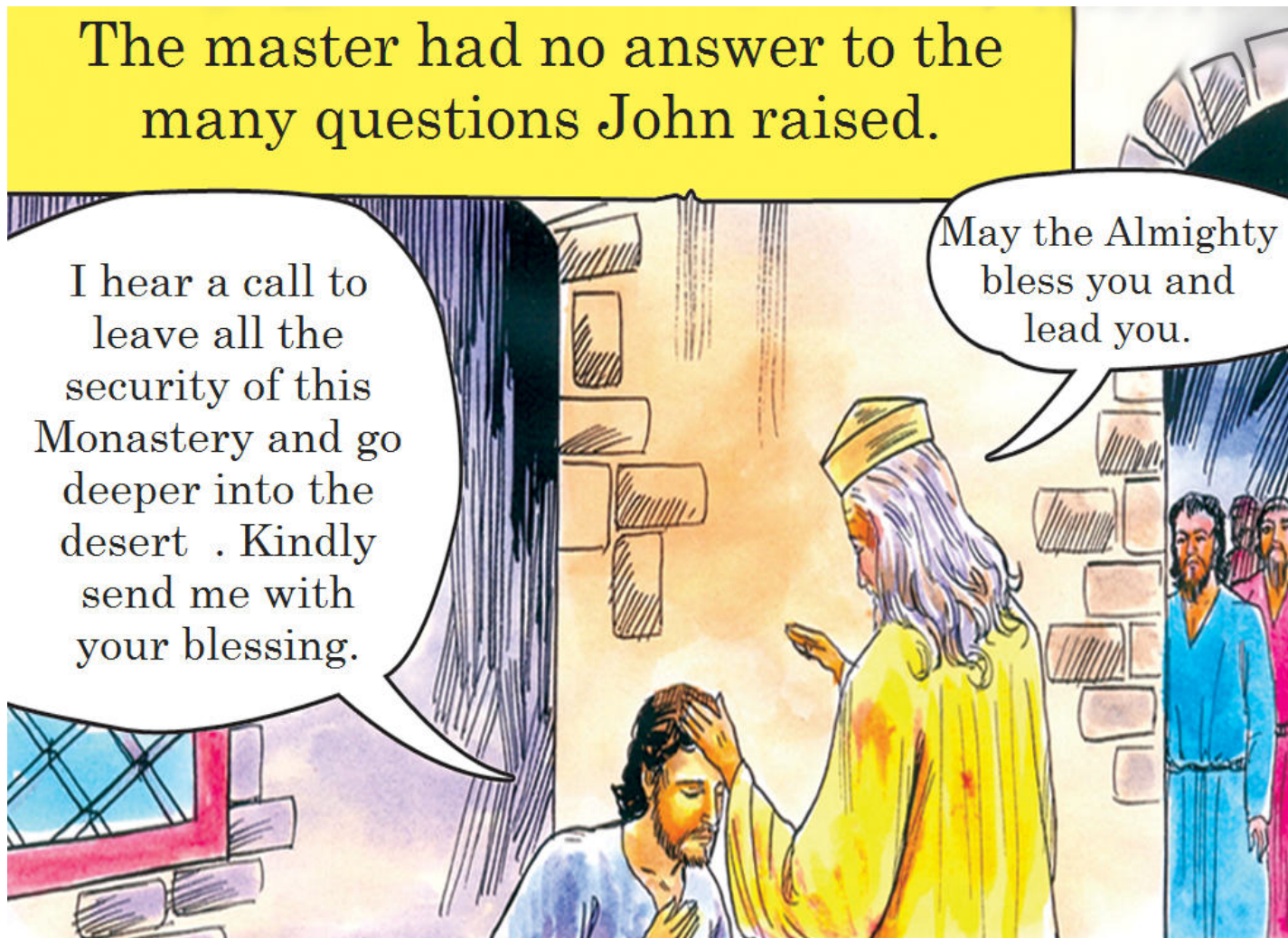
I think it is Hypocrisy to

I hear a call to leave all the security of this Monastery and go deeper into the desert . Kindly send me with your blessing.

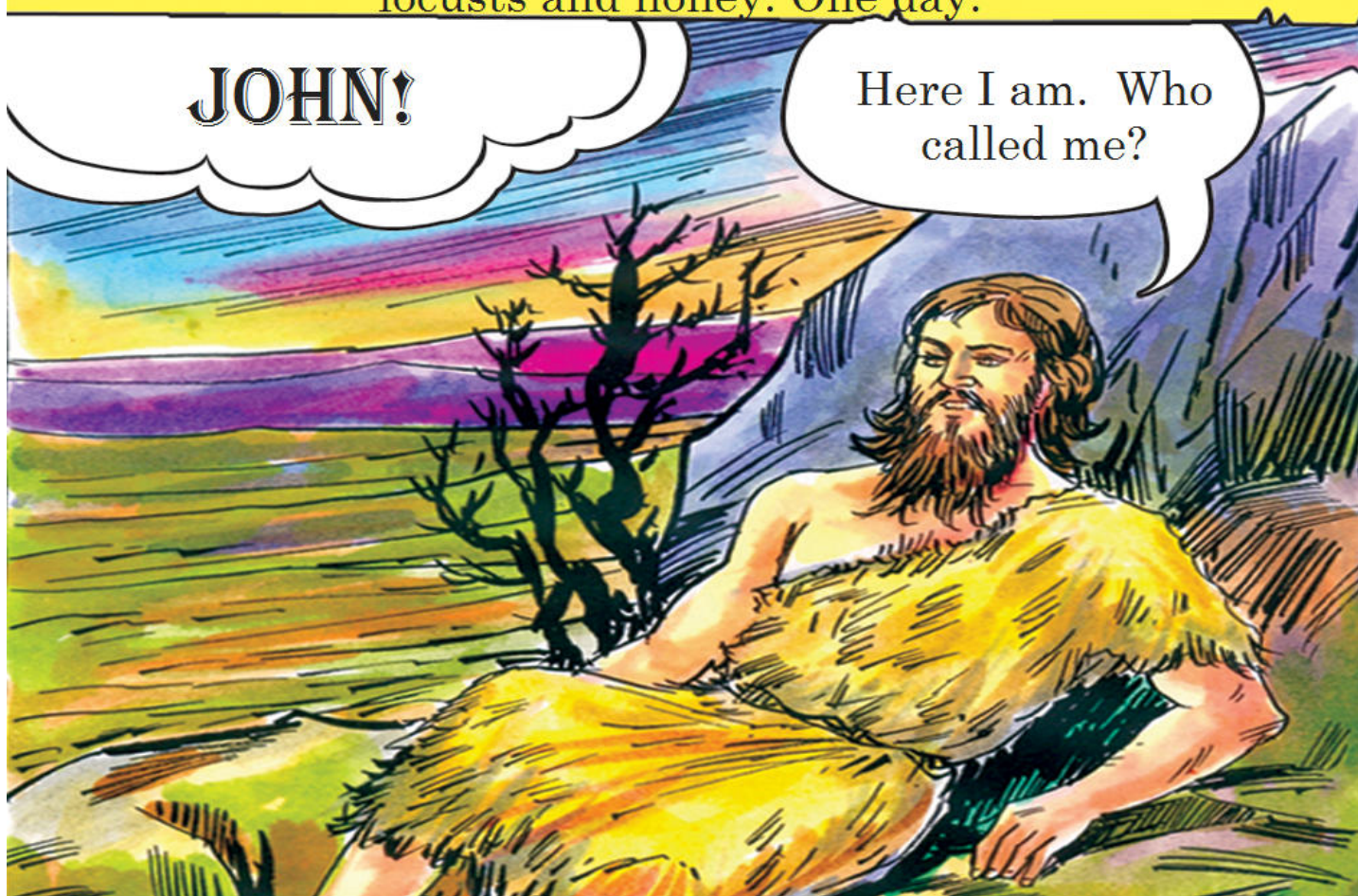
May the Almighty bless you and lead you.

Here I am. Who called me?

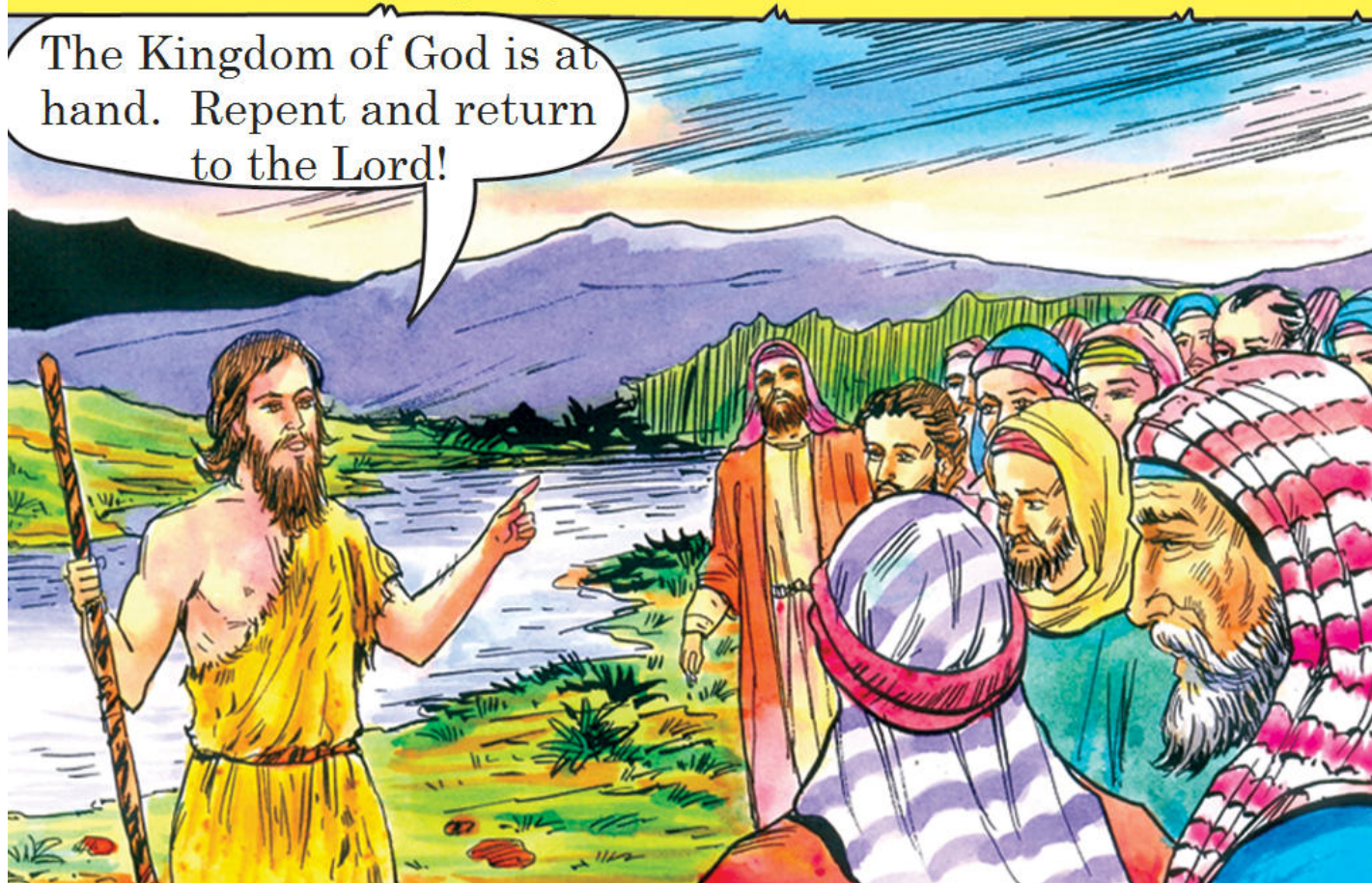


Receiving the call, John came to the bank of River Jordan.

The great and terrible day of the Lord is coming. Every mountain shall be laid low and every valley exalted. Repent and be humble.



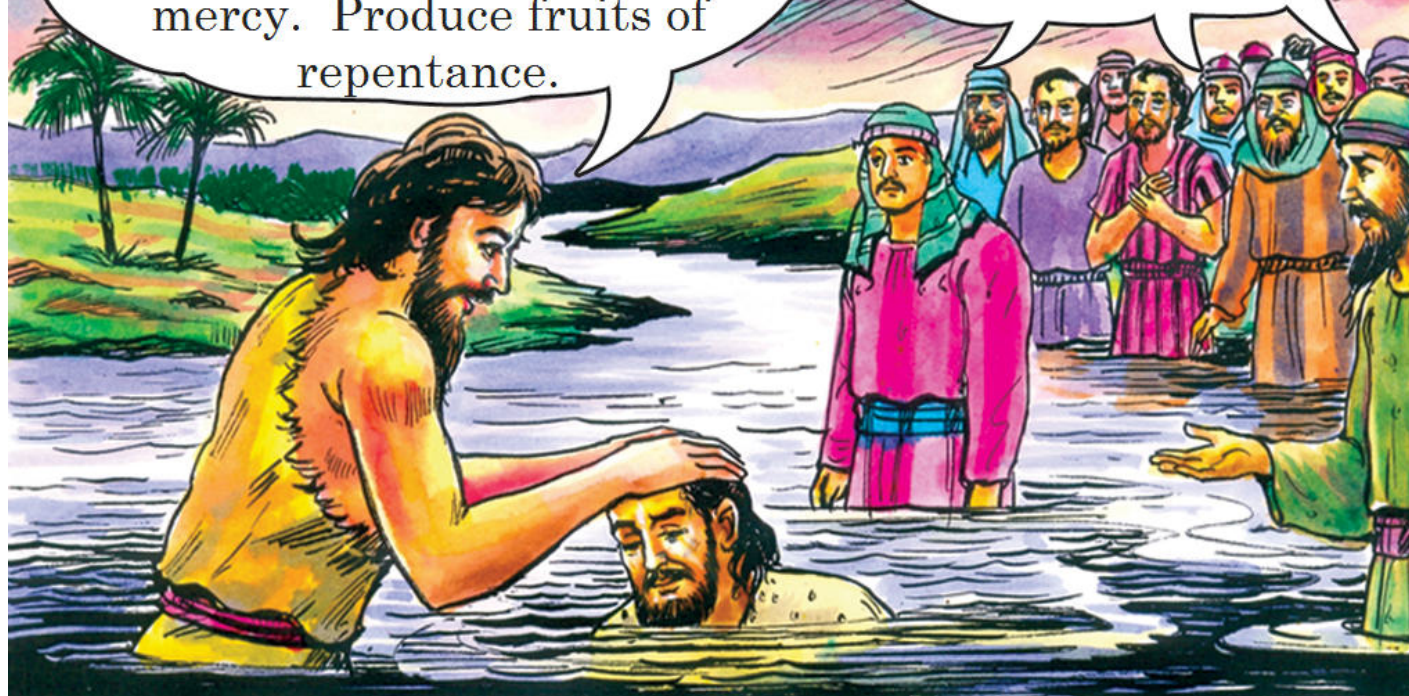


Leave the crooked

Receive the baptism of repentance! Confess your sins and cry out to the Lord for mercy. Produce fruits of repentance.

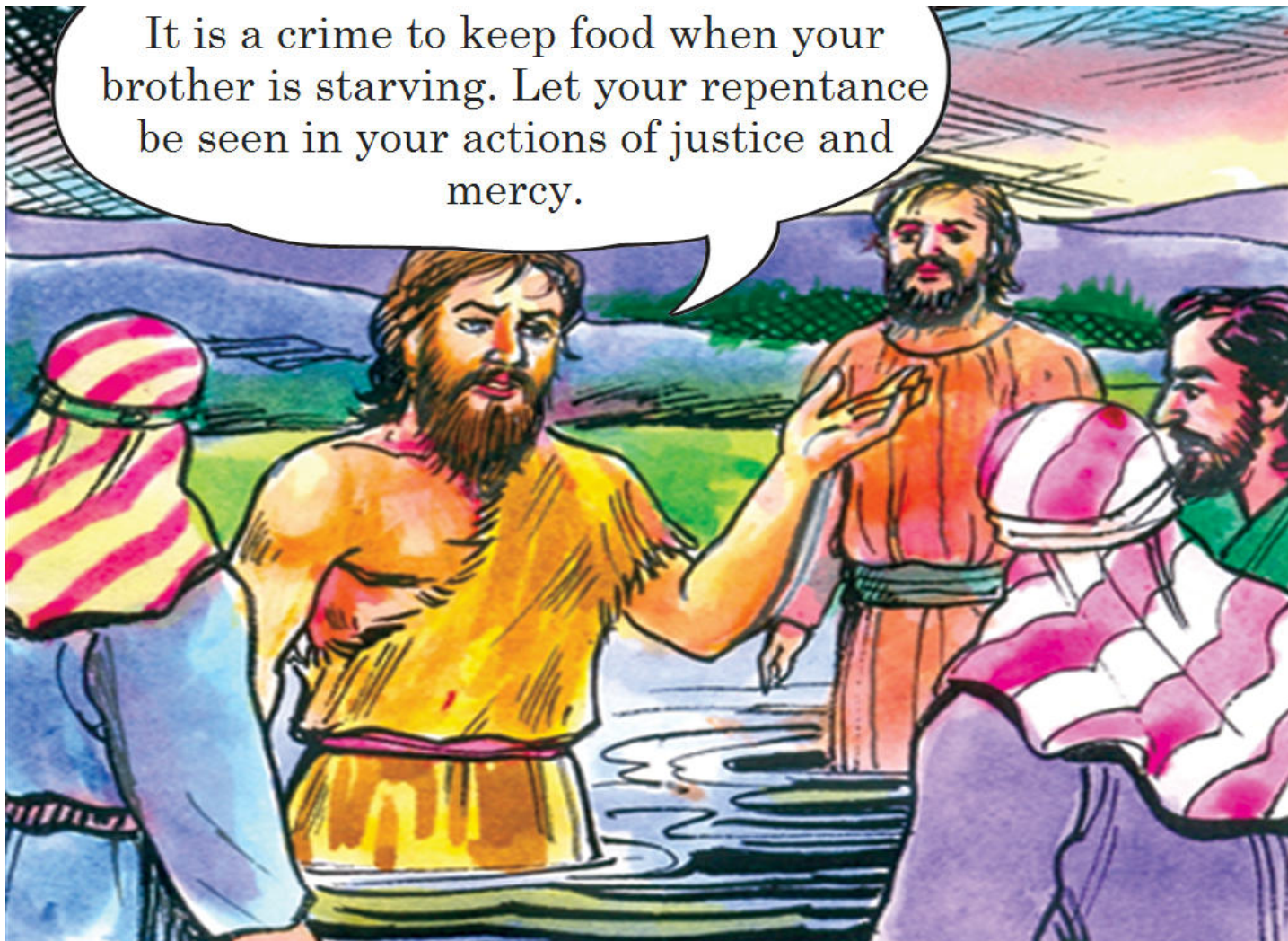
Master, what shall I do?

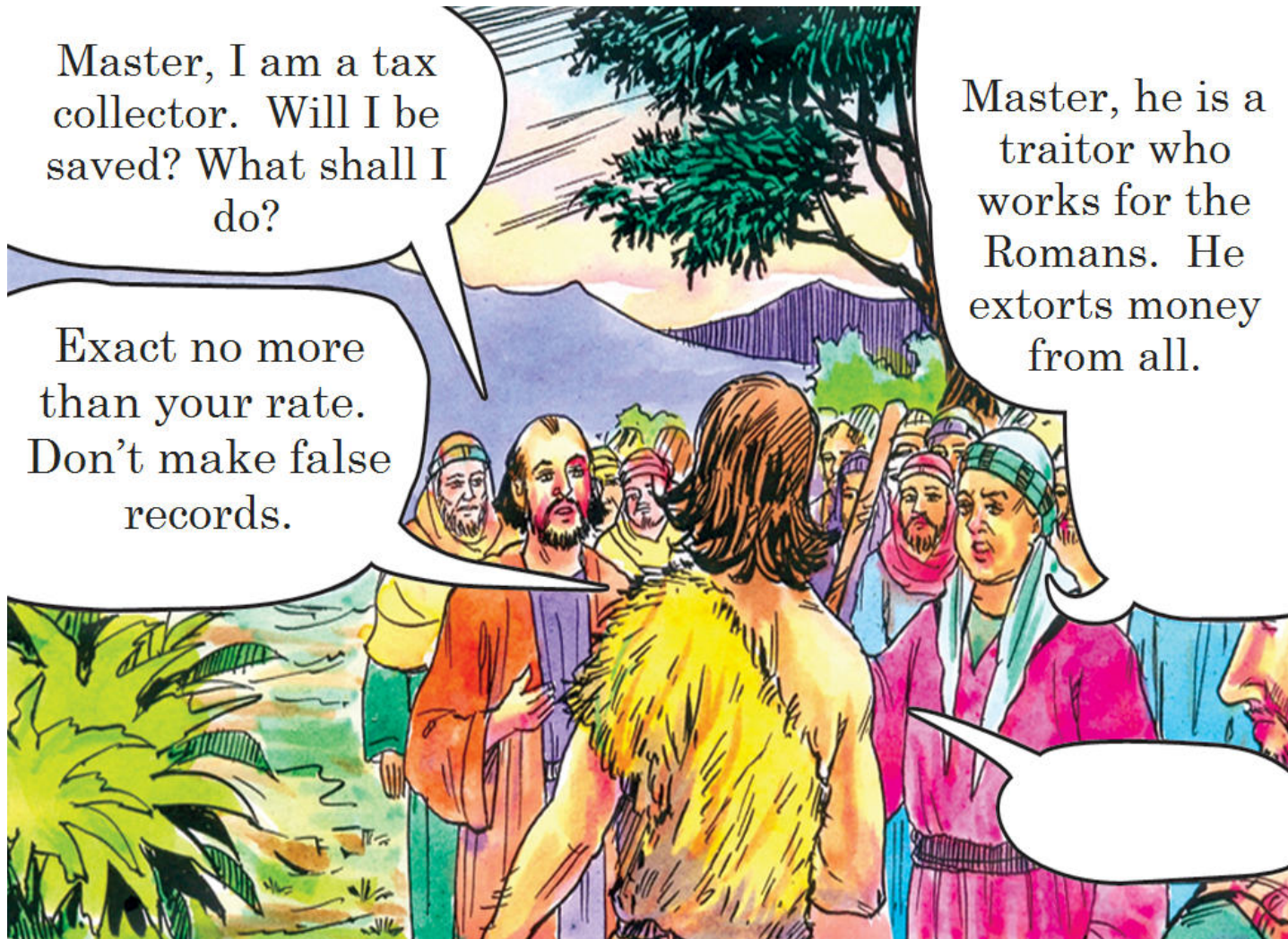
It is a crime to keep food when your brother is starving. Let your repentance be seen in your actions of justice and mercy.




Master, I am a tax collector. Will I be saved? What shall I do?

No, I am not the Messiah. I am not worthy even to undo the straps of His sandals.

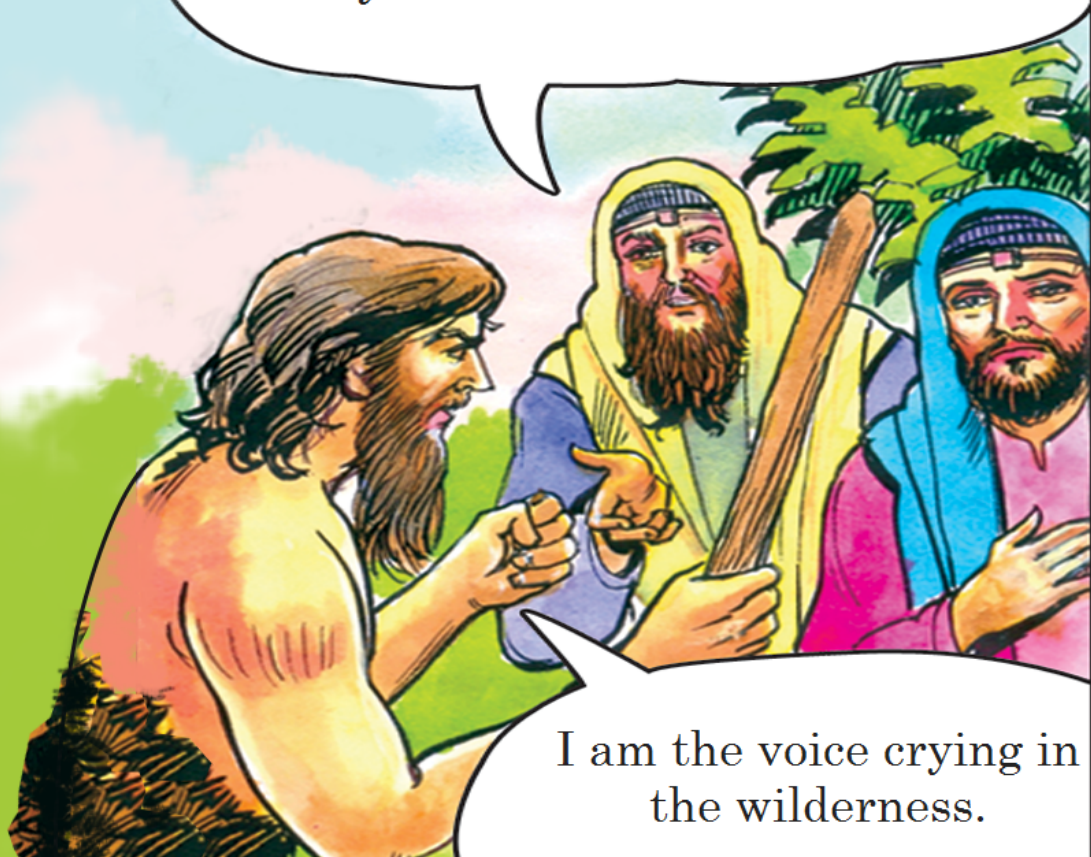


Are you the

nor the prophet.

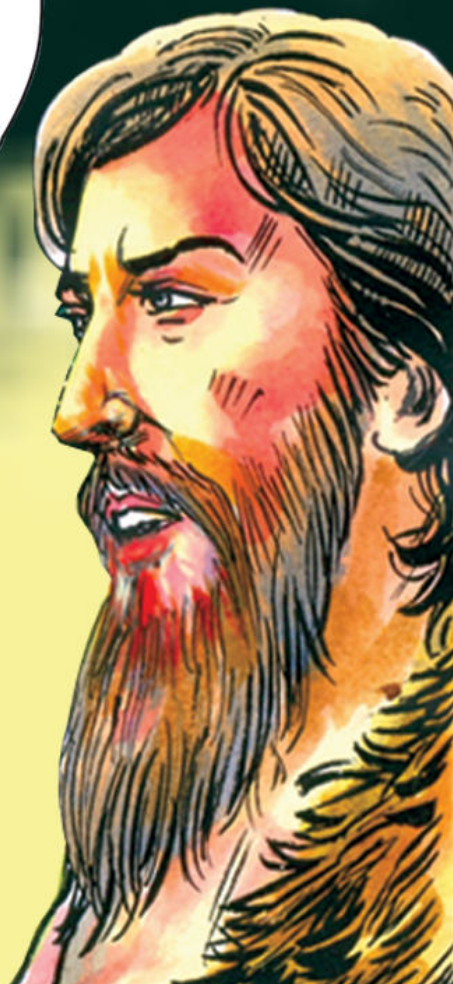


Then who are you? What shall we say to the ones who sent us?

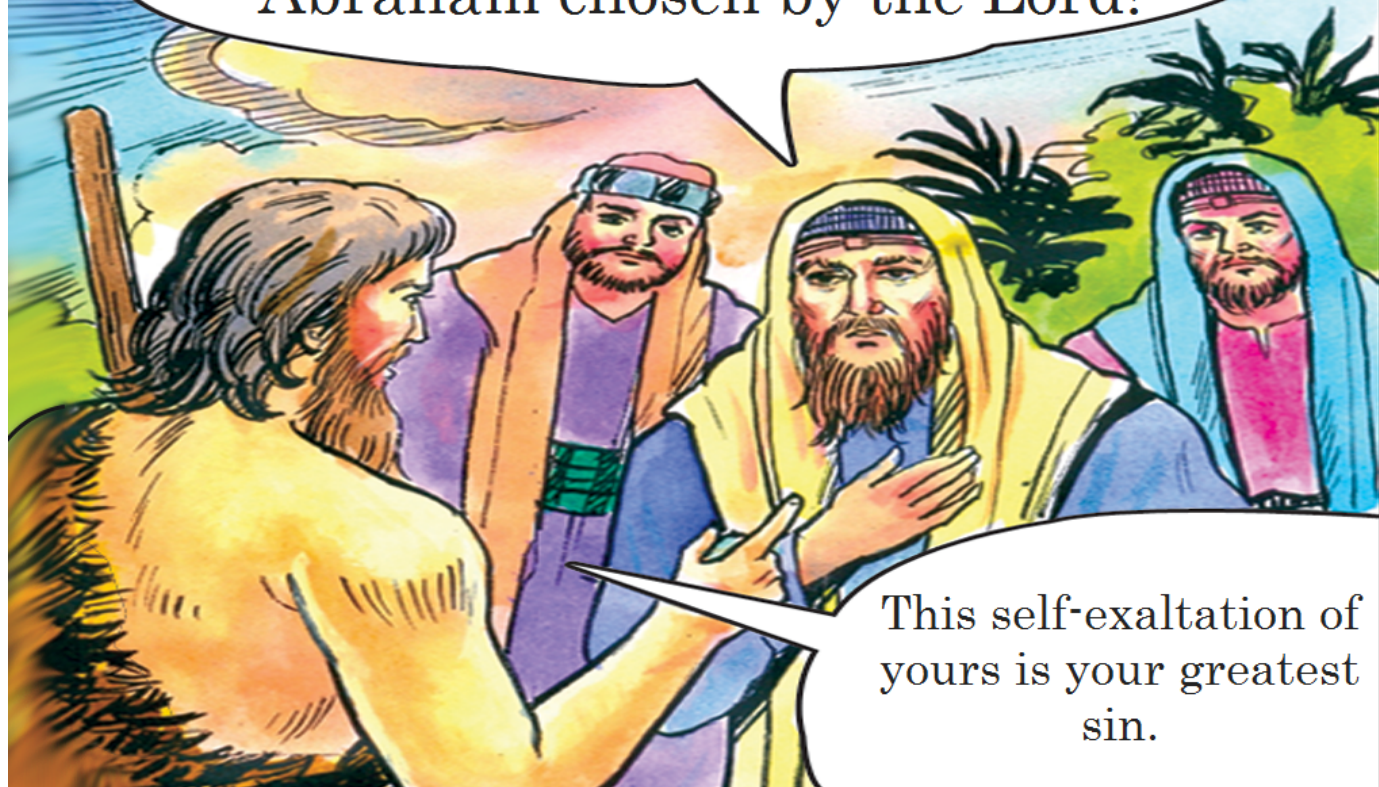


I am the voice crying in the wilderness.

Abraham chosen by the Lord!




This self-exaltation of

If you are neither the Messiah nor the Prophet, then by whose authority are you baptizing?



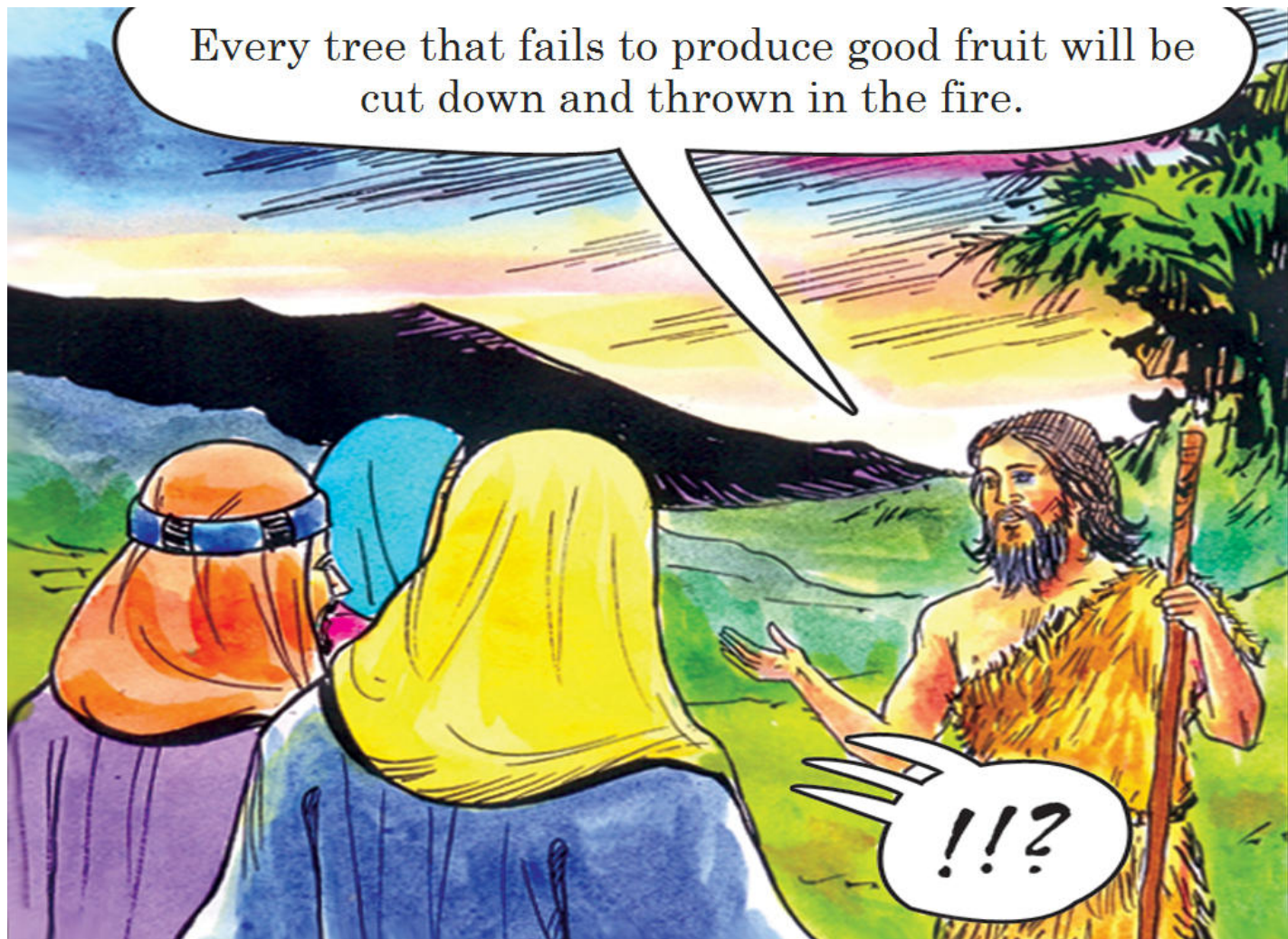


I baptize with water in order to prepare you to receive the Messiah.

root of the trees.

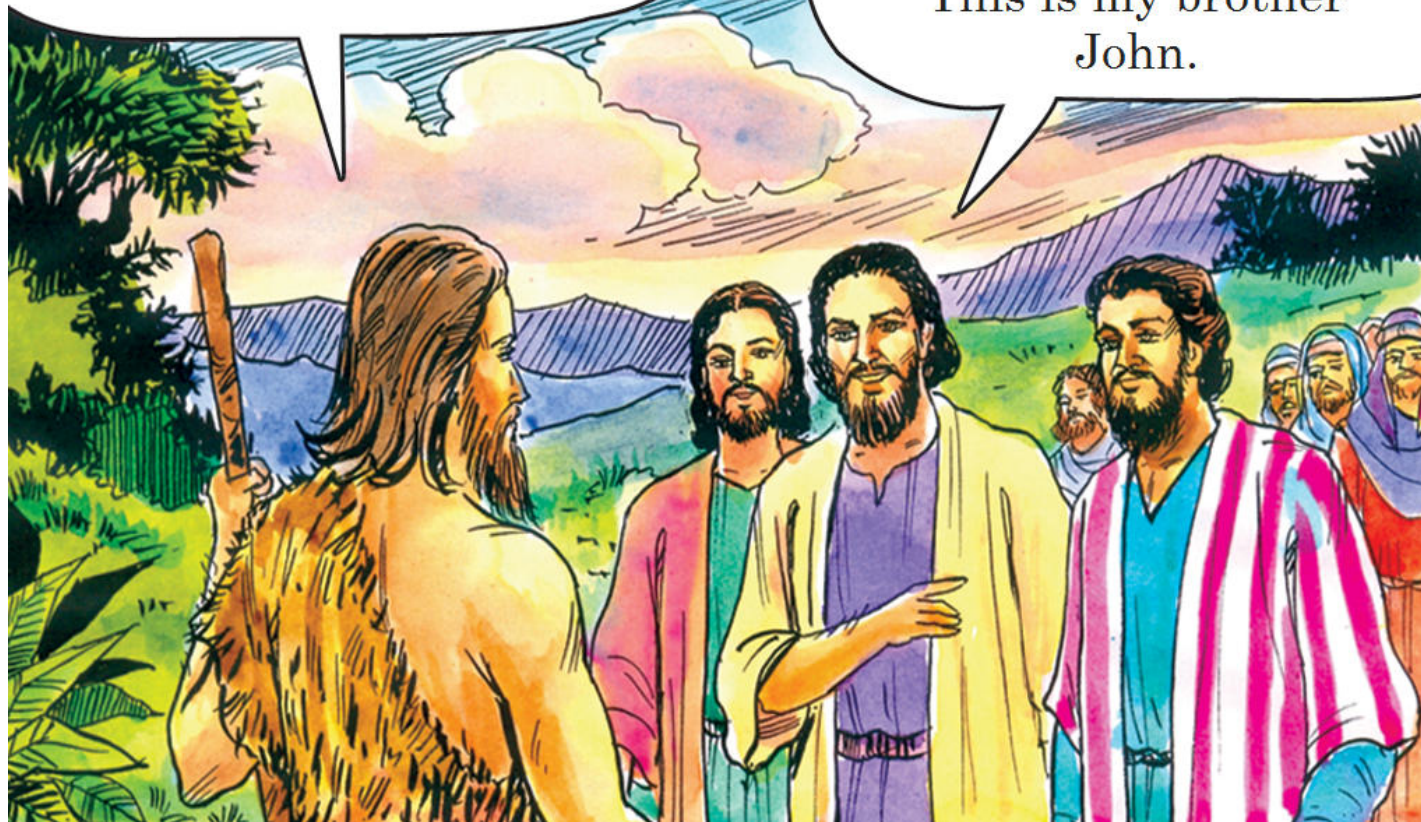
Every tree that fails to produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown in the fire.

John.



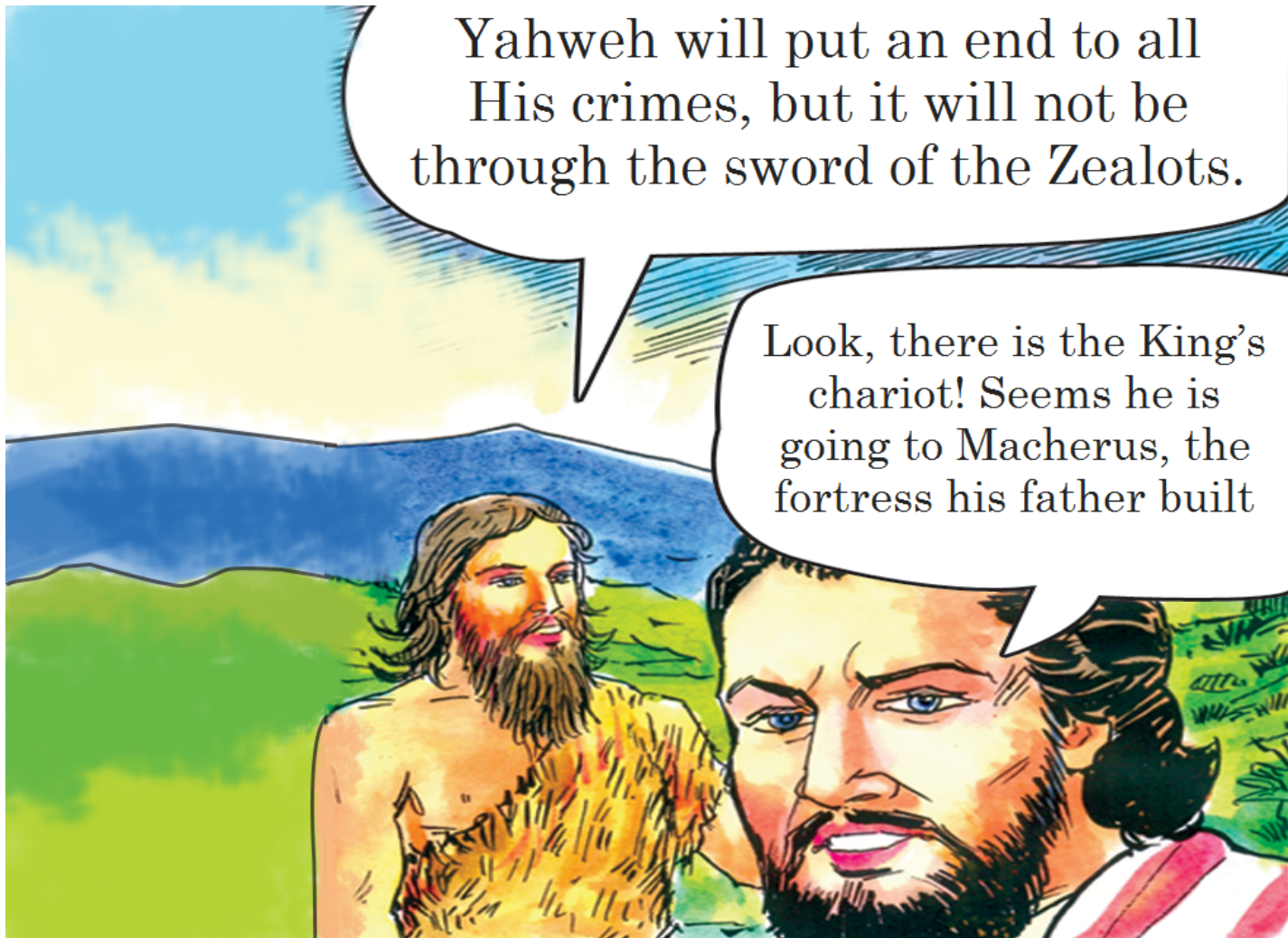
We come from

dearly.

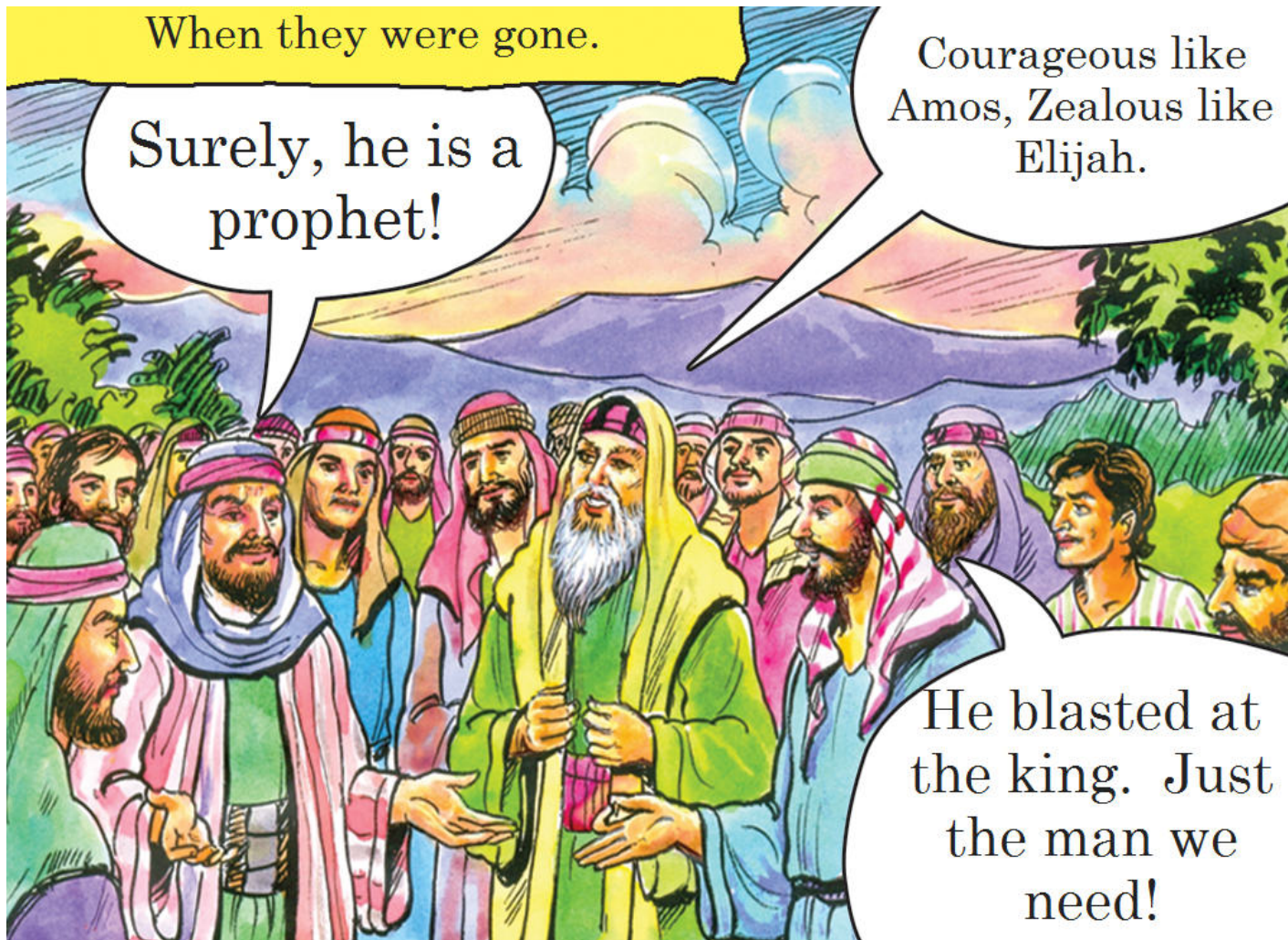


When they were gone.

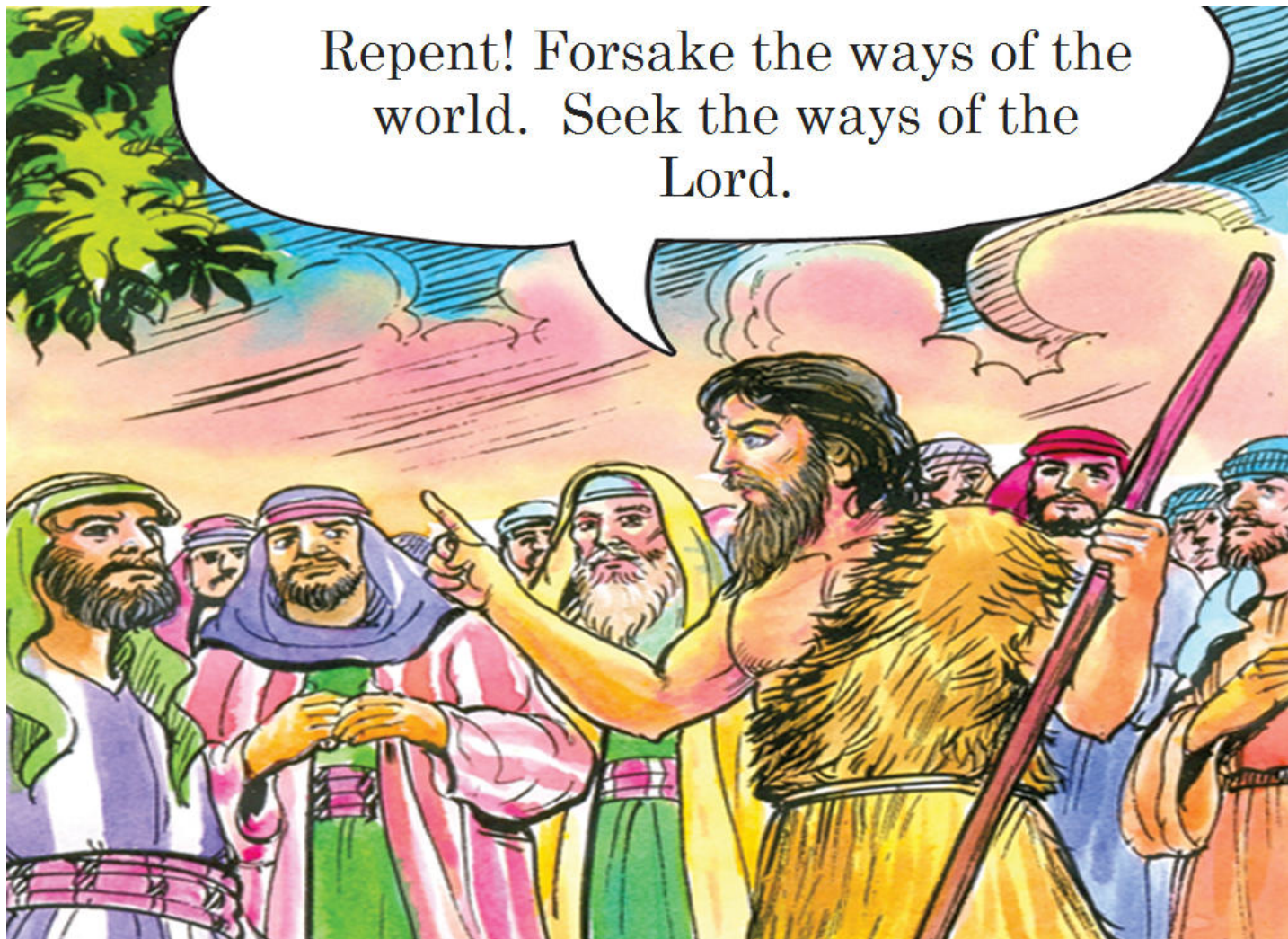
Surely, he is a prophet!

Shalom Jesus, how are you?


Shalom Jose, So long since we met! Where have you been?

be baptized.

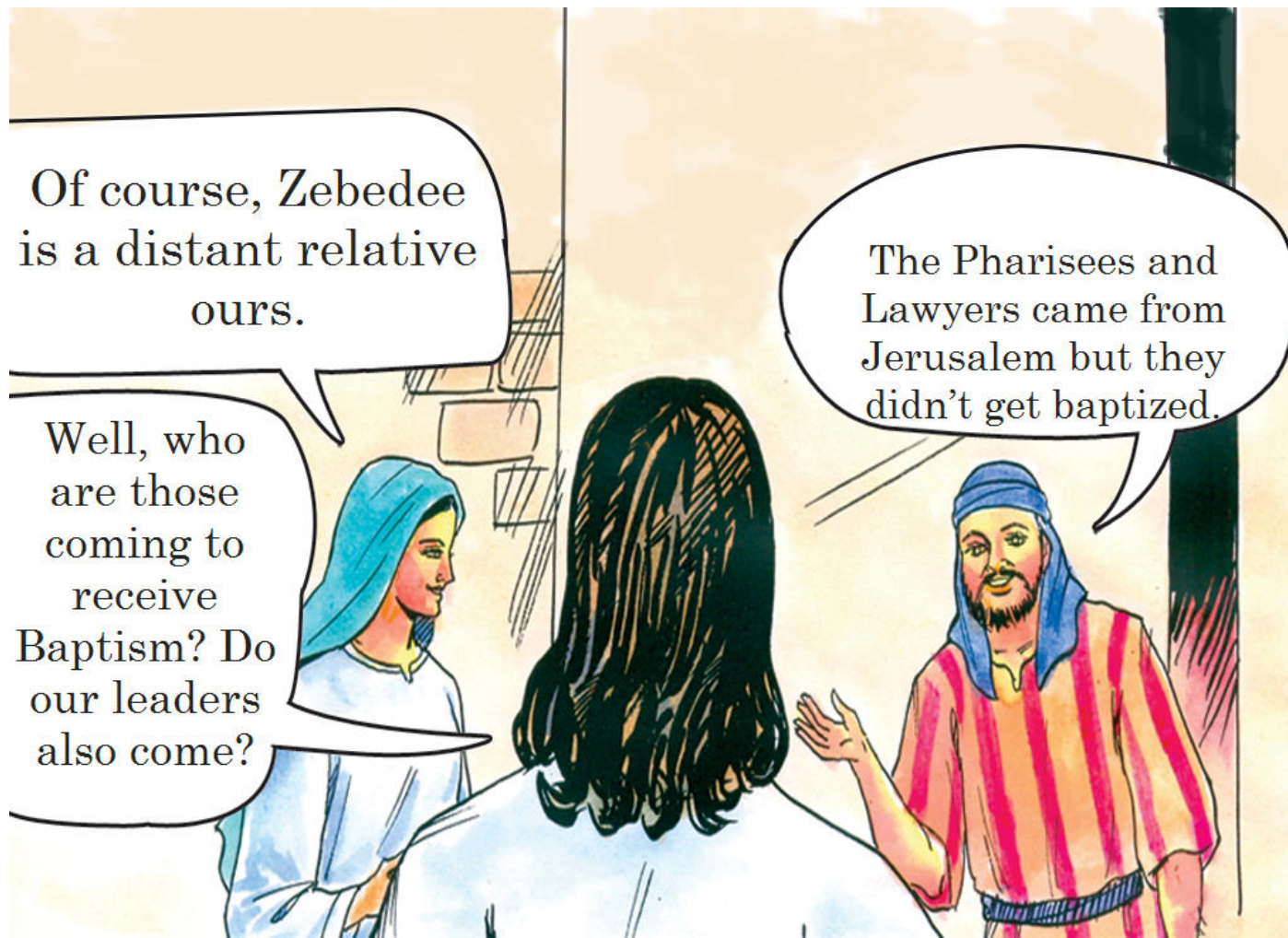
Is John

Do those zealots also receive Baptism?





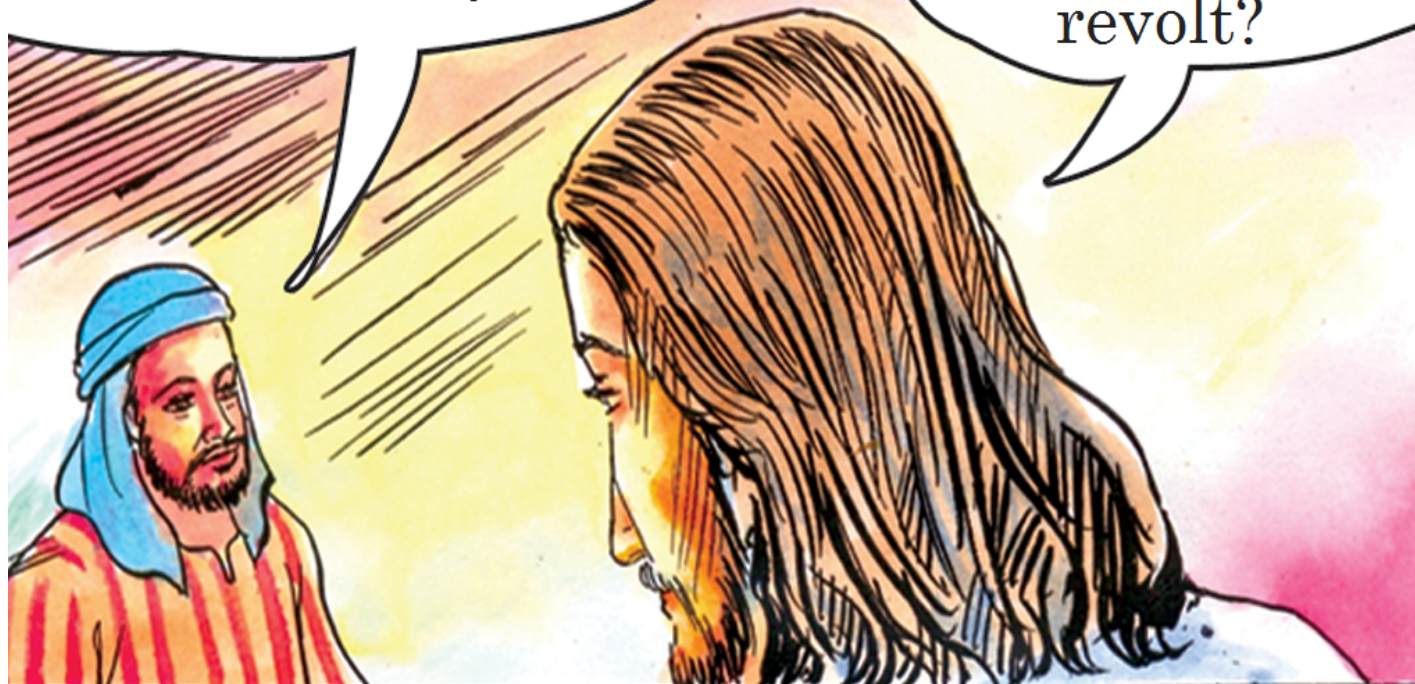
They are in the

Will the one calling to repentance join an armed revolt?

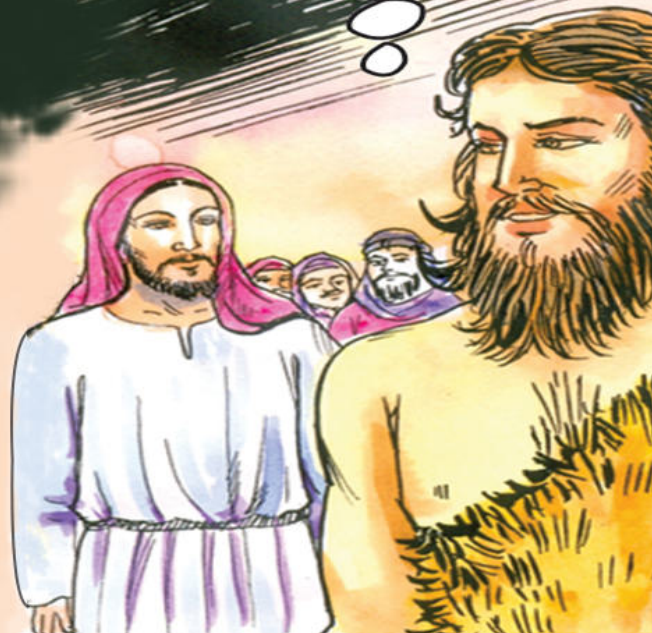


That remains to be

Why is the one without sin coming to receive the baptism of the sinners?

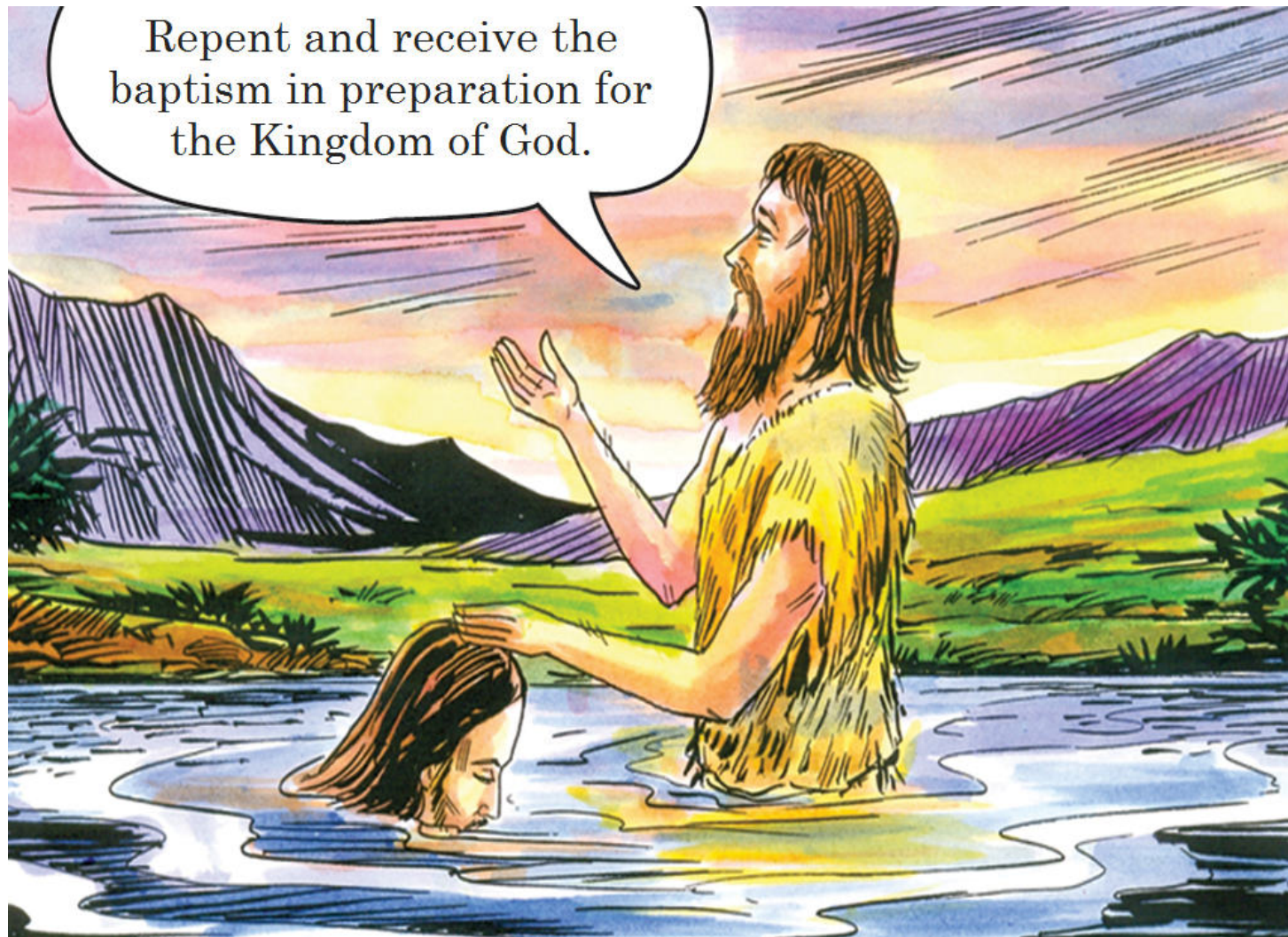


It is I who need

When Jesus received baptism the heavens opened and the Spirit of God descended upon him like a dove.



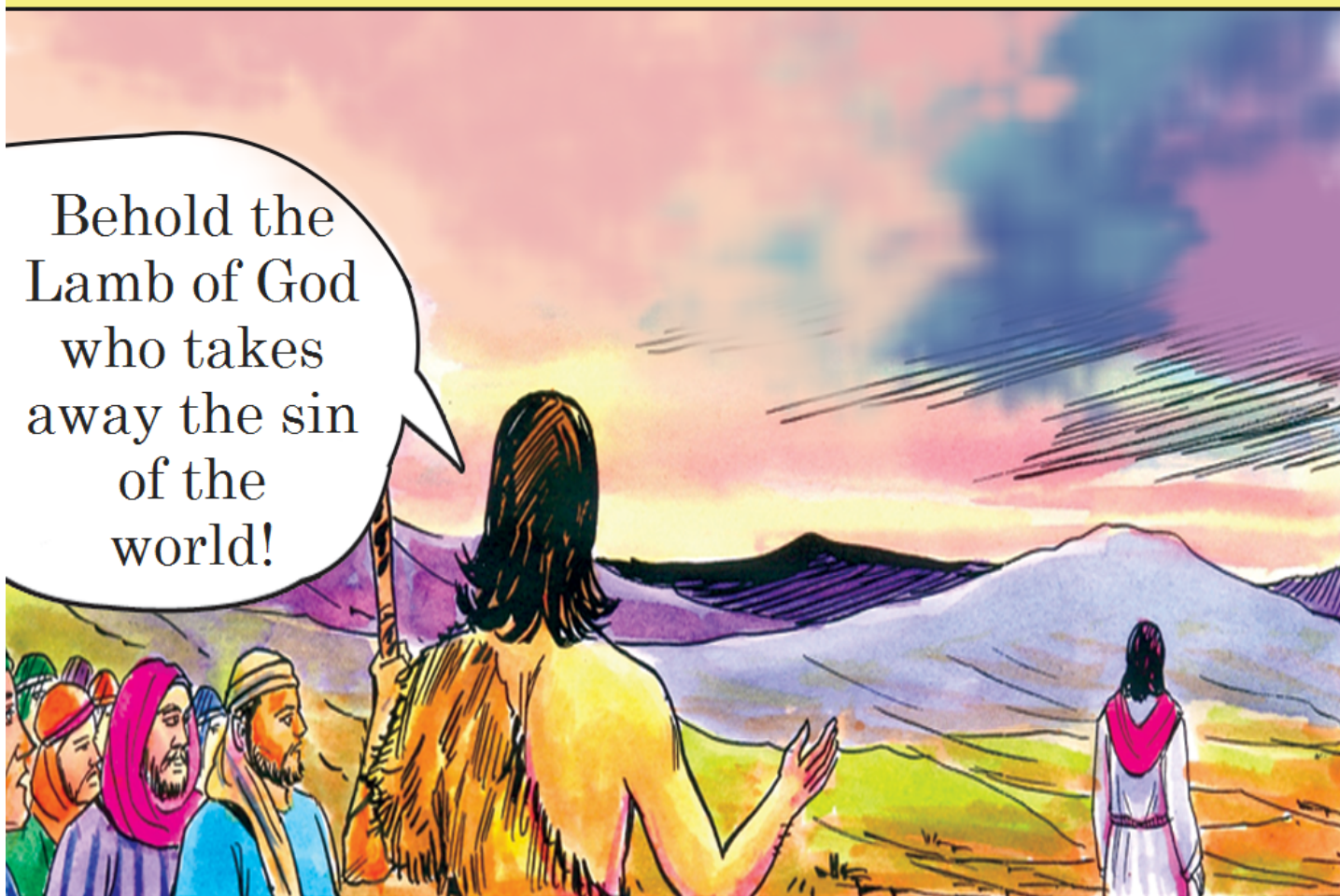


