

COME LORD JESUS!

The history of salvation will come to its fulfillment when evil will be completely annihilated and the world that is now under the power of evil will be thoroughly renewed. The book of Revelation, the last book of the Bible, concludes by depicting God' God's victory over evil. All form of oppression and suffering will come to an end. Death, the ultimate enemy of life will be destroyed. God Himself will establish His Kingdom of everlasting peace and happiness upon this earth that is now plagued with

oppression and exploitation, hatred and divisions, misery and death.

Though the Book of Revelation contains such a beautiful message, it is difficult to understand because the message is clothed in a symbolic language that is not quite familiar to the present day reader. The content of the book as well as the historical circumstances in which the book was written compelled the author to use such a symbolic language. Though the symbols might seem strange to us, they were not so for the first century readers of Jewish and Christian background.

Towards the end of the first century A.D., Christians in the Roman Empire met with a terrible persecution. Thousands of people lost their property, liberty and their very lives for their faith in Jesus Christ. The book of Revelation was written with the main intention of encouraging the persecuted Christians to keep their faith. Evidently it is the Roman emperor who persecuted the Christians. But the sacred author recognized Satan standing behind the

emperor. The imperial power was only an agent of Satan.

Persecution is the attack launched by the powers of evil against the church of Christ. In fact, it is the decisive battle between good and evil, between God and Satan. Such a theme of cosmic proportions could be depicted only in symbols. Besides, the revolutionary content of book that announced the imminent the destruction of the imperial forces had to be clothed in symbols in order to reach it to the

believers without being detected by the political authority.

In the book of Revelation extremely beautiful and horrible pictures are intermingled. Whatever is good and divine is beautiful; whatever is evil and diabolic is horrible. The symbols of the serpent, beasts, prostitute etc. depict the nature and activity of Satan, whereas the symbols of the lamb, bride, New Jerusalem etc. describe the salvation through Jesus.

In order to exhort and encourage Christians not to renounce their faith for fear of

persecution or for material gain ad pleasure, the sacred author depicts in vivid colours the terrible punishment that will befall the sinners. The destruction of Rome is a symbol of eternal punishment reserved for all those who reject and oppose God. The new Heaven and New Earth on the contrary describe the eternal happiness destined for the faithful.

In the present story, we have depicted a few scenes from the Book of Revelation. The pictures of ineffable beauty and unimaginable horror should persuade the readers to avoid sin and

remain faithful to Christ at any cost. "Come Lord Jesus" is the prayer that rises unceasingly from the Church waiting for the establishment of the Kingdom of God upon the earth. To this prayer Jesus replies: "Yes, I am coming soon". This promise of Jesus Christ, the risen Lord, is the solid rock on which our hopes are anchored.

















There is nobody fit to open the scroll and execute the salvific plan of God.

As the Lamb broke the seals punishment of the evil began.




He received the victor's crown and started his triumphal march.




Wars and revolutions broke out.



A severe famine followed.




Plague and starvation killed many.

When He broke the sixth seal, the whole universe shivered. The people in terror tried to hide themselves.



Seven angels with trumpets appeared. When 4 of them blew their trumpets, there were signs and great destructions on earth, sea, and sky.





The key to the Abyss was given to the one who fell from the sky.








The locusts that came up from the Abyss.




The emperor of the Abyss was Abaddon which meant "destruction".






As the sixth angel blew his trumpet.

Release the four angels that are chained up at the river Euphrates.




Four hundred million mounted men destroyed a third of the human race.





Another powerful angel blew his trumpet.

The woman delivered a boy and the child was taken to God. The woman fled to the desert.




A war broke out in heaven. Michael with his angles fought against the dragon.

A second beast emerged from the ground and it compelled everyone to worship the first one.




Then an angel appeared in heaven.

One like a Son of Man, sitting on a cloud appeared in the sky.





Another angel with a sharp sickle appeared.




The blood of the wicked came out of the winepress.










When the first angel emptied his bowl, disgusting and painful sores appeared on all those who bore the mark of the beast.







The seventh angel emptied his bowl on the wicked gathered in Armageddon.







When the beast is defeated by the lamb, he will turn against the woman, sitting upon him.




As the milestone sinks into the sea, the great city Babylon will fall. She will have to account for the blood of all the innocent.

Rejoice you heaven and all the saints. God has pronounced his judgment.



People of the nations, birds of the air, beasts of the forests, come for the banquet prepared by the Lord. Eat the flesh of the wicked beast.






Satan, the primeval serpent, you shall remain in the Abyss for a thousand years, until it is time to destroy you.


All who were killed in the name of Jesus received life and lived with him for a thousand years.




When the thousand years were over, Satan was released.








